Skip Breakfast? No Way! Eat at The Egghead!

There is no better way to start a great weekend off right or just laze away an average day than going out to breakfast at a great restaurant, a really great restaurant, like The Egghead. Is there any other?

Now, as you've probably already guessed, the place specializes in dishes that have to do with eggs: omelettes, more omelettes, Benedict, scrambled, poached or over easy it's all there for the taking. If you didn't know it al-ready, it would be quite clear the moment you walk into the eatery. The walls are covered with framed posters all repre-senting different visualizations of the same theme -

that's right — the egg.

But if the contents of white ovals laid by chickens aren't your thing, don't worry for a single minute, because the friendly servers will fill you up with your choice of pancakes, homefries, fruit, fresh baked goods and more. These are also the sides

when you order an omelette or egg breakfast. And you get to pick two of them.

I always choose the two-egg dish — varying in style - drink the neverempty cup of coffee and have homefries 'n' toast as my sides. My loyal eating partner, on the other hand, generally orders the Egghead Benedict, with pancakes and homefries. Sometimes I add bacon when I'm in the mood. But no matter what we order, there has never been a disappointing meal. If fact, it's always started the day off right. The same could happen for you.
One of the best parts ab-

out the restaurant, after the food and service, of course, is the seating options. There are several inside spots, conveniently located near the newspaper rack that houses all your favorite reading ma-terials, or if the weather's right, an outside patio is available with umbrellacovered tables. The sec-

ond option takes you through the kitchen, where the edible master-pieces are prepared and the cook always greets you with a wave.

I do have to admit that The Egghead holds a special place in my stomach because it was the first restaurant I ever visited in Isla Vista—and that's all it took. Now, it's not the reason I came to study at this fine institution, but it certainly didn't hurt. The bottom line is, whenever I get a hankering for breakfast, actually more often than not it's brunch time, served just the way I like, it's the one and only place I go. There is no way to leave without eating your fill, most of the time I need the helping mouth of my fellow eater just to clean off the plate. Basically, I never looked back after the first time — I just knew it was right.





New York Hero House An I.V. Classic

You can only eat so much pizza, y'know? After a week's worth of burritos, you want something different, don't you? If these questions provoke a resonating sense of kin-

ship, perhaps you should make the positive switch and include Isla Vista's New York Hero House. There's really nothing else like it around.

Nestled in the heart of

I.V.'s bustling downtown, situated perfectly for people watching on both Pardall and EdM, the Hero House is a feast for the heart, the eyes, the ears and the gullet. Let's start where it all started: the food. Each sandwich is blessed with an individual identity - you don't just belly up to the counter and order a meatball sub. On the contrary, you ask for a Melvin or a Marvin or my favorite, the Aunt Nellie.

This is the kind of thing I look for in an eatery style. Sure, IHOP has the "fresh and fruity" and Denny's has the "moon over my hammy," but these are corporate contri-vances. The Hero House offers sandwiches with personality. When you're given the chance to consume something with personality, my advice is to seize this opportunity and

shove it in your mouth! Aunt Nellie is a sausage and eggplant creation, and features the Hero House's trademark sauteed onions and peppers. If you want a sandwich that eats like a meal, this is the place to go. The sausage is not some shrink-wrapped kielbasa, it's got texture. Many of you out there might be put off by the concept of the meatball. This is understandable: The meatball is so easily defiled by ignorant cooks working for nationwide sandwich chains. The

meatballs at the Hero House, however, are powerful enough to overcome any memories of bad experiences you might have collected on your culinary journeys. It's good.

You can also get garlic bread and chips. And beer. When I first came to I.V., Hero House didn't serve beer. I went there anyway 'cause the food rocked and rolled. Now they serve beer, and let me tell you, there's nothing better than watching traffic go by, sippin' from the pitcher and chewin' on Aunt Nellie.

Another thing that puts the Hero House in a class by itself among I.V. eateries is the live music showcase. The Hero House is not afraid to offer up gritty tunes to accompany the vittles to satisfy your soul.

California has kind of developed a reputation for producing lightweights, what with nouvelle cuisine, diet sodas and fulltime aerobic instructors. This may be why it takes the East Coast sensibility of the Hero House to bring a compact density to the local scene. Like Scarlett O'Hara, once you sample the wares of the Hero House, you'll swear that (God as your witness) you'll never go hungry again.





When you walk into this mecca for snooker, caroms and the occasional slop, you notice the sheer length of the house — it really is a pool hall! Once your eyes move like maple syrup flowing toward the most golden of Belgian waffles, drifting longingly

past the dart boards and wide beverage case, it seems you can see forever in the expanses of green that spread out before you.

What, ho! Is that a fully stocked jukebox I spy? Why yes, an even greater part of the billiards experience is all the more heightened here at Johnny's. With all the selections one used to hear on a certain local radio station, as well as everything from Pearl Jam to Janis Joplin, the juke keeps the hall groovin'.

On the little shelves at the ends of each table you find white bowls complete with white bags of palmslicking, moisture-absorbing chalk, a convenience I wish I found elsewhere. But it seems only Johnny's has this necessary tool of the pool game, something I use so my cue doesn't start jerking on the skin between my thumb and shooting fingers.

There's always plenty of blue chalk for the cues, too, bolstering the blocks of green and white which make up Johnny's decor. I've played billiards at

Johnny's until the wee hours, after a concert, proving it to be the perfect cap-off to any evening. The hall is usually jumping during the after-dinner hours, full of eager men and women trying to clear their green slate clean, seeking a uniform, natural picture.


Of course, some people do it for money.
