

"No problem," Steff said soothingly, "we can go for lunch tomorrow."

My slip of the tongue proved all too Freudian when, the very next day, Steff and I sat bathed in the sun outside Cafe Vallarta, sampling crunchy, thick corn tortilla chips and a positively tangy salsa as we studied the lunch menu. So there we were, in Puerta Vallarta — er, Cafe Vallarta — tummies arumbling and tastebuds atingling, faced with such an array of subtle Mexican favorites; it would make any true culinary cultist cry.
What to do? Caldo de Marisco? Paella de Marisco? Chiles rellenos calamar picado? Cochinita pibil? Served up with arroz poblano and frijoles negros in such outstanding style and - for these low prices? Cheaper than in

nos was almost too pretty to eat. All that succulent squid and sauce, arranged like it had been served up in the finest restaurant in Mexico. But eat it he did, only sharing one bite with me. I didn't notice — I was too busy working on my enchilada and plotting our next visit to Cafe Vallarta.



I'll never forget my first introduction to Mexican eats. It was in Washington D.C.; I was about six. Dad and I were in the kitchen and he was showing me the finer points of jalapeño choppin'. I think we were doing nachos that night or someth ... no, it wasn't na-chos it was the Big Fellas: enchiladas, I remember now it was enchiladas.

Anyway, me and Pops were in a rhythm: tagteamin', high-fivin', that kind of thing. But things got weird quick. After a can or two, he told me to get my jacket for we were headed to the store to pick up some picante. He told me to use the restroom first because we might have to stop at a cou-ple places and might be gone for awhile know, I was six. So I did. Thirty seconds later ...

well, let me just say the screams were incredible. From that moment on, I've always had the utmost respect for jalapeños and the words, "Wash your hands after cutting jalapeños:"

But that experience made me a connoisseur, I obviously had full respect for the stuff and wouldn't settle for anything less than superb. Kind of like the superb

Mexican food they serve up at the Cantina here in Isla Vista. I'd had enough of these South of the Border wannabees who put what-ever they can find inside a lame excuse for a tortilla and serve it up, knowing full well people will buy it be-cause they don't have the time to actually go to Mexico. It was too much, so I went to Cantina, where they make each order fresh. Yes, fresh. I mean, the closest any of these other places I've been to get to true freshness is keeping chicken cooked within the last hour in a metal pot over some

steaming agua.
Not Cantina. In fact the second after I ordered my chicken fajitas and chicken burrito with sour cream, rice and of course, jalapeños, the cook threw a handful of fresh, raw chicken

onto the grill. I smiled. I knew this was the place.

The Cantina has been around for a few years and knows how to treat its customers. From the complimentary condiment bar, to a big-screen TV, to live music, to newspapers on the house, Cantina is the Mexican restaurant dining experience. I think my favorite part is the full complimentary condiment bar because it allows each to garnish his or her own food and avoid the inevitable "Um, 'scuse me I ordered this without salsa (pronounced 'salsa')," or "can I get a little lettuce in this bad boy?" or "Nah, I ain't down with no jalapeños, see I had this experience when I was a kid." You

And I've got just two words for Cantina's fajitas: Peppers! I mean, they were robust, fresh, aggressive and kickin'— this was livin'. The thing I like best about Cantina food and the reason I go back every other day is that taste I get in my mouth as soon as I bite into the chicken burrito. You


know that tender poultry, grilled, charcoal, meaty thing you experience when a burrito is really good and TLCed, not just hastily assembled by a smart fellow wielding a quick ice cream scooper and huddled over really bad, lardy refried beans inside a pot that has only been used for refried beans since the beginning of beans since the beginning of dinner and hasn't been cleaned since and thus has that refried bean crust on the inside near the top and on the bottom from the last batch that ran out.

I can't rattle them off right now without my notes because there's too many, but I can tell ya that on Mondays they have chicken tacos for about 80 cents, then there's Happy Hour where you can get dollar burritos and some great prices on brew. So I say, "Vamos a La Cantina, para la comida final"






