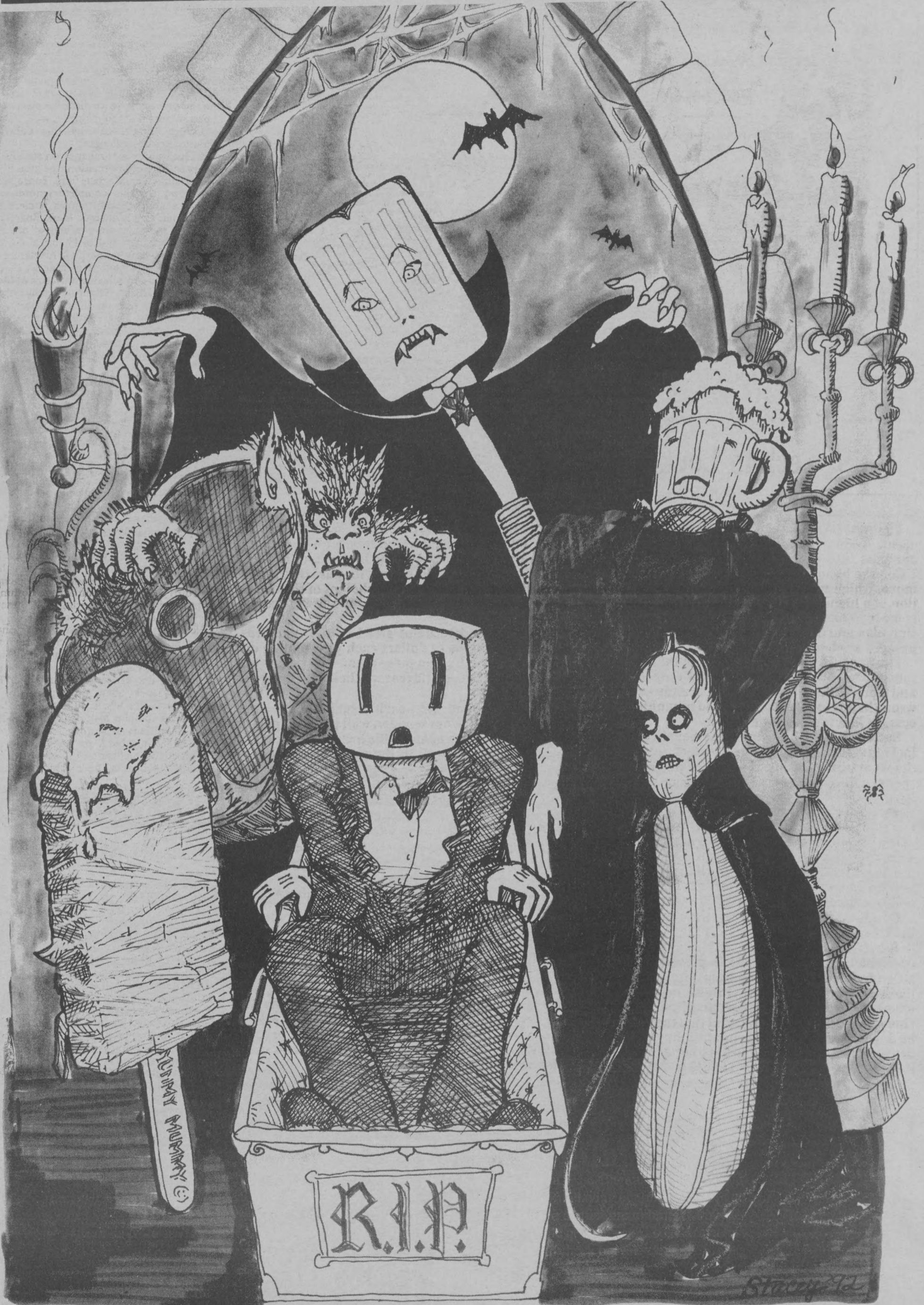

Be Merry at Harry's!

In these latter years of the 20th century, it seems that the public's interest is as reversible as a '70s jumpsuit. Month to month, week to week, day to day, people just keep changing their minds. "Oh, we like the president!" they might say. "He's our guy!" Then, a few short months later, we get, "The president is a weenie!"

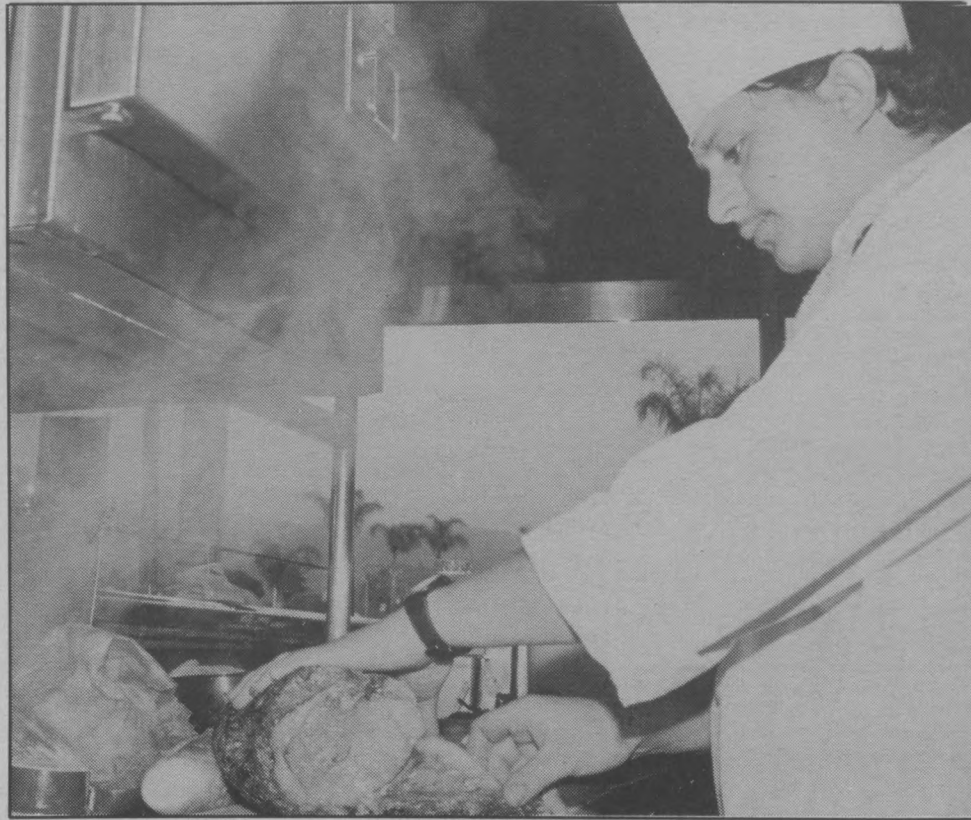
Our attention span is down to a first-grade level, and it seems that we wouldn't know lasting quality if it came down and sat next to us for 50 years. The same is true of restaurants, for the larger part. Just drive anywhere and then drive back. On the return trip, you could probably note four restaurants that weren't there before, and three old ones that have become specialty stores.

Obviously, the public is not the root of this problem. They've been so hyped-out and blasted with ever-changing information that all of these things seem out of their control.

That's why it's good to have something like Harry's Plaza Cafe. As one of the oldest restaurants in town, it is no surprise that Harry's is still one of the most popular. Harry's owns major stock in what has become of scarce commodity these days: reliability.

Harry's Plaza Cafe is the place to go when you don't want to worry about whether it's going to be good. It's the place to go when you don't want to worry about whether you are going to have to bus your own table, or pay a pound of flesh for a quarter-pound of tofu patty, or sit in a dining room that looks like a racquetball court.

People often say that looks can be deceiving. That's true, but one of the great things about Harry's is

another, equally-true cliché: What you see is what you get. Harry's, unlike so many other places, looks like a restaurant. You go in, and there's somebody who says, "Hello. How many in your party, tonight?" A warm greeting, a get-down-to-business smile coupled with a lets-get-you-to-your-table wave of the hand and grab of the menus. Real restaurant stuff. Look over to your left, there. Those are the chefs. You can tell because they've got chef's hats on and they're making up some food. They don't have visors, they don't have hairnets, they have chef's hats. Good.

Now, to your table. They're not going to try to shove some soy dog or Mongolian rhubarb hash down your throat. What they've got there is a comprehensive selection of classic Ameri-

can meals. We're talking steak, lamb, chicken, pork chops, shrimp, blackened river trout and some real, American Italian dishes. Harry's is not for people who order the Chinese tofu salad and then pick through it for 20 minutes and then order an Evian without taking a single bite. Harry's exists for people who, since they're going out to dinner, would like to have some dinner. And dinner they serve.

While you're waiting for your entree, check out the sourdough bread, salsa and sour cream they bring to your table. It's a neat combination, really. One of the dangers of this appetite-whetter is that you may eat too much. When your meal comes, even if you have stuffed yourself with the bread and salsa business, you will eat the entire massive, scrumptious dish. Be

careful, because you might die. At Harry's, I often feel like a goldfish who will eat and eat and eat until he just floats at the top of the tank.

It's really a good place, one even your grandfather would note for its quality.

Chuck's of Hawaii isn't actually in Hawaii, and that's a good thing. I mean, why should the islanders get to have all that great food, while Santa Barbarans get stuck with restaurants where the cook doesn't know a steak from a stake. At Chuck's, they don't have a problem with homonyms. In fact, their specialty is steak. That's what they do; that's their forte, if you will. Chuck's serves it a number of different ways, and is damn proud of it. This place is special. How can you tell? Good question. At Chuck's the menu is not some glossy fold-out with pictures of the Bob's Big Boy specials. The menu is not a delicate placard with a tasteful amount of white space to make the prices seem smaller. And it certainly doesn't double as your placemat, so that when you spill dressing on it during your salad you can't see

what comes with your fish. At Chuck's, those pitfalls are cleverly avoided. The server brings you a bottle of wine. Before you even get a chance to ask which of your admirers sent it over, the server points out that the bottle is empty, but more importantly, that the menu is written on it. That's just the beginning of the unique experience patrons have while at Chuck's. The menu choices are varied. There is chicken, there is fish, there are the daily specials. And, of course, there is steak. Hungry diners are forced to chose between the sirloin, the New York or the filet. It's a tough choice for anyone, but the folks at Chuck's make it a little easier by starting the meal off with a trip to the salad bar.

This salad bar is not just an assembly line of greens and radishes. Oh sure, Chuck's has its fair share of crisp lettuce and other goodies which makes salad

bars great, but it also boasts its own fresh bread. And butter. Which brings us back to the steak. Since the salad bar is located directly in front of the grill, it's impossible not to notice what's cooking. What is cooking? Good question. Steak. Chicken. Fish. Steak. Some leftover scraps from that other guy's steak. It's all there, in glorious red, brown, white and black. And with a name like Chuck's, you know it's going to be good. If Pierre or Jurad were cooking, there's room for doubt. But this is Chuck. If Chuck can't make a good steak, no one can. And not just Chuck, but Chuck's of Hawaii. Ah, a patriot. A beverage is always good in situations like this, and Chuck's has a wine list too long to fit on an empty bottle. Instead, they have a small brochure, with dozens upon dozens of choices. If steak is their spe-

cialty, wine is certainly a close second. The food is complimented by the restaurant itself, a delightful combination of mood lighting and Hawaiian-themed architecture. Sort of a post-modern Orwell-meets-Mike Brady concoction which only adds to the dining experience. Steak just can't be enjoyed when it has to compete with flashing lights, vinyl-covered booths and the sounds of dishes crashing in the kitchen. In short, it's the perfect place to eat steak, or even steak and chicken. Or even just chicken, because the portions are so large that it's easy to eat too much. 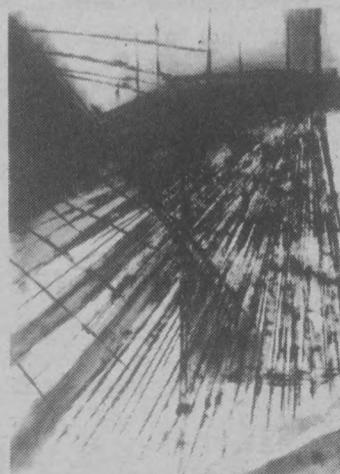
