SOHO-SO HOT

No one quite knows how to classify the food at Soho in downtown Santa Barbara. Nancy Weiss, Chef/owner of the restaurant calls her food "international homestyle cuisine." Paul Angeloni, pantry and pastry chef at our very own faculty club and a Soho patron, uses the phrase, "health-oriented rustic California cuisine." The S.B. Independent classifies the food as "Continental." I have coined my own term to describe the food: "So hot!"

So, hey, you might ask, what makes the food so hot at Soho? The variety and the love that goes into the preparation, I would reply. Nancy genuinely cares about keeping her customers happy. This is manifested in the wholesome, unpretentious food.

Soho has a totally open kitchen that extends out into the dining room. I recommend sitting at the counter at the edge of the kitchen where you can talk

with Nancy and actually watch as she whips up your meal. You can practically point to any of the ingredients behind the counter and ask her to use them in preparing your dish. She is there to please your palate and is anxious to adjust any dish to your personal specifications. Easy on the butter or salt? No problem! She gives a gourmet meaning to the phrase, "Have it your way."

Entrees at Soho are a culinary bargain. They include fresh bread as well as soup or salad. Far and away the best dish is the grilled chicken tacos, served with thick blue corn tortillas made on the premises, tomato and tomatillo (green tomato) salsa, black beans, guacamole and sour cream (\$8).

Due to the satisfying portions doled out by Nancy and her assistant, Susan, ordering an appetizer is hardly necessary. However, when I read "whole roasted

garlic," I began salivating until a head of steaming garlic garnished with home dried tomatoes and fresh thyme was set before me. I slowly squished the gooey olive oily garlic onto some crusty french bread and a slice of the tomato. The salty flavor of the tomato, the earthy, warm garlic and the crunchy bread all erupted into a glorious symphony in my mouth.

Desserts, of course, are homemade, with a Soho version of flan, creme caramel, as the house specialty. There is also an extensive wine and imported

beer list to choose from.

Nancy is a UCSB success story. After graduating in 1982 from UCSB, she was head chef at Zelo before opening her own Soho. She is friendly and loves to "see who I'm feeding." Don't be surprised if she comes out from the kitchen to chat with you. She's also concerned about keeping her customers healthy. She says she doesn't cook with a lot of fat because "I can't. I nibble all day long." So, don't be worried about treating yourself to a Soho meal. It will nourish your palate, your soul, and your body.

Though it might be a bit off the beaten path, the Cold Spring Tavern is a hidden treasure worth discovering.

Located about 10 miles from campus, snuggled away in the San Marcos hills, the Tavern is an eating experience unlike any other in the Santa Barbara area.

The decor is genuine, or as close to genuine as this eater could tell, 19th century western Americana.

But so what, you're probably asking. What about the food? Well, what about it? It's great, that's all. If you're coming all this way, you'll probably be prepared to spend an arm and a leg on the food fare. Well, put away that home loan, buy back the car and get the kids out of the workhouse because, while at the upper end of most people's price range, the Tavern is not unreasonable, considering what you get. And oh, what you do get!

Let's start with the homemade dill seed bread, served hot and in abundance with each meal. Then how about that fresh salad. It's tasty and attractive. But the

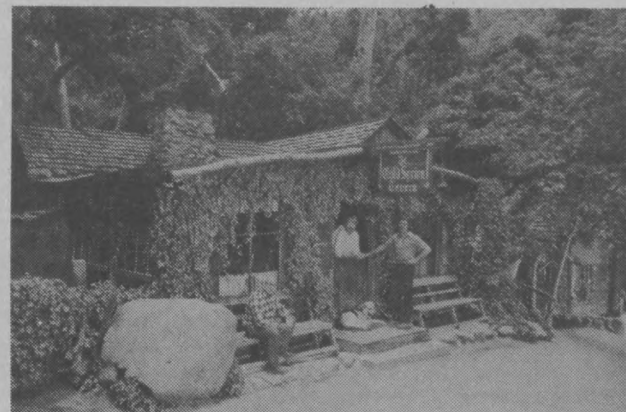
real wonder about the Tavern is its selection of entrees.

I had the steak, which was delicious. With it came mixed veggies and my choice of either a baked potato or rice. Needless to say, I opted for the potato. My good friend had the halibut picatta and assures me that no finer fish has he tasted in the Santa Barbara area.
