This brings up the main point. Everything about The Egghead is about eggs. This means that they know how to cook some Jim Dandy eggs. But there's more. Their

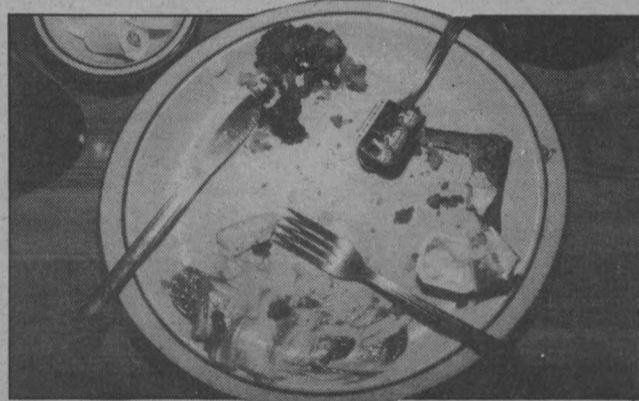
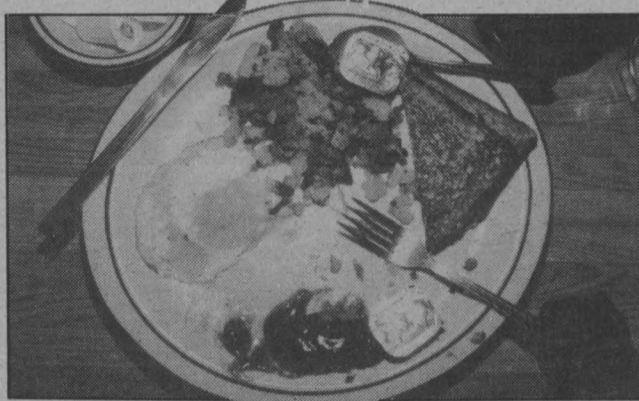
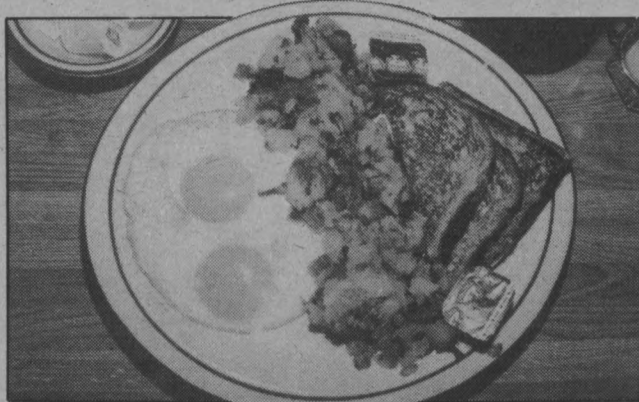

You also get your choice of sides with your eggs, so be creative. For instance, you could make a sandwich with a pancake two eggs and a blueberry muffin. And the best part is they give you lots of everything. I'm talkin' a big plate o' goodies. At The Egghead, you get your dollar's worth.

According to Erin, a self-described egg-hater who had a guacamole and jack cheese omelette, "Even if I do hate eggs, I love this omelette." Grace, who likes eggs but won't admit it pointed out that "there's no way I could eat all of this."

The ambience is spare. You get some formica tables, a small room, and you can see the cook as he screams through the orders. Go get your eggs. Your mother will be proud of you, the farmers will be grateful, and your roommates will be

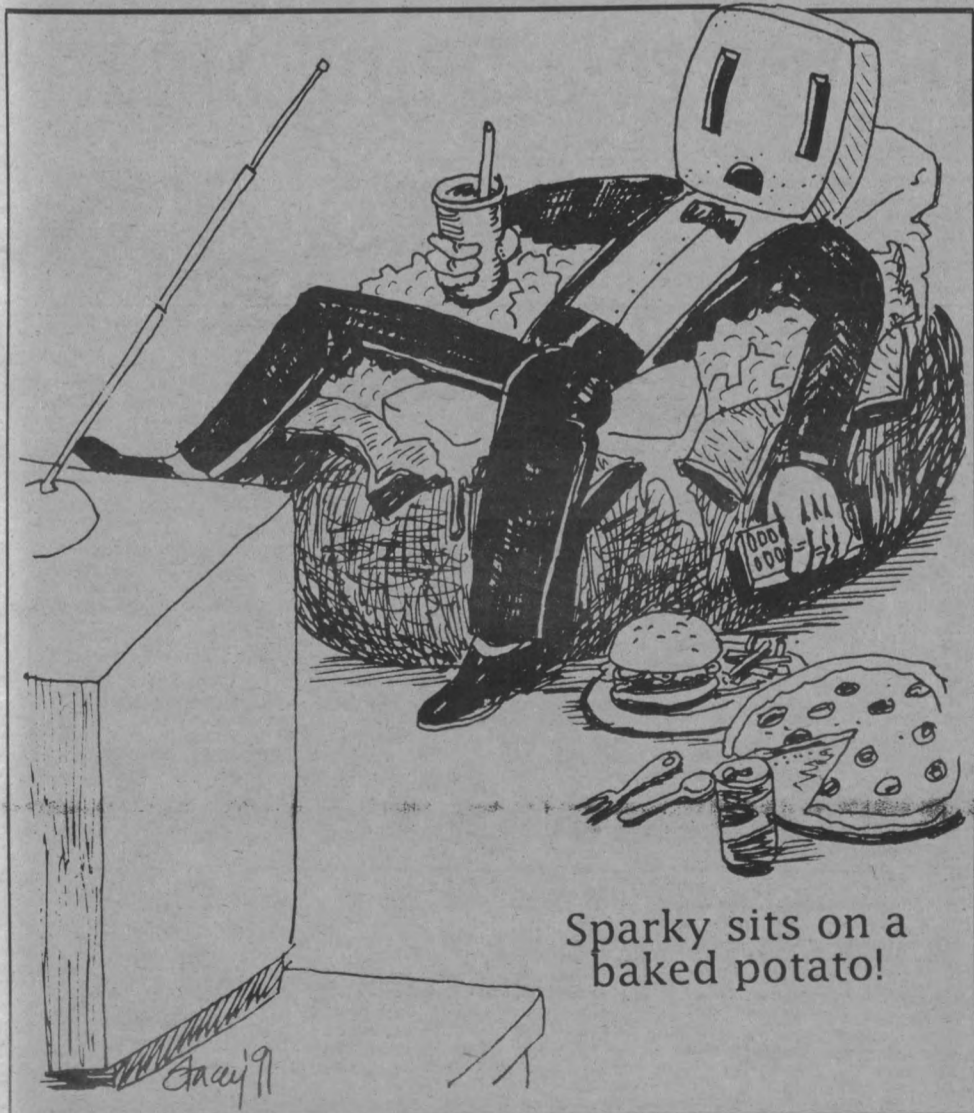

Not only are the prices so low they could limbo under a rug, but the pizza is hot, cheesy, saucy and tangy. In fact, Da Vinci's won the best tasting pizza award in a contest at the UCSB dorms last year. And a better deal is not to be found. Let me illustrate this by mentioning that, in one of the Da Vinci's specials, you can get a large pizza, a medium pizza and three

Cokes for \$11.10! \$11.10! Normally, if you were to call a restaurant and ask that a meal for three or four (or five?) be delivered at such a price, they would immediately transfer your call to Bellevue. Not Da Vinci's! At Da Vinci's they simply ask your address and, as if on the wings of Mercury himself, bring it direct to your doorstep in less time than it would take to play "Hey Jude" thrice over.

OPTION #3: If you liked certain aspects of the last two options and wanted to combine them in a fashion that would please you, then Option #3 is the option for you. Listen up. You can get the affordability, convenience, quality and abundance of both, here, by opting to have their fine entrees delivered. Let me cite as an example a coupon that Da Vinci's has going right now. You can order, via the telephone, two spaghetti or lasagne dinners (or one of each, if you wish), salad and

garlic bread for under nine American dollars. That is fine, I think. I've tried it, and therefore I should know.

The three options I have outlined are not meant to be the only possible ones, I admit. The option of doing something like ordering a pizza to be delivered and then immediately driving over there to pick it up and then eating it in the Arby's parking lot is always open. And that's just the point: Da Vinci's is all about options and lets us know that we need not be slaves to the I.V. restaurant rut.

If Uncle Cliff were here, I'd know exactly what he'd say. He'd say, "Marcel, things are looking up."

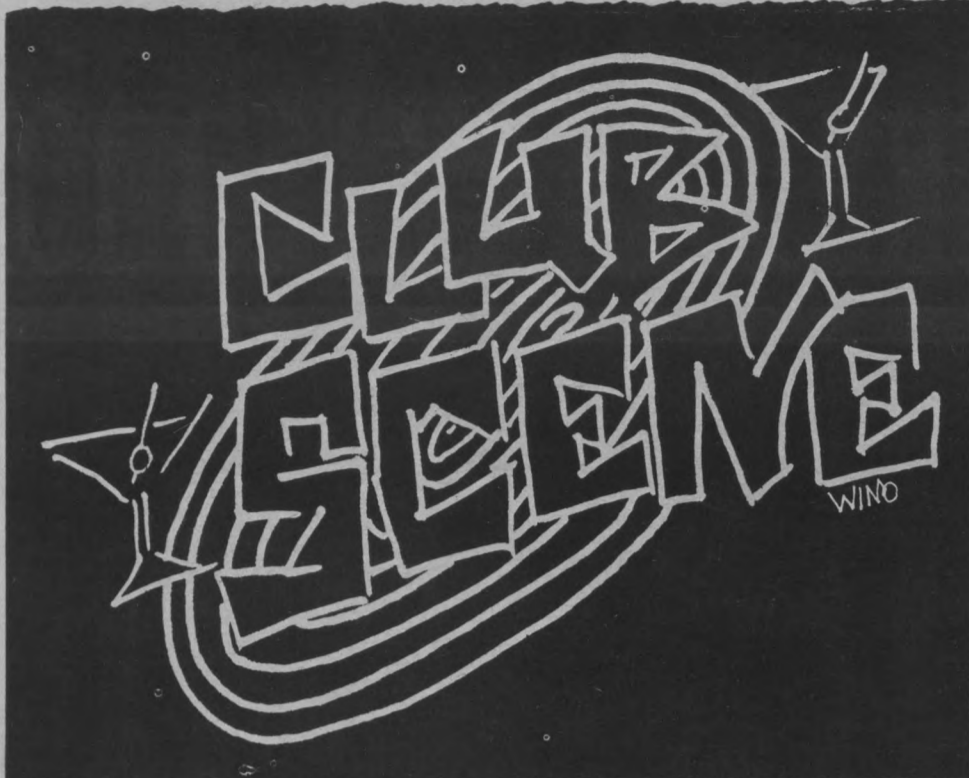

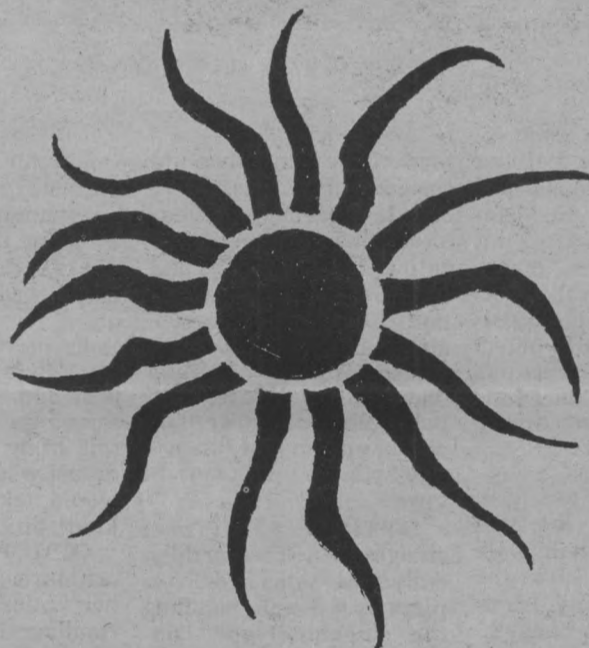
