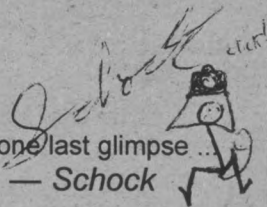
Therefore, as photo editor, I promise to continue to give you the best images this staff can provide, with a continuing focus on quality and accuracy.
