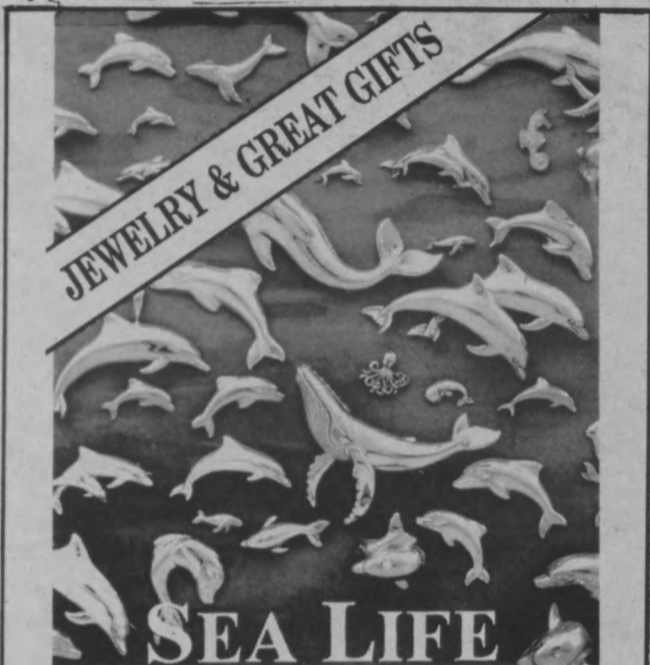

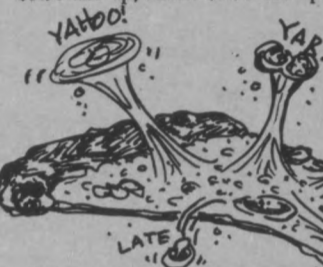

Monty's is Great, Bar None!

There's something really satisfying about a good bar. Stripped down of ferns and pretensions like the early Rolling Stones, they exist as clubhouses for adults, places for people who've been workin' hard all week to go "Whoooo!"

The other night I had the good fortune to stumble onto Monty's, a fine neighborhood bar in that netherland between Goleta and Santa Barbara.

OK, so it really isn't a

netherland. In fact it's in the Magnolia Center, next to Woody's on Hollister. But like all good neighborhood bars, its red neon light shines above an otherwise unimposing sign:

Cocktails, it says.

And cocktails it means. Big ones, short ones, li'l ones, long ones. Everything from Long Island Iced Teas to those Screaming Faked Orgazmathingamawhatzits on the Beachcombers.

My drinking partners belied up to the bar. One ordered a Whisky Sour and one ordered a Coke. Be-

Which meant I was, of course, the designated drinker. I had my usual: J.D. on the rocks. And I don't mean John Davidson. Went down smooth and settled hot, like jalapenos on furlough. Made me talk in terse sentences.

One of the patrons walked over to the jukebox and selected everything from Cream to Bobby Brown. He was wearing sunglasses and it was dim. It was also a quarter to midnight. Monty's is that kind of place.

But then she ordered some kind of weird drink she said she had back east. Holly called it a Paralyzer, but the barkeep misunderstood and brought a Budweiser.

"No, no. It's got tequila, Kaluha, Coke and Milk," Holly told the barkeep. The Bud looked infinitely more appetizing. I started to think about the psychoactive properties of tequila and milk mixed together, but Holly insisted that it was actually good and good for you.

I decided to go over to the famous Monty's pool table and shoot me some pools. Great table, with good response, good felt and good cues. I am, after all, the executive producer of that late-night "Learn Billiards in 20 Minutes" videocassette.

After waxing some booty and waxing poetic for a while, I decided to play Monty's "Whirlwind" pin-

ball machine. It's great, with these droogy little discs that spin in the middle, altering the ball's path. It also has a little fan on top that blows when you get a bonus.

Monty's jukebox is something to behold — a wonder of modern tech that has the biggest selection I've ever seen. Little Steven? You got it. Stevie Wonder? You got it. The Wonderfols? Well... I didn't see them, but I might have missed 'em. The only thing that jukebox didn't have was Gregorian chants.

I knocked back another J.D. (not John Denver) and punched a bunch of random numbers on the machine. Patsy Cline oozed out of the speakers and I felt both good and at home. 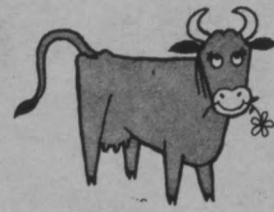

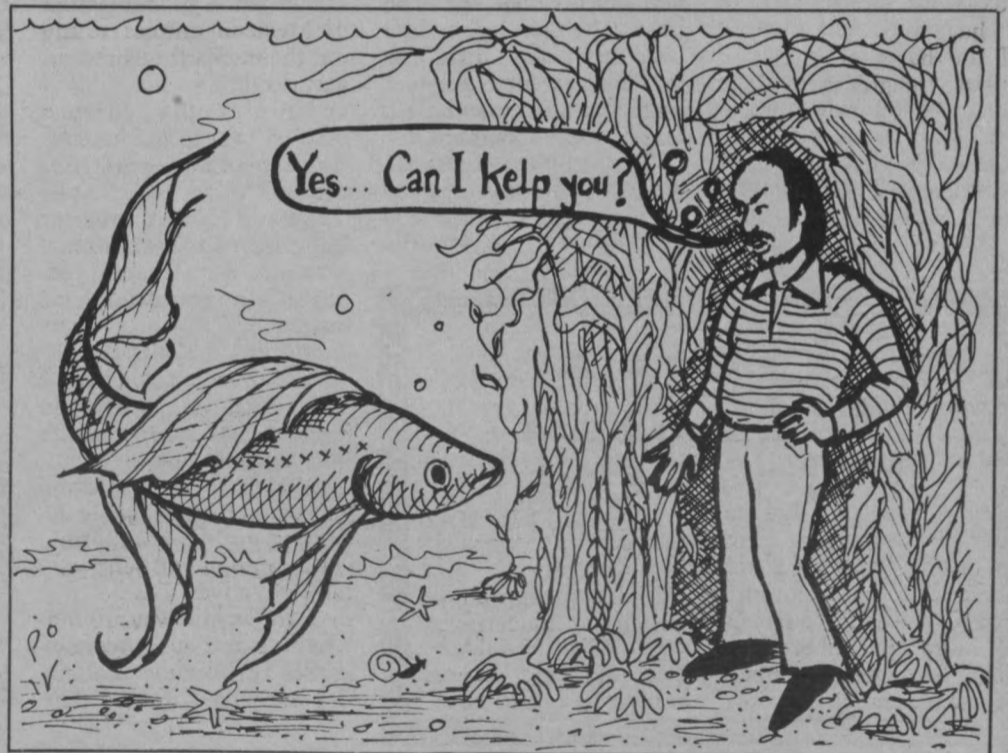

State&A is Good!

It had been a week since the accident, and Max and I were looking for a good time. We went to the State & A. Let's hear it for me and Max.

I have to tell you straight off the bat that if you're looking for greasy, spoiled food at ridiculously inflated prices in an atmosphere that is designed to make you sing the theme song to "The Conqueror Worm," then the State & A is the wrong place to go. Why? Because the State & A offers some of the best American food at great prices this side of Oxnard. It's a quality, dyed-in-the-wool good restaurant. It's food and service are as solid as the ground it rests on.

Max once told me that the proof of the pudding is in the tasting. He's right, of course, but that's not the issue here. The issue has to deal more with hot chicken wings. These wings, dipped in some nice ranch dressing,

give me a good feeling throughout my body. That's proof enough for me.

Oftentimes, when I'm downtown with Max shopping for household items or going to see the latest Steven Seagal movie (love that man!), I have a hard time deciding where to eat. The places that look good are too expensive and the places that look cheap are really just as expensive as some other place that looked nicer! Also, consistency is apparently not a virtue that most of these restaurants strive to achieve. For example, sometimes a restaurant will be good and the next time you go, it won't be as good. This is the kind of inconsistency I'm talking about here.

But not the State & A, at least judging by the number of times I have been there. They always try to serve you up right, and I have not been let down yet.

Their menu is pretty comprehensive concerning the food that you should — as a sane, educated person — want to be eating. Nice, big

salads of normal tradition and a few of strange invention — all good, as far as I can tell. A fair range of hamburgers, big ones I might add, to make the meat-lover in you stand up and walk across the room and smile annoyingly at the nearest vegetarian. A good selection of Mexican entrees round out the menu, though in no way do they complete it! A quiche of the day and some nice chicken dishes can take care of that order. And they do.

But my favorite thing at the State & A is the hot chicken wings, and you can't take that away from me. The wings may be listed as an appetizer, but a double order is a meal to make my Uncle Cliff wax culinary.

Food may be the sustenance of a restaurant, but by no means is it the end all and be all of the State & A. They've got a bar and drink selection that will send you home in a cab. The bartenders know their way around a bar... and they know how to make drinks, too! At least one of them — the one that

was working when I came in last — spins and twirls the bottles before making your drink.

Some restaurants offer patios as comfortable as the State & A, but few offer the great live entertainment that the State & A does. One time me and Max saw a great acoustic band with four handsome men in tuxedos doing neat harmony. What a good idea.

Sometimes the State & A is referred to as a "Santa Barbara tradition." I think a visit would clue you in as to why. It's pretty State Street friendly — the perfect stop after a movie date.

And for the college student surviving on money from Mom and Anisq' Oyo' park handouts, the price couldn't be righter if Bob Barker was your waiter. Truth be known, it's actually quite inexpensive. But it's really nice, too. Check it out.

Did someone say "Chinese?"

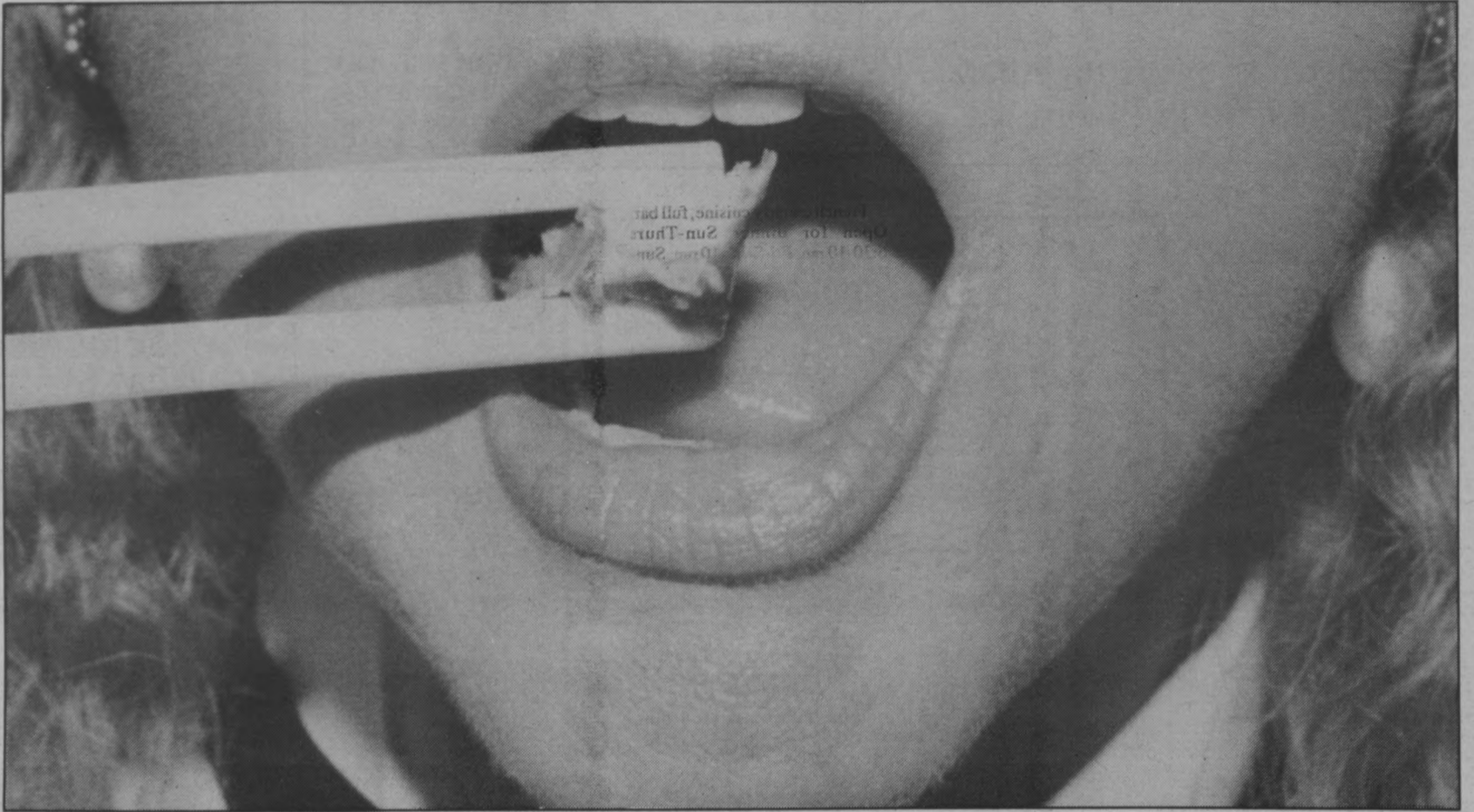
Did someone ask, "Where can I get some of that Chinese food that's so good you can't put down your chopsticks?"
