


Perfect Fish 'n' Chips & More

Every time I go to the Crabby Lobster, I worry. Not because I'm afraid the Not because I'm afraid the food will not live up to my greedy expectations (it always surpasses my wildest dreams of savory satisfaction), but rather my fear is that I'll get there and the place will be so packed with piscaphile patrons that I won't be able to belly up to any one of my favorite tables. Actually, every rite tables. Actually, every table at the Crabby Lobster is my favorite.

Nevertheless, I experience a bizarre mixture of regret and euphoria. The euphoria comes because there's always room for me to pursue my own brand of happiness — fish and chips done right! The regret is that the ready access to each absolutely deli-cious item on Crabby Lob-ster's tantalizing menu seems somehow unjust, although I selfishly covet any piece of it that I can.
You see, Goleta's greatest seafood restaurant de-

serves to be packed with customers every hour of every day, except when the excellent help needs some breathing time. It's not that the place is always empty; I often see my fellow searchers questing for clam or lusting for lobster when I go down with my faithful gal Odessa by my side. But there aren't enough people clued in to the glory of the Crabby is dry and flat; it's not a Lobster for me to feel that pretty thing. At the Crabby all is right with the world. The last time Odessa and I went there was, indisputably, the highlight of the past six months. She had been feeling a little blue, as she's a fragile flower who doesn't take stress without bruising. An end was put to that in short order; in fact, the order was so short I can repeat it to you in its entirety: "Two Super Combos, lemonade, ice tea."



In my meditations on why, perhaps, some of you resist what is to me an all-consuming siren call to go down to the Plaza on Hollister and throw caution to the wind, I have come up

with two possibilities.

The first is that perhaps your idea of fish and chips is based on a lifetime of palate abuse by people who served you "fish sticks" (or even, yechh, "stix") as if that was at all a satisfactory resolution to hunger, much less a proper introduction to seafood.

With fish sticks, the breading is pasty, the fish is dry and flat; it's not a

breading is crisp, but well herbed and oh-soflavorful. Even more entic-ing, the fish is perfect beyond a perfect 10, a perfect host and a perfect accompaniment all put together.



All members of the bivalve family make some damn good eatin'. If this idea makes you a trifle squeamish, get the hell over it or else you are missing out on a treat equivalent to the Seven Wonders of the World times 100 with a fifth of fine Bourbon thrown in!

The second reason why you might not be heading out the door to go to Crabby Lobster already is that there's something about the name that rankles you. Perhaps you get an image of an ornery and pernicious crustacean coming to lash out at you with snapping red claws, and this puts you off. To this I have to say: What do you do with a lobster whose behavior you're unhappy with? You EAT it!! This you can do to your heart's content at the Crabby Lobster.



I asked my friends. We all agreed that our plates of pasta were the best we'd had in Santa Barbara.


Chia, who usually never finishes what she orders, cleaned her entire plate and proclaimed, "Put a fork in me, I'm done."


