# SB Sweeps to Find Winning Ways Against Big West Foes

■ Team Comes Together in Victory Against Utah State



The UCSB men's soccer team picked up its first win in three weeks on Friday, beating Cal Poly San Luis Obispo at Harder Stadium

The win was an important one for the Gauchos, although they are out of playoff contention. Despite the lack of postseason possibilities, the team is trying to finish out the season on an upswing.

"It's just a first step in building more of our confidence," said Santa Barbara freshman goalkeeper Trent Ulicny. "It proved to ourselves that we can

Mark Arya stressed a more aggressive style of play in the game, committing three of his players to the forward position. The move paid off with multiple scoring chances.

"That had to be a factor," Ulicny said. "We've been practicing a lot on finishing. Even with two forwards, we were getting the opportunities, but we weren't finishing. The extra man helps us do that."

Both Gaucho goals were scored in the first half. Senior midfielder Kristian Berre put Santa Barbara on the scoreboard with an assist from senior forward Ryan Schomberg in the 34th minute.

Tarvin will still serve out


her duty as captain and attend all team functions, including games.




