I felt a little ashamed, and meekly answered, "Domino's".

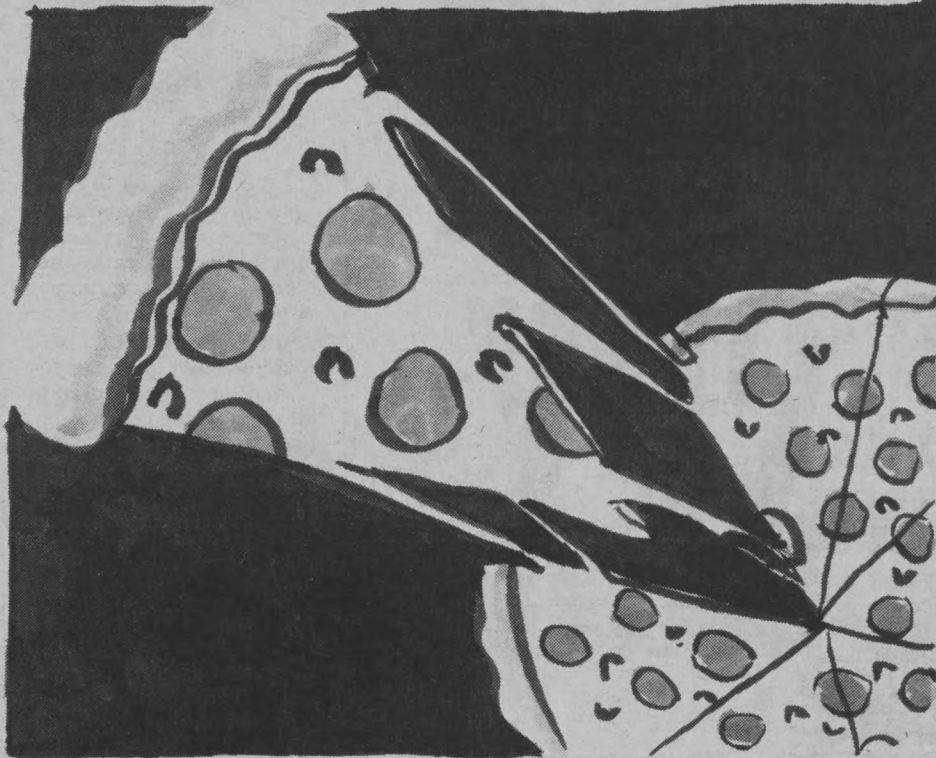
