

## A Mexican Treat: Cafe Vallarta

To most Californians Mexican food means tacos, burritos and enchiladas, usually served from a local fast food joint or perhaps an "authentic" tacqueria. Sadly they are missing out on what is perhaps one of the more eclectic mixes of styles, classical Mexican

cuisine. Santa Barbara's Cafe Vallarte appears to be just one of the area's many intimate restaurants from its frontage along Haley Street. Once inside, the decor takes one back to Mexico: whitew-ashed walls and arched celings are flanked by bright blue trim and beams, while the decorations vary from brightly-painted wooden fish carvings to the more esoteric woven baskets and

Cafe Vallarte does not just seem like Mexico from the atmosphere however the food is more than authentic. Restauranteur Justo Garcia and associate Lil-

iana Parra describe their food as a blend of early Mexican food and cooking styles with the influences of Spanish and French styles brought on by Mexico's colonial past.

Justo, a native of Monterrey, Mexico, has been providing his clientele gourmet Mexican specialities for over a year and a half now and in that short time has done quite a bit to shake up the local culinary establishment. Just last July his Caldo de Mariscos, a hearty seafood stew with shrimp, fish, octopus, mussels and vegetables took 1st Place at the Santa Barbara Bouillabaisse Festival, no small feat as the competition included chefs from 20 area restaurants, with such notables as the Four Seasons Biltmore and the Palace Cafe entered.

Caldo de Mariscos is but one of the splendid items on the extensive menu every day, however, which I found out the other day when a friend and I went there to see what all the fuss was about.

After gorging on fresh tortilla chips and a great green salsa, we started with appetizers from the tapas bar, choosing the Camarones al Mojo de Ajo, shrimp sauteed with garlic and lime. Many people actually make a meal out of tapas alone, choosing several selections from the 23 appetizers offered, and eating it with rice and beans. Although we were tempted by the calamari fajitas, the skewered chicken, the mussels in wine, herbs and chile, and so many others, we opted for entrees.

I had one of the specials of the day, Camarones a la Crema, shrimp in a cream and chipotle sauce made with red chiles, and it was superb. It was complemented by a house salad (with a unique olive oil and lime dressing), rice, veget-ables and tortillas, all of which left me more than satiated.

My friend opted for Pescado Yucateco, a grilled

fish fillet seasoned with achiote and lime, served with Cafe ·Vallarte's own Vallarte sauce — a spicy, green chile mixture which simply defies description rice, black beans and tortillas.

The menu has something for everyone, from typical Mexican favorites such as chile verde or chile relleno to the more exotic Cochinita Pibil, a Mayan pork feast slowly cooked in banana peels. There are numerous beef and chicken dishes, and vegetarian ones as well, all of which is cooked without lard or additives.

So if you crave South of the border gourmet food but want something a little dif-ferent than the average Mexican meal, Cafe Vallarte
