So what exactly does "RG" stand for? This is a question, I feel, that most people ask themselves as they walk by the small-but-enticing State Street eatery. After eating there, I would imagine that most people say, "RG's stands for quality and delicious burgers and an uncommonly satisfying State Street dining alternative."

Obviously.

But I want to speak more specifically here. What does the letter "R" followed by the letter "G" stand for literally? My first thought I threw out immediately: "Hello Goody" — just wouldn't be a good name for a restaurant, and it doesn't come very close to capturing that certain something that RG's. And I went through all of the other ones I could think of (Reaper Grim, Mothers Gibb, Rotund Gilt, Raspy Gerald, Rasperry Gutter-snipe, and all the others), but none of them seemed to have anything to do with RG's Giant Hamburgers.

So, I called them up and asked them. The man who answered the phone said he didn't know either. I decided right then that I would go downtown and have another avocado bacon cheeseburger and figure it out for myself.

So I did. And I came to a conclusion. There is only one thing that "RG" can stand for in my opinion, and that is "Really Great" Giant Hamburgers!

Check it out. It's the truth. These giant hamburgers they got are not made with some small thin patty and a squirt of ketchup on a bun-looking bun. These things they cook up mean serious business. Serious business like nobody's business. No funny business involved here. Rockefeller

wishes he meant as much business as these Giant Hamburgers.

They got a third of a pound of fresh hamburger. Quarter pounders take a back seat! Go somewhere else if you want a small burger. I mean it! You want bacon? Get some bacon! You want guacamole? Just ask! But specialty hamburgers is not all that RG's Giant Hamburgers has to offer.

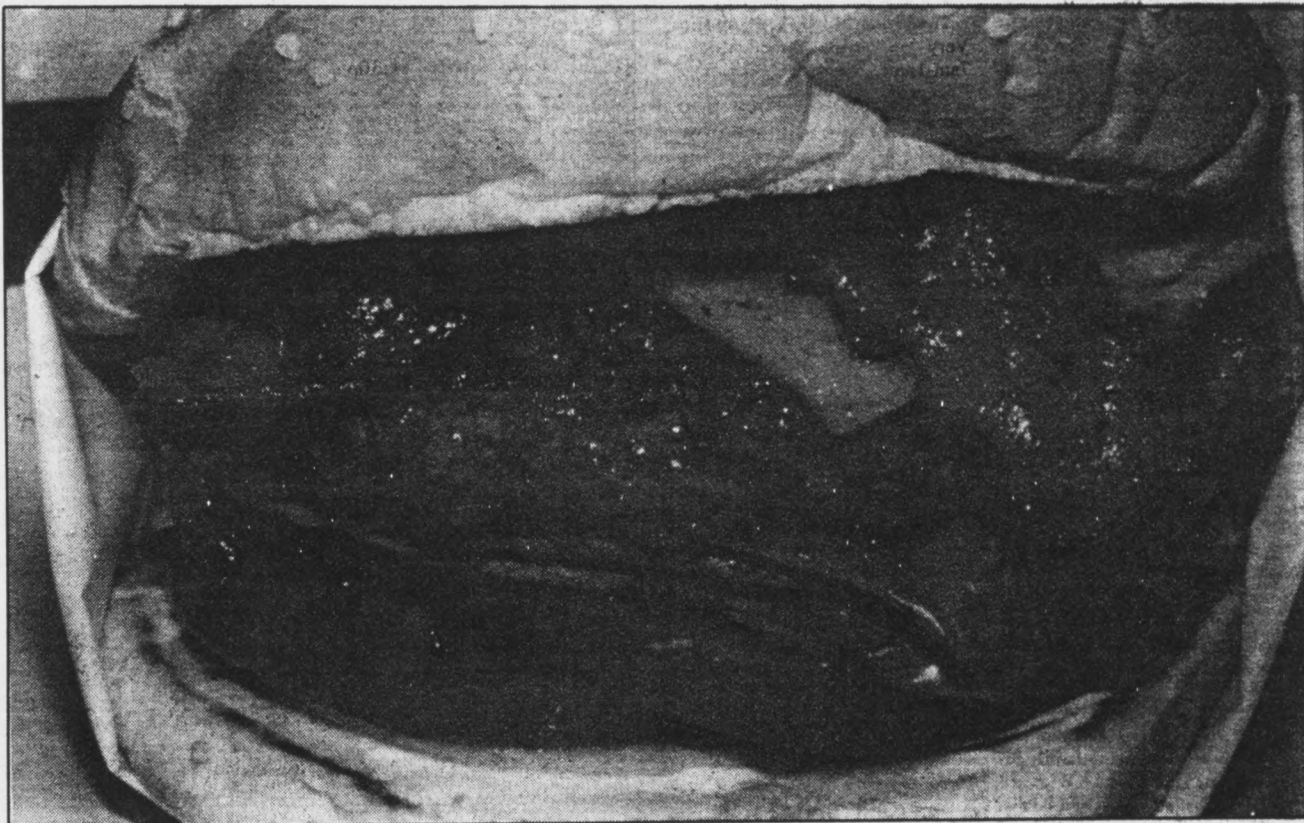
They have some of the best waffle fries in the business. And regular fries, too, done up crispy and golden, making the ketchup taste better than it should. Hot dogs. The whole works.

You may be saying to yourself — and you shouldn't be — that this sounds like a normal burger joint. If you are, then you're wrong (I told you that you shouldn't say that!). Even a casual glance as you pass it by on your usual State Street stroll should convince you that it's not. But if you wander in, you'll know for sure.

The walls are covered with really neat, rare-looking photographs of movie stars and rock stars and generally famous people. It's actually quite entertaining to walk about the restaurant looking at them. But that's not the most of it. The most of it is the back patio area. It is truly one of the greatest spots on State Street, either because of or in spite of the fact that you know that you are still on State Street. Let me try to explain. It doesn't look like State Street or feel like it at all. You get a strange and entirely pleasurable sense of not really knowing where you are. It's really cool!

So check it out. I think the fact that they are always voted the best hamburger in town should tell you something, if I haven't already.

But perhaps the most transcendent experience of all is a pasta dinner at The Big Yellow House in Summerland, which is located a mere 25 minutes south of UCSB down Highway 101.

linguini in creative sauces), steaks and salads. But call in advance about the dinner menu, because it changes about once a week.

For myself, my British genes kicked in and told me to order a helping of fish and chips, featuring a fresh filet of Red Snapper. When the order came, I found to my surprise that it included

poppy seed, and spicy fries, too.

It looked like a feast. Two big slabs of fish and a mound of fries. But my waitress informed me that there'd been a mistake; the fish had not been properly weighed, and they were preparing me an additional serving. I didn't complain.

Then, stuffed to the gills

with four filets of Red Snapper, I sheepishly ordered slice of Bailey's Irish Cream Cheesecake. Never mind what I said before about apple pie. This is the real thing.

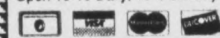

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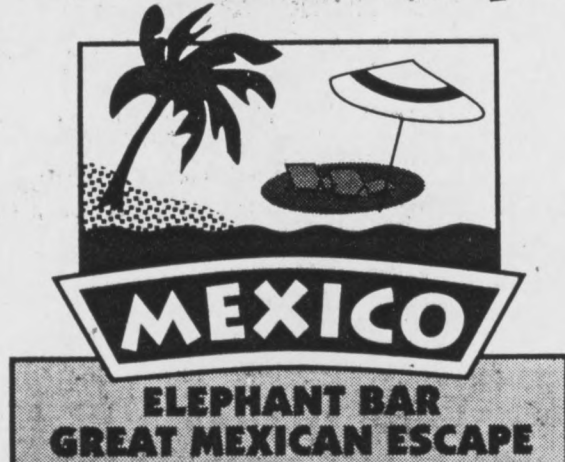

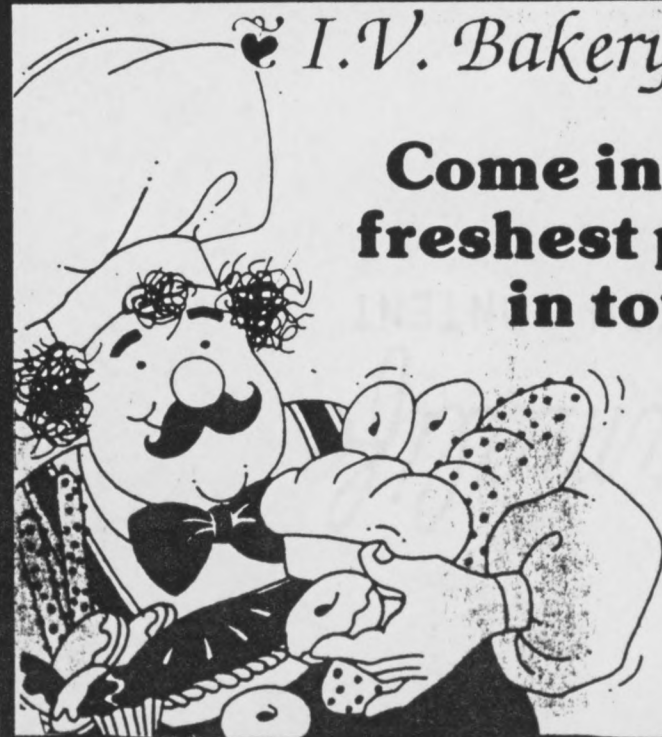
