UNE IN THE ULD WEST AT... Cold Spring

B ack in the Old West of sharpshooting cowboys and outhouses, travel was considerably more harrowing than it is today. After riding in a vehicle running on literal horsepower for a few days, dodging bandits, wild animals and a crusty prospector named Cyclops, being able to stow your shotgun for a relaxed meal would be like going home.

This rustic ambience exists today in a secluded hideaway that is the Cold

Spring Tavern. People have dined on the Tavern's all-encompassing menu for about a hundred years, and when this haven was the last stop between the East and Santa Barbara for hardened stagecoach travelers, the Cold Spring Tavern walls housed them for a quiet night in the depths of the Santa Ynez Mountains.

Most of the trinkets, trophies and tools on display in the Tavern have been there since Teddy Roosevelt left office, lending the restaurant a nostalgic air. During the day, the Tavern is a comforting eatery with a down-home attitude, and at night the flaming lanterns create a romantic atmosphere perfect for an intimate dining affair—truly a versatile cabin, but with class.

While the Wild West feel of Cold Spring Tavern may appeal to the simple life, the menu certainly doesn't appeal to a simple palate. With gourmet meals featuring exotic meats, delectable pastas and incredibly prepared sandwiches, this is no franksand-beans operation.

On any given day, patrons may find such options as ostrich burgers, buffalo steak, wild boar chops or even quiche lorraine offered, each being equally delicious and unique. What's more, the full

bar stocks a wide selection of beer, wine and all that hard stuff. It's a long and winding road to the Tavern, so make sure to designate a driver.


Cold Spring Tavern also offers a wide selection of tempting desserts, including rich chocolate cake, and pecan pie laced with Jack Daniels. Get them a la mode with scoops of locally made ice cream.

Oftentimes, the Cold Spring Tavern management books lively bands to play at the accompanying bar, where bikers and drinkers from miles around converge to groove on the woodland acoustics. Few concerts offer patrons a truly gourmet dining and imbibing exerience in a natural, outdoor setting, and Cold Spring Tavern never fails to disappoint.

So for a taste of the Old West and some country cooking with flair, go to the Cold Spring Tavern. And even though it no longer rents out rooms for the night, you may never want to leave.

Cold Spring Tavern is located at 5995 Stage-coach Road in Santa Barbara. Take Highway 154 north until crossing the Santa Ynez Mountains; Stagecoach Road will be on your left. Call 967-0066 for more information.




