My Appalachian ancestors rarely ate at restaurants. Yep, when they went out for dinner, they made sure to bring their trusty hound dog and a .22 rifle.

The greatest aspect of hunting for supper was that there was no way of knowing what would be on the plate at the end of the evening. If it was an average night, my great-great uncle Hephaestus may have dined on rabbit or

warped by moonshine, he may have feasted on venison or wild boar.

There is a small eatery not too far from here where the fine delicacies mentioned above are offered on a regular basis, and the atmosphere is exactly that of a 19th-century cabin. Tucked deep in the Santa Ynez Mountains, the haven I speak of is the

Cold Springs Tavern.
The entire restaurant still has the same rustic interior as it did when it was built more than a century ago. Originally frequented by stagecoach passengers en route to Santa Barbara from the east, the menu is adorned with rules concerning "prairie schooner" etiquette.

Of course, raw history isn't all the Cold Springs Tavern features. The full bar and thick wine list are a welcome sight for any weary traveler, unless, of course, they are the designated driver (the long and winding road to the Tavern is not advisable for the tipsy). What's more,

> But the sole reason why a restaurant exists is the food, which is precisely why the Cold Springs Tavern has existed for so long. As I mentioned earlier, this is one restaurant where you'll find delica-cies out of the ordinary, so when you go there make sure to be bold and try something you've never had before.

> I ordered the venison, a meat I've wanted to try for years, and was certainly not let down with my first bite (or the following 17, for that matter). Marinated in a rich red wine sauce, the plate was also graced with garlic mashed potatoes and freshly baked bread.

My companion, not being of mountain breeding, ordered the tamer yet still scrumptious seafood pasta, along with a salad and steamed vegetables. After a little goading, she tried a bite of the deer and also found it to be quite succulent, if not a little

chewy.

Although we were full and quite satisfied when the meal was done, we could not resist splitting a slice of bourbon pecan pie a la mode. I don't know how accessible ice cream was in Santa Barbara County a century ago, considering that this region is notoriously poor for natural ice production, but we didn't let that creative anachronism get in the way of the pie we agreed was the best we'd ever had.

And so, the next time I feel like roughing it without actually going out into the wilderness and setting traps and getting dirty and whatnot, I'll head right back to the Cold Springs Tavern. Uncle Hephaestus would be proud.
