Dinner offers an expanded menu of seafood, pasta dishes (fettucini and

linguini in creative sauces), steaks and salads. But call in advance about the dinner menu, because it changes about once a week.

The Big Yellow House is located at 108 Pierpont in Summerland. Open for lunch and dinner every day. Phone 969-4140.





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
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
