Want Italian? Baltieri's Has Ticket!

Don't Be Very Wary About Baltieri's!

It has been said that Santa Barbara has more restaurants per capita than any other city in California, with the possible exception of Castroville, which has no less than fifteen Denny's and an assortment of artichoke-themed eateries. But to get away from Castroville (many have tried, I presume) and to talk about Santa Barbara: what a lot of restaurants!

We have so many "La Hicici Blah Blah's Donuts and Seafood" and "Doo-pie's Beef" around town, that choosing a restaurant is about as hard as Metallica. And even if you narrow it down to what style you want, you still have 765 restaurants to choose from. This is especially true of Italian food.

Everybody loves Italian food. It's just a fact. If you come across someone who doesn't like Italian food, you can tell him he is obsolete — you may even get far in the argument that he doesn't exist at all!

That's why, after searching far and close, I can hereby recommend Baltieri's as a consistently fine, well-priced Italian choice. Sometimes, when you go

to a random Italian restaurant and look at the prices, you think, "Well, the food must be really good here or they must give you a lot, because I've seen spaghetti in the stores and it seems relatively cheap, so I don't know why they would dare charge so much for simple pasta and sauce unless it was really good or unless they give you a lot." Then you get the food and you taste it and look around the room and tell the waitress in a sarcastic tone that: "I didn't know Chef Boyardee was the chef here!" Then everyone is embarrassed and sad and you don't leave a big tip and you peel out of the driveway like Boss Hogg was on your tail.

I know this kind of thing happens at some Italian restaurants, but I tell you now that it doesn't happen at Baltieri's and I can also tell you why. It's a combination of elements that make for a positive Italian dining experience. First of all, when you walk in, you get a head full of ambience. Not that overdone, we-will-now-try-to-trick-you-into-thinking-you-are-in-Italy-now kind of way, that some places try and fail to do. Baltieri's let's you know you're in an Italian restaurant, but also let's you know that your in one

of the most relaxing, comfortable, and conversational parts of Goleta. Then, when you settle down with some wine and peruse the menu, you start thinking just the opposite of what I was talking about before, namely, you may think: "Oh, these prices are so low that the food couldn't possibly be as

good as I had hoped." There you would be wrong, because Baltieri's can caesar salad all the way to the bank, and their very, very good pesto is so large that it makes a wonderful lunch the next day. What I mean to say is: A) it's large food, B) it's delicious food, C) it's food you couldn't make at

home, even with the help of Chef Boyardee or his friend from the military, General Mills.

I guess the best way to describe it is, Baltieri's gives you a dining experience that is relaxing and spiritually and physically profitable, a very appreciated alternative to a lot of those

places out there. They even have live jazz on the weekends.

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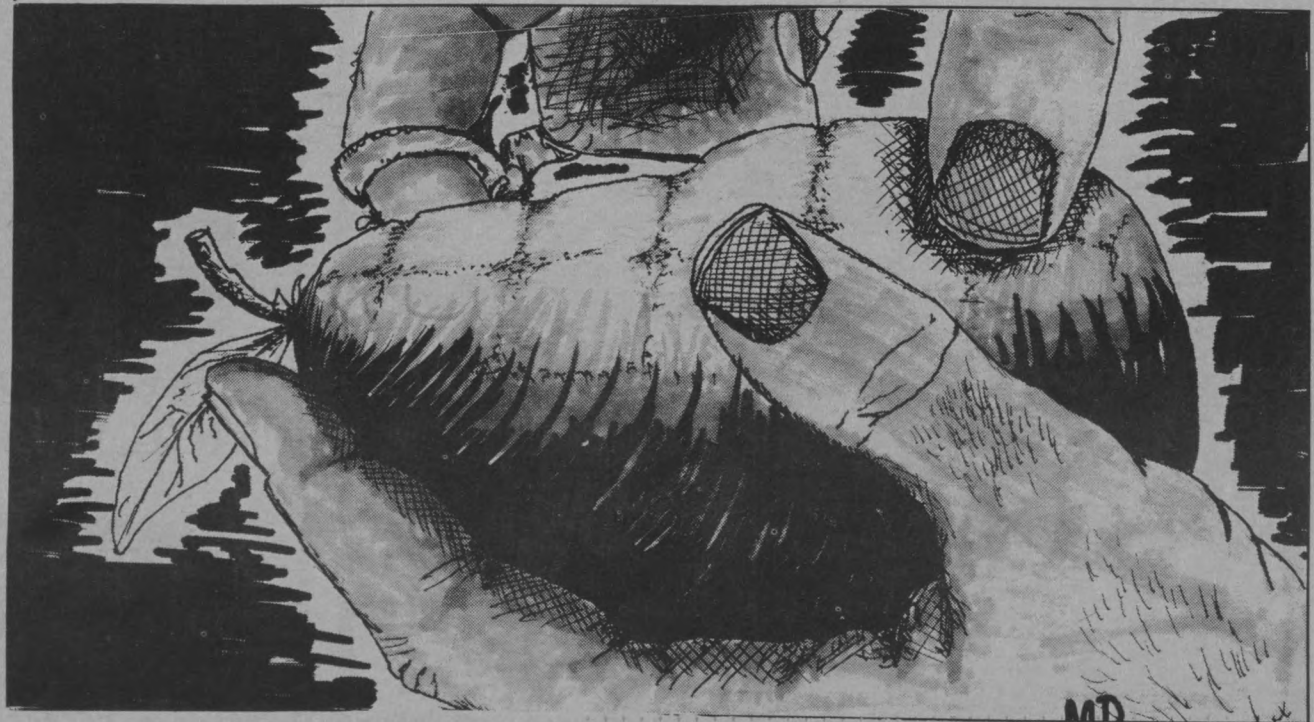

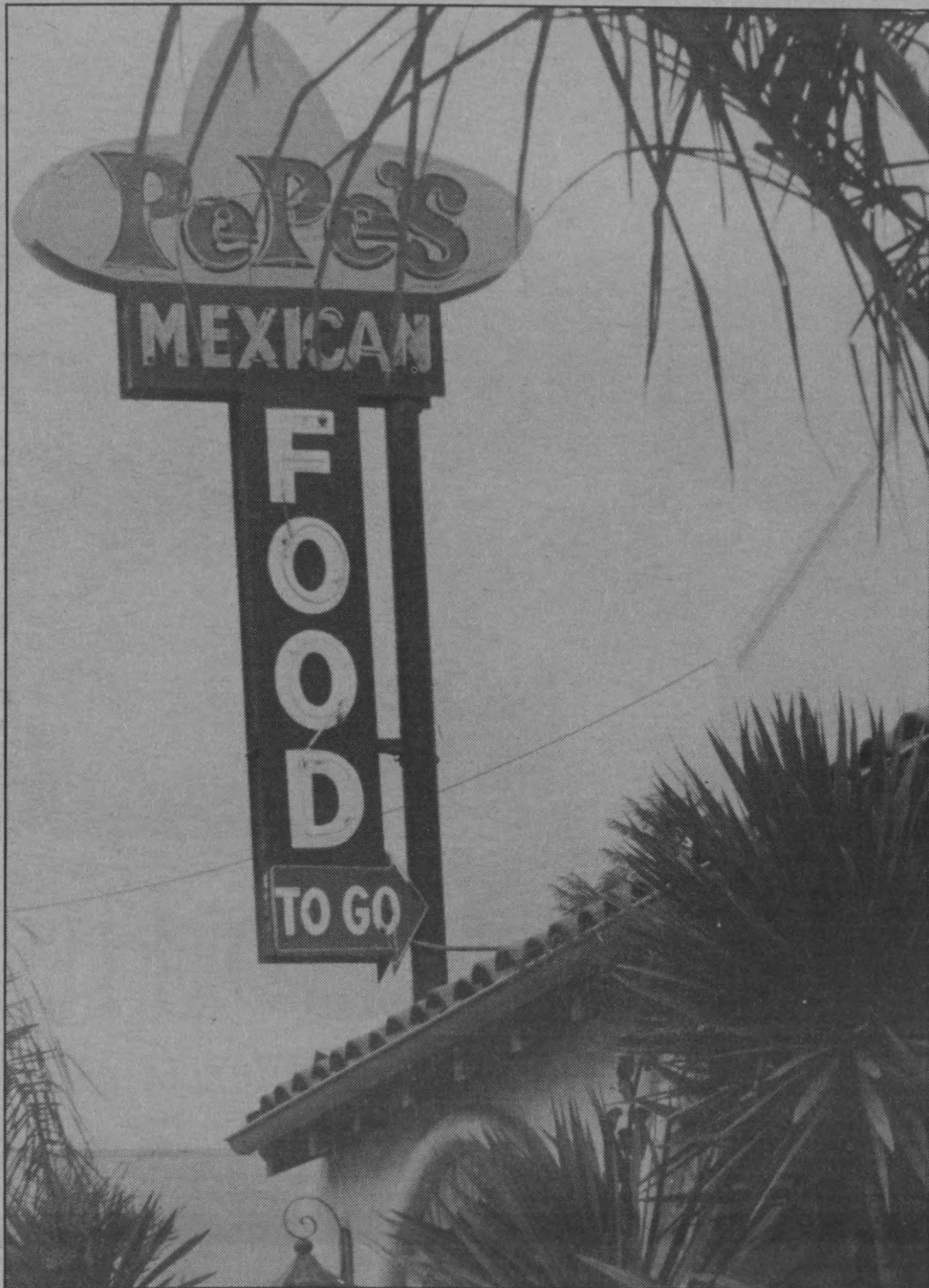
Pepe, Pepe, Pepe. You are too good ... too good for the likes of us.

Pepe, Pepe, Pepe ... All this for the likes of us. And with food to go!? Pepe! Please!

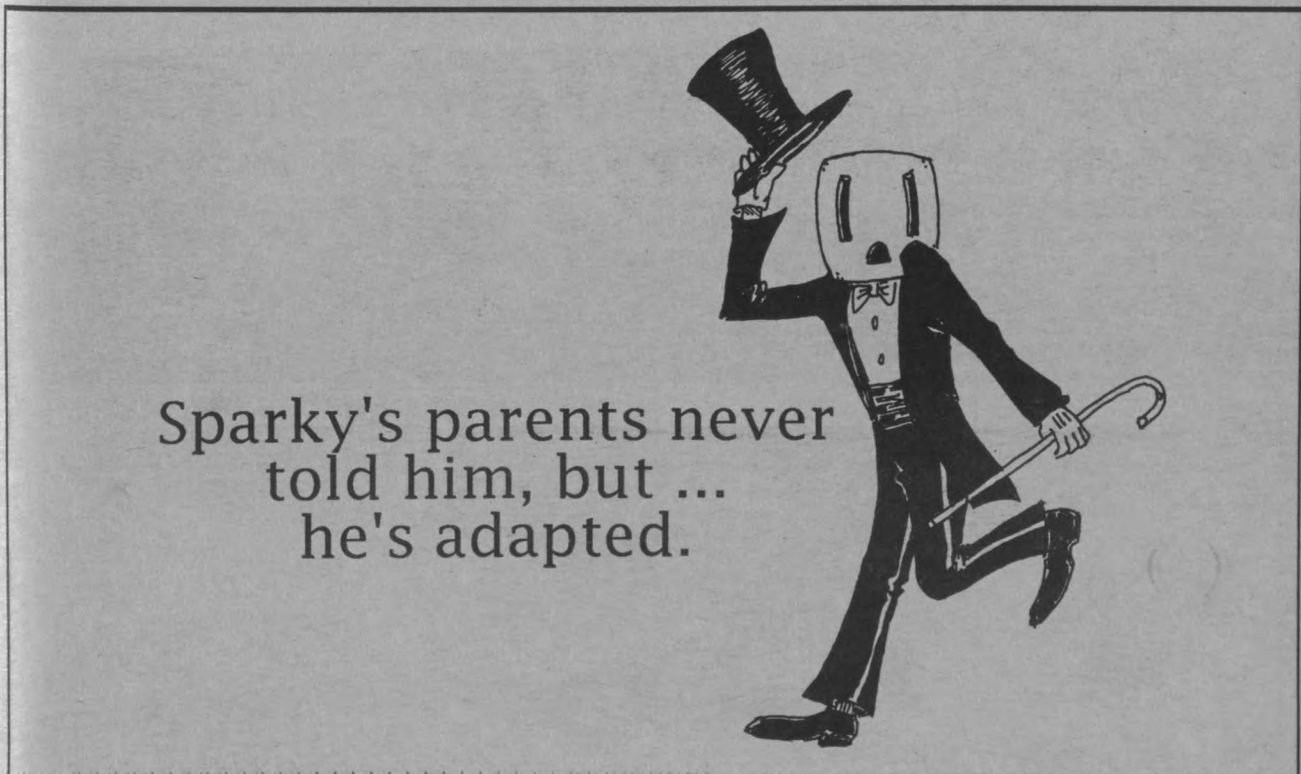

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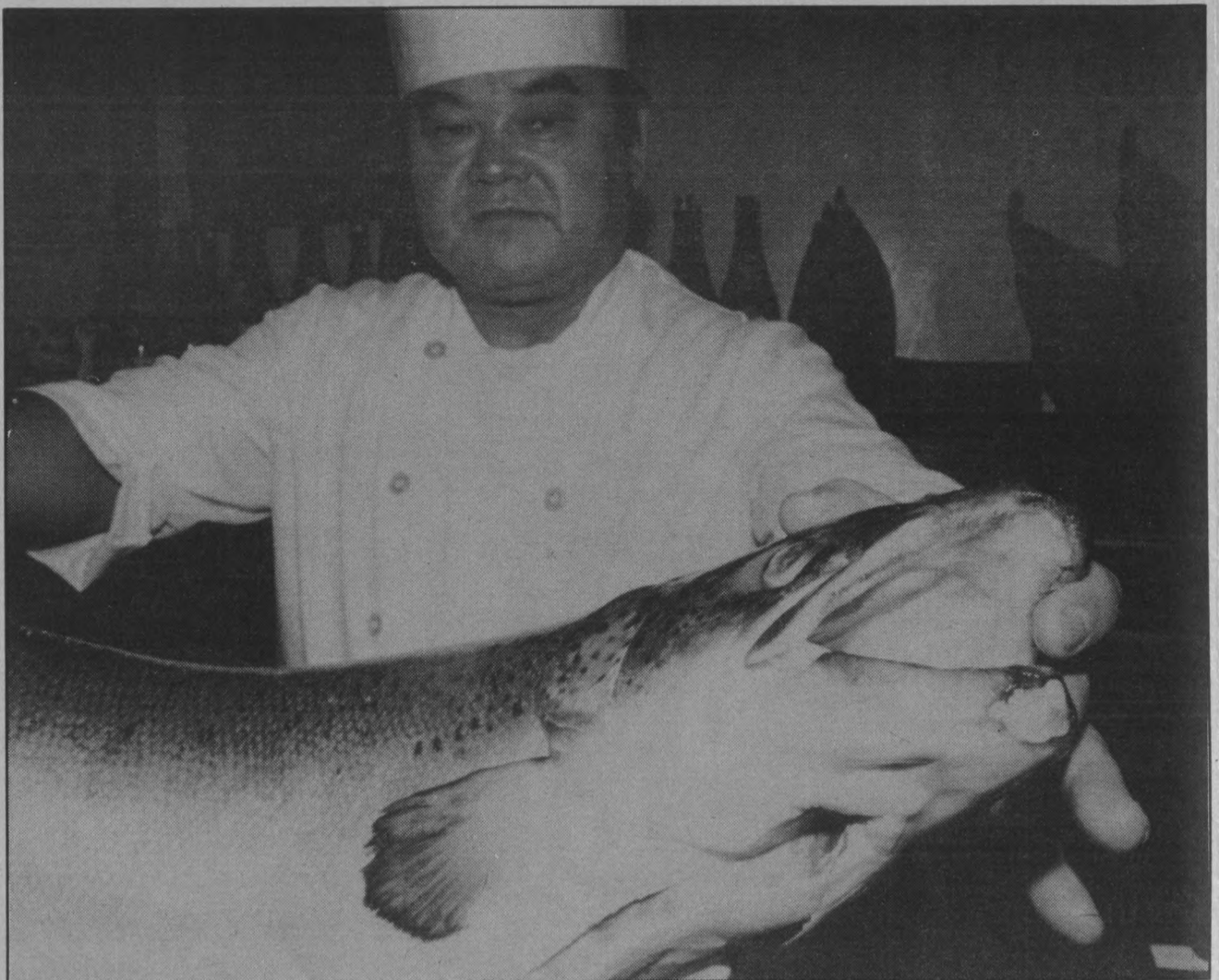

tale.

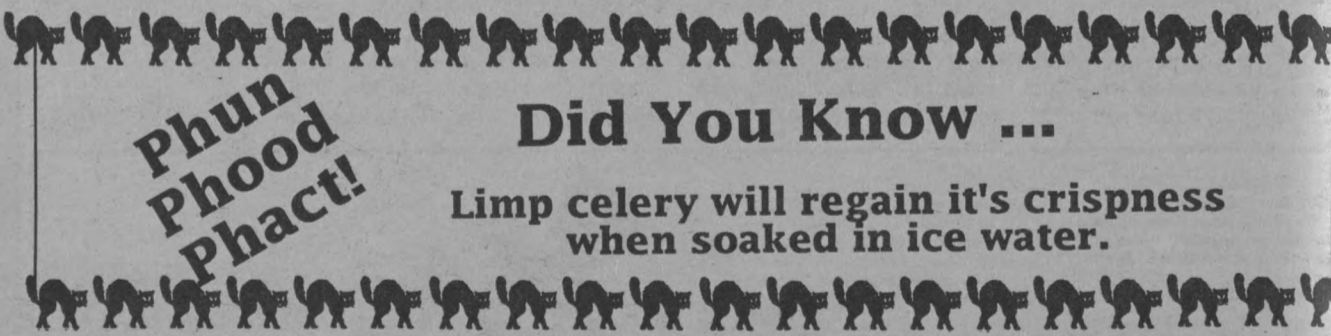

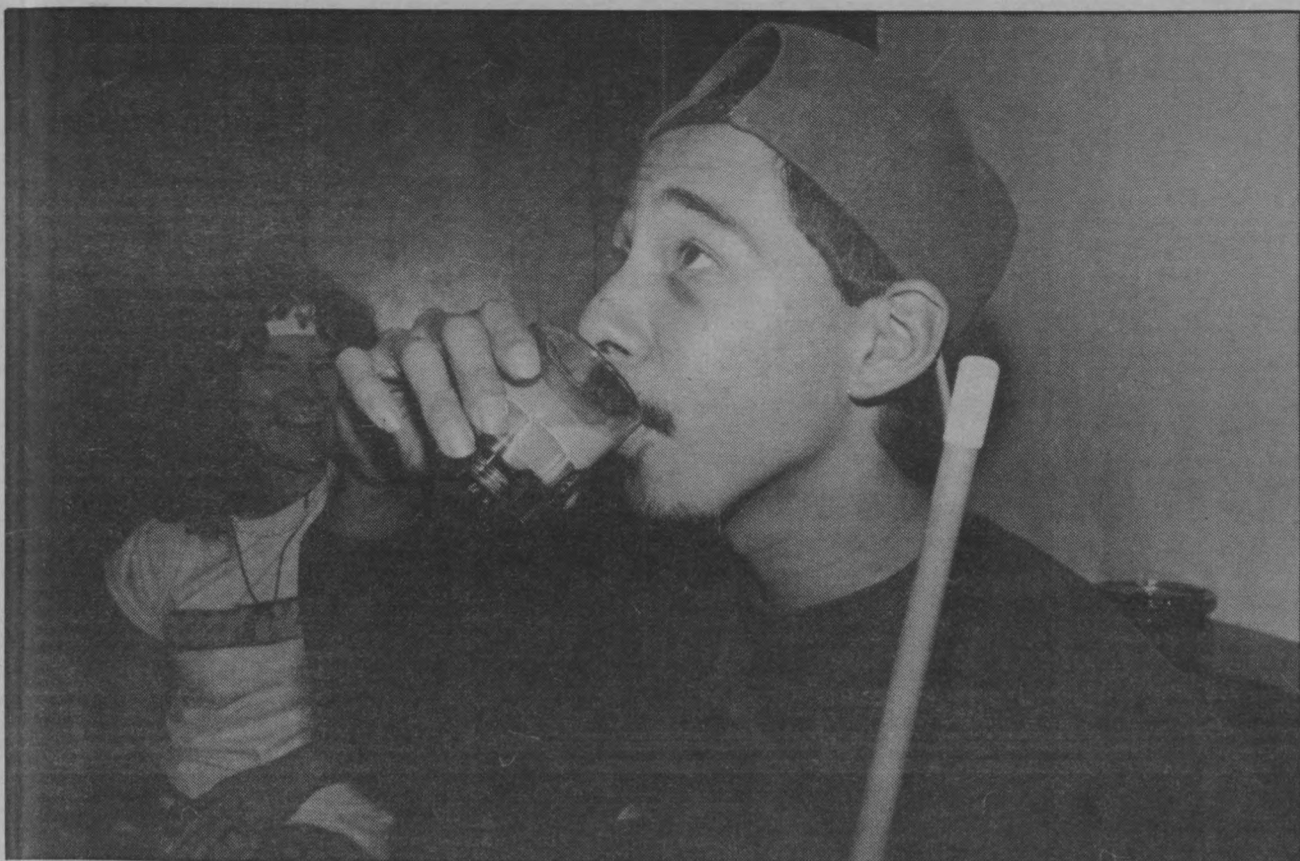

Mel's: A Real Bar

Venerable S.B. Bar Still Serving 'em Cold and Good.

Mel's is a bar. It's not fooling around.

It's dark, cool and comfortable, like a bar should be. The minute you enter, you suddenly feel like a cool guy, whether you are one or not. You just can't help it. And you just can't help going up to the bartender, getting a whisky sour and then leaning up against the bar and having a slow, long look around the room. It's a great place. It's a classic bar.

It's the kind of bar you walk into and wonder, "Where's Mickey Rourke?" The kind of bar you walk into at 7:30 in the morning and order a bloody mary before you get married. It's the kind of bar that when the phone rings you might hear somebody say, "If that's Mabel, I'm not here." It's a bar's bar.

They don't have drink specials. They don't have happy hours. They don't have any of those weird people who like to go out to weird places and get weird drinks that they have to explain to the bartender. You know the type of person I'm talkin' about: "I wanna go out tonight to the Pink Telephone and drink a Shakespeare in the Park. You know how to make a Shakespeare in the Park, don't you? It's got tequila and sarsaparilla blended with kiwis and has an entire un-peeled banana with toothpicks in it with those little colored marshmallows stuck on the ends. It's served in a hollowed-out coconut shell, blended. Hey, I said blended!"

Mel's is about going to a bar and getting a drink that, on first taste, makes you look around the room suddenly, hoping that no one saw you make Mel's famous "My, this drink is strong!" face. It's about generous

drinks, and yummy ones, too. It's about playing pool 'til two o'clock in the morning with your friend, Jerry, and two guys you just met named Willie and Reasonably Quick Eddie.

The fact is, Mel's doesn't need gimmicks to secure its title as the most genuine bar in Santa Barbara. Indeed, to look at it — smack dab in the middle of the fangled, faux-'80s El Paseo Nuevo mall — and see it standing proud like a trophy of Americana, is inspiring. It's like God ripped one of the honest pieces of our culture from another era and stuck it in the middle of a sterile consumer center just to make a point.

I talked to Nancy, who has worked for Mel's for a total of ten and one-half years, and she was of a similar mind. "Everybody is crazy about Mel's: everyone who has been here and everyone who is going to be here," she said. About the drinks themselves, Nancy

said, "It's happy hour every hour at Mel's."

And it's true. The drinks are cheap, but strong and good. It's a fine place for conversation, with just enough of that vague bar/music noise to make it worthwhile but not enough to drown out normal speech. It's dark inside, like it runs on its own schedule and you can get just about anything you want on the jukebox. The people there are friendly and very capable.

So if you've got a story to tell, or need to have material for a story, Mel's is your place. It invites you in with a no-frills honesty that is true to the bar's self. If you want a Shakespeare in the Park, however, may I suggest the Pink Telephone?

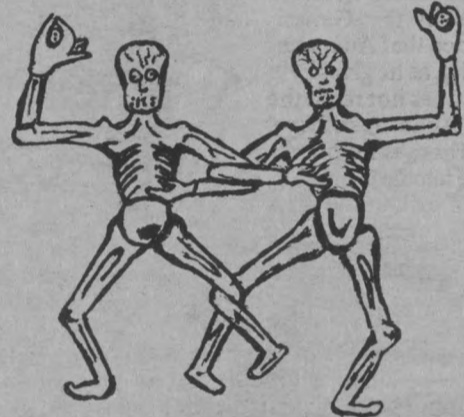
