And the best part is they give you lots of everything. I'm talkin' a big plate o' goodies. At The Egghead, you get your dollar's worth.

According to Erin, a self described egg-hater who had a guacamole and jack cheese omelette, "Even if I do hate eggs, I love this omelette." Grace, who likes eggs but won't admit it pointed out that "there's no way I could eat all of this."



Da Vinci's is really an

eater-friendly place, with a whole list of options for the patron. Let's examine these shall we?

OPTION #1: Da Vinci's is a perfect place to go on one of those college dates that you kids are so fond of. Even though it is close, you will have to drive there, which gives the outing a distinct here-we-go-a-drivingout-on-a-date feeling. Once

sincere Italian atmosphere can't help but augment your entrees from the varied and sure-footed menu. The price tags attached are so reasonable and fair that you may get the mistaken impression that you are talking with Judge Wapner rather than dining on some of the best spaghetti and fettucini in

OPTION #2: Pizza, straight up, no time for dilly-dally. Da Vinci's delivers pizza as if it were handling the singular Hope Diamond. Not only are the prices so low they could limbo under a rug, but the pizza is hot, cheesy, saucy and tangy. In fact, Da Vinci's won the best tasting pizza award in a contest at the UCSB dorms last year. And a better deal is not to be found. Let me illustrate this by mentioning that, in one of the Da Vinci's specials, you can get a large pizza, a sagne dinners (or one of medium pizza and three each, if you wish), salad and

Cokes for \$11.10! \$11.10! You can get the affordability, convenience, quality and abundance of both, here, by opting to have their fine entrees delivered. Let me cite as an example a coupon that Da Vinci's has going right now. You can order, via the telephone, two spaghetti or lagarlic bread for under nine American dollars. That is fine, I think. I've tried it, and therefore I should know.

The three options I have outlined are not meant to be the only possible ones, I admit. The option of doing something like ordering a pizza to be delivered and then immediately driving over there to pick it up and then eating it in the Arby's parking lot is always open. And that's just the point: Da Vinci's is all about options and lets us know that we need not be slaves to the I.V. restaurant rut.

If Uncle Cliff were here, I'd know exactly what he'd say. He'd say, "Marcel, things are looking up."






