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Bar-Hopping Without a Net

A MULTI-PART JOURNEY BY BALL Diepenbrock Sall

(Editor's Note: Since this column is intended as a sampling of local bars, nightclubs and other late night hot spots, a one-shot deal is not going to cover it. The hangover alone would ruin the quality, not to mention the inability of any one person to truly get a feel for the best this town has to offer. So, look forward to additional columns in future issues of Dining and Entertainment.)

Today's Goal: Perhaps your classic, or at least basic, State Street and Goleta pub crawl, ideal for 21st birthdays or to impress your when out-of-town visitors arrive.

The night begins, as many do, with a stop at the Elephant Bar, off Hollister near Fairview and the local Goleta movie house. Stop in for dinner or just a quick shot at the bar, but remember to have at least one margarita and perhaps a long island ice tea before you leave. Mostly, the Elephant Bar is a nice place for a nice time. No serious crowds, and smiling waiters and waitresses to serve up the beverages.

No prohibitive prices here, although it's not a free ride unless you're 21, and that only lasts for one drink at one place for one night, barring illegal alterations of your driver's license. They have a good selection of import beers and will mix just about any drink you can think of, even if they can't figure out why the name of the place, part of a chain, is for a jungle type animal. Of course, you can sit outside, so maybe that's why.

After a few drinks, and perhaps a meal to buffer the excesses of the evening to come, drop off the wimps and proceed to stop number two: Spike's Place, home of imported beer and the celebrated "Around the World Trip." You may never leave the physical location, but Spike's beers bring you around the world and back. The trip is a collection of beers from each of the seven continents where beer is brewed by the best and the worst. Some of these beers will make you wonder why you ever drank Coors or Meisterbrau

The selection is probably without peer, and the crowd is usually pretty relaxed. Sit outside or at one of the small tables. Or grab a booth for some serious beer competition. But, no matter what condition you're in, don't forget to knock a few more beers off your official Spike's Around the World card.

But, if you want to hit the hot State Street spots, move on fast or you'll find it's already time for the last call.

Next on the list? What else but Joe's Cafe, located on the corner of State and Cota, just a short walk from the restaurant of restaurants, the Palace Cafe.

At Joe's, you usually have to wait in a line to get in, if you arrive a little after 10 p.m. Now, the sign on the door may say something like Room Capacity: 98 people, but it never seems like that few. Around the sides of the place, people sit and try to eat food. Swarming around them, setting their drinks on their tables and probably using their ashtrays is

this multitude of humanity.

The drinks are served fast and usually pretty strong, but never do a kamikaze, slammer and tequilla sunrise combo in less than three minutes. I've seen the 30 second show and it's just not that pretty.

Meanwhile, the place is rocking with all these people and it has subsequentially gained a reputation as a singles joint. Never one to refute rumors, I nevertheless did ask a friend what she thought. According to her version, Joe's is a great bar for groups of people out together, and especially for the

big two-one. But then, she also told she met her boyfriend of two years there as well. So, who knows?

However, this is supposed to be a crawl and we're barely even doing that. Next stop is all the way at the end of the strip, nothing other than Rocky Galenti's — a hip name for a bar located under a hotel that sounds like something of a 70's Eagles' song. Although the name Rocky's somehow brings pictures of topless and buffed male waiters to the mind, the reality (thankfully) is something else altogether. You walk into the bar (after passing the bouncers suc-

Now, from a rather hangoverish experience (not mine, of course) I can tell that you want to start the night with a couple of double watermelons. These are not fruit drinks, but an alchemist's delight of a mixture. The bartender throws together Vodka, Southern Comfort, Amaretto and some other arcane mixtures and you get a drink that tastes like a watermelon Jolly Rancher but packs a kick like a cornered donkey. Wow.

cessfully) and you see this extremely long and skinny room

leading to the band and dance floor at the back.

Of course you can get all the usuals from the well-stocked bar, but why when two or three of these puppies will have you howling at the next full moon. Now, Rocky's also features a number of bands each night.

Now, after this delightful stop, the crawl continues. Rather than attempting to drive — a ridiculous idea if you've followed us this far — just walk across the street to a spot set back from the same side of State. This is the Long Bar and at this point you shouldn't be able to see all the way down.

The last time I was there I asked simply for two types of drinks, their strongest and their smoothest. The first appeared to be a slammer, joy of many and undoing of many others. One of our group took three tries at it (it was her first time with something of this nature), while the rest of us simply did the destruction in one.

The smoothest drink turned out to be a nice surprise. The man behind the bar poured some Grand Marnier cognac over a ripe cherry and served it up. It packs a whallop, but what a way to go. The bar itself is spacious, with tables for the more relaxed customers. However, sometimes you may run into a line that stretches for quite a bit of other interested parties. One those days, or after you make it in, just walk the short distance to its State Street neighbor, the Cancun Cantina. Now, here's a place to dance, drink and make all sorts of general merriment. Unfortunately, for today, it's our last stop as the 1:30 last call chime begins to ring

At the Cantina, you want the margaritas or kamikazes. Or at least that's my suggestion, the two drinks being the one's I have mostly partaked of there. Both are strong (especially when you ask for doubles), and both can be loads of fun when unleashed upon an unsuspecting new drinker.

The bar features some hip bands as well, with Reggae on the Friday night I and my small band of merry-makers stopped by. It, like Rocky's, has a weeklong slate of different music and atmosphere.

Now, a word of caution. Don't just jump in the car and zoom off to I.V. or wherever. You're close enough to the beach to take a long walk while people get the drinks out of their system, if you don't have a Designated Driver. Do this. If people get sick (as they have in the past), they can get sick on the beach and not in your car.
