Elephant Bar Restaurant

Amazing is the only word that pops into my mind when I try to describe the Elephant Bar Restaurant. I have been a student at UCSB for four years now, and by far my favorite restaurant has been the E-Bar. It has the best selection of salads, appetizers, entrees and specialty bar drinks. I was hoping to have a final opportunity to eat there once more before my dreaded graduation, so I jumped at the opportunity to write this restaurant review. For fun, my date and I decided to sit at the bar where we were able to order our complete meal. Our reason for doing this was so we could watch the ball-game. We started our feast with two *Elephant Rampage* drinks which were sweet and secretly hid three different liquors in it. It was great! Then we ordered the Pan Pacific spring rolls, which I highly recommend. For dinner, I am a big fan of the fish tacos, which are grilled rather than fried. My lovely date ordered the oriental chicken salad, a good size meal for any eater. Both entrees were reasonably priced at \$7.95 and both of these were devoured almost immediately to make room for the famous E-Bar mud pie. This delicious chunk of pie stands at about eight inches tall and could easily feed a small army.

This restaurant option is convenient for all students. E-Bar is located right behind the airport on the corner of Hollister and Firestone. The E-Bar is perfect for a date or large party. I celebrated my 21st birthday there because we got a nice private room and I wanted to include a large number of people. For Greeks, E-Bar is also a great place for hosting date parties. The atmosphere is nice and the wait staff is extremely friendly. I give the E-Bar a full five stars and if you haven't eaten there yet, where have you been hiding?

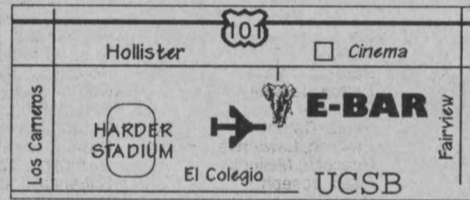
