

Gaucho Women Trample Anteaters, Forget the Titans

This past weekend, against Big West cellar dwellers UC Irvine and Cal State Fullerton, Santa Barbara women's volleyball fans finally had a chance to see what ugly volleyball looks like.

But it wasn't the Gauchos (22-6 overall, 13-2 in the Big West) who were ugly, for they were able to sweep both the Anteaters and the Titans in three games.

"These are two matches that we are really happy to put behind us," sophomore outside hitter Brooke Niles said after Saturday night's victory. "I know it sounds corny, but anytime you can get a win in league it is big. We only have one more league match left, and if we win and [University of the] Pacific loses, then we win the Big West. That would be huge."

Even with their sights set on the Tigers, UCSB needed to play well to get past Irvine on Friday night to have any hope of winning a league title. Without the services of freshman outside hitter Erica Menzel, Santa Barbara knew it could ill afford a slip up against a team they should beat.

"We knew what we had to do, and we did it," UCSB Head Coach Kathy Gregory said. "They were a great defensive team, but their setting wasn't that good, and we played well. Missy [Blackshire] was great for us, but tonight belonged to Danielle [Bauer],"

Blackshire, who transferred from Washington State this season, has not seen much court time. In the third game she was subbed in and made several key plays resulting in Gaucho points. Sophomore middle blocker Bauer also bolstered the attack for Santa Barbara with 14 kills and a team-high 16 digs.

It wasn't just Blackshire and Bauer playing well against Irvine (8-16, 1-12). Everyone got into the act for the Gauchos, including outside hitters Courtney Guerra and Brieanna Lampe.

Both players had nine kills with no errors for the match. With those two playing well, along with Niles and Menzel, when she returns from her injury, UCSB will have four very good outside hitters in their arsenal for the upcoming NCAA Tournament.

The result of the all-around performance by the Gauchos was a 15-2, 15-8, 15-6 romp of the Anteaters.

Although Saturday night's match was against a different team, it may as well have been a replay of the Irvine match. With the exception of a better setter and a better offense, the match against Cal State Fullerton (9-18, 3-10) was almost identical to that of the previous evening. Santa Barbara dictated the flow of the game and won in three straight sets.

"We had some big leads, and we gave them up," Gregory said, "but I am glad that we won. We need to stop letting teams back into games with offensive errors, and if we can do that, we will be just fine in the tournament."

One of the keys to victory was the serving and defense of freshman Casey McFarland, who had three service aces and made a number of clutch digs in the back court. With her explosive play off of the bench and everyone else playing smart volleyball, UCSB rolled to a 15-6, 15-8, 15-10 sweep.

"I like the way that this team is going right now," junior All-American setter Brooke Rundle said. "We have a lot of confidence, and we are just playing really well."

Gregory reiterated Rundle's sentiments. "Our middles are playing exceptionally, both on offense and defense. So now, our defensive specialists have to play better to get into the games. And we have four good outside hitters and a good setter. ... It is just a great situation for me to be in as a coach. Whoever I put in is going to play well. This team is looking stronger now than it has all season, and this is when we need to peak, heading into the tournament."

'Free' Agents?

The free agent market officially declared open season on baseball over the weekend, which means as much to most major league teams as a vote in Florida. Baseball insiders predict that shortstop Alex Rodriguez will shatter this year's market by signing a \$200 million deal, a price tag that most teams' gold cards simply won't approve.

Only the Yankees, Dodgers, Mets, Red Sox, Braves and Orioles even dare consider such a splurge. Years of salary inflation have dramatically changed the face of baseball to the point that the pool of teams in the majors has evolved into two extremes: those with shallow bank accounts, and those with deep pockets.

Small-market franchises run their teams prudently and carefully; they fix their problems by developing players, making trades and firing incompetent personnel. In contrast, big market franchises expect that merely throwing money at

problems will fix everything.

Last year, it was Shawn Green at \$84 million. The year before, it was Kevin Brown at \$100 million. (The Dodgers signed both players, and still didn't make the playoffs.)

The problem of salary inflation has plagued baseball since the dawn of free agency and has been the root of player strikes that have deeply bruised the sport. The problem is not the players; Alex Rodriguez will not be holding a pistol to Yankees' boss George Steinbrenner's head when he receives a \$220 million offer from the World Champions.


Teams like the Dodgers and Diamondbacks, who are naïve enough to believe that a high payroll translates to a trophy, are the source of the problem. Small-market teams can only stand helpless and watch as these teams throw their Monopoly money at players and inflate salaries every year.

Countless people have said that baseball has changed from a sport to a business. Big market franchises must realize that to win at the sport, you have to run a good business.







Ticket Distribution Info
