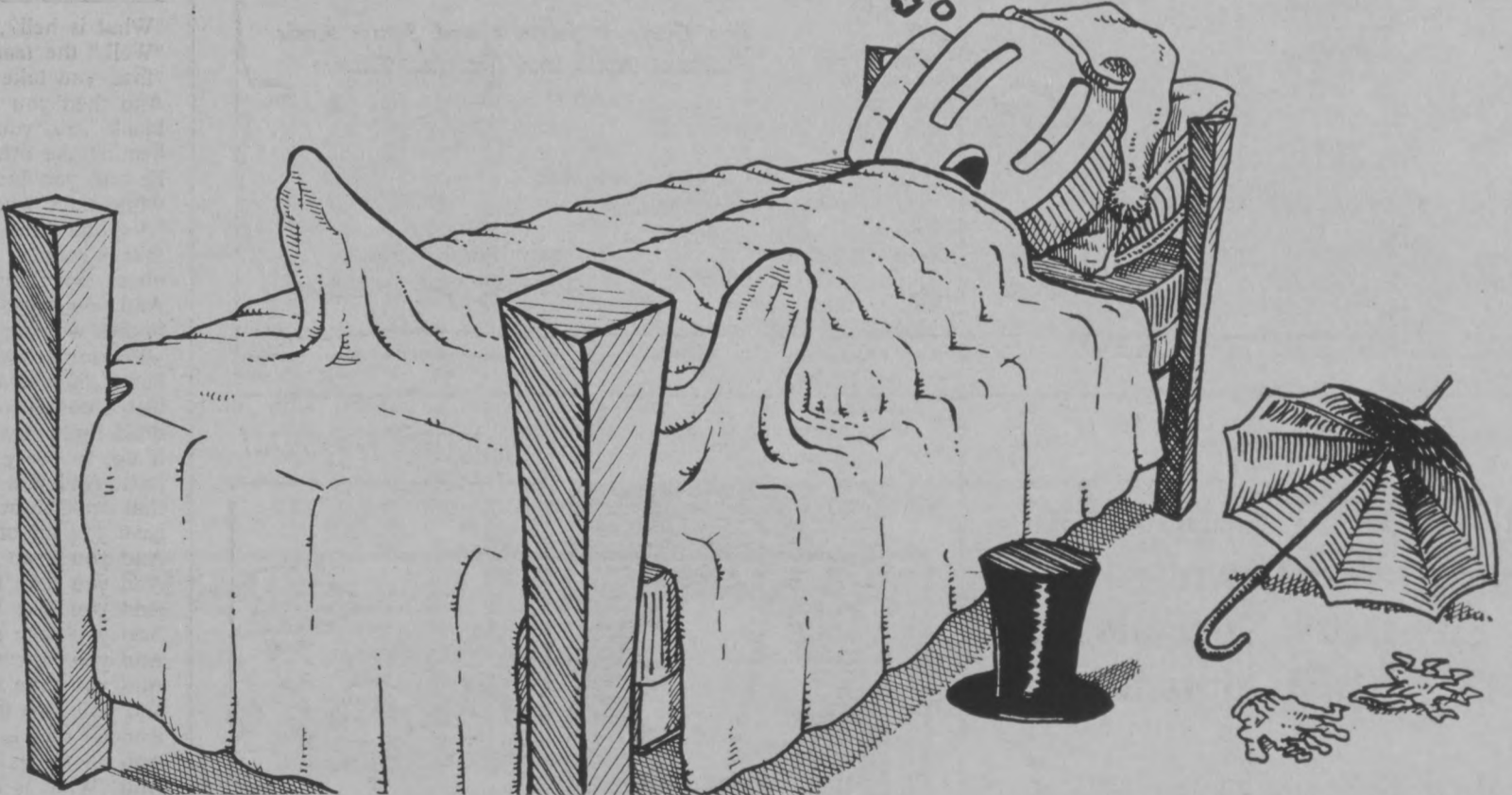


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

DaVinci's: A Masterpizza

Pasta as tender as a Julio Iglesias' power ballad. Atmosphere as refreshingly warm as a summer's breeze. Tomato sauce as rich as Little Richard, but less bitter. Pizza as saucy as the BBC. Lasagna so fulfilling you may as well cancel your next appointment with your therapist. In a word, DaVinci's Pizzeria and Ristorante.

My roommate Max and I had heard stories about DaVinci's for some time, many of them being about the high quality of the chicken fettucini. For some reason or another, we had never made the short trek out there. Boy, have we been missing out on a great restaurant! Whoo-ee!

One of the more spectacular things about DaVinci's is that beyond just being a great restaurant, they have one of the best pizza delivery services in town. They've got this deal — a deal that lasts all year long — that no other pizza place in town can compete with. I'm talking about a large pizza, medium pizza and three free Cokes — delivered to your doorstep, all for \$11.95. Get out of here! That's amazing and you know it! But before I go on about DaVinci's, let me backtrack a little and tell how Max and I finally found our way down to DaVinci's

Max had long been tempting me with stories of his prowess in the kitchen. He told me he specialized in Italian food, a statement that sent my mouth watering at an embarrassing rate, creating enough moisture to alert meteorologists county-wide. Max's tales of chicken fettucini and old-fashioned lasagna became legends in our household and we would often invite people over to sit around the fireplace and listen to Max wax culinary.

After two years of living with him, however, I confronted him with the fact that I had never actually seen him hunker down over a hot stove and make anything more complicated than an Eggo waffle. Max was in the kitchen the entire next day. Each time I would wander in to check on his progress, he would scream Slavic vulgarities, sprinkle paprika liberally on my tie and threaten to set his wig on fire if I did not leave immediately. He was sweating profusely and waved a soup ladle menacingly about his head. So, trusting that he knew what he was doing, I went back into the living room and my Richard Scarry novel.

At about 7 o'clock, Max emerged from the kitchen, explaining that he had to run to the store for some last minute ingredients. He returned an hour later with two spatulas, three pounds of lard, six pairs of latex gloves, an Egg McMuffin, a Garden Weasel, 11 copies of the soundtrack to "Grem-lins II," a pound of ground beef and an autographed picture of Sha-Na-Na. His eyes flashing with mad energy, Max disappeared once again into the kitchen, which was now smoking quite furiously.

At 2 a.m., Max called me to dinner. After the events of

the day, I wasn't really expecting the sumptuous dinner we had planned the night before. All the same, nothing short of a two-day marathon of "The Facts of Life" could have prepared me for the "dinner" Max set before me. In the ornate-yet-quiet dining area, Max and I were served like prodigal sons returning to their homeland. All-you-can-eat salad bars, delicious cheesy pizzas, garlic breads and — at long last — a chicken fettucini to make the angels weep. The place is classy. They've got gothic-y wood chairs and Mona Lisa herself on the wall. It's touches like those that catapult DaVinci's far beyond the petty reaches of your average Italian restaurant.

But that being as it may, DaVinci's doesn't let its high class status get in the way of serving UCSB and Isla Vista. No, unh-huh. They've got their drivers out there delivering hot, steamy pizzas every night of the week at ridiculously competitive prices. In a recent UCSB taste contest, DaVinci's was even voted best pizza!

And at the restaurant itself, the selection is wide, the service is affable, the prices are super and the food is supreme. How are you gonna say no?

An hour and a half later, ignoring his screams of protest, I dragged Max out of the restaurant and into the jeep. I was able to satiate him by saying that we would be returning to DaVinci's fine Italian cuisine the very next night. Hey, I don't need a lightbulb to go on above my head to know when a good idea comes along!

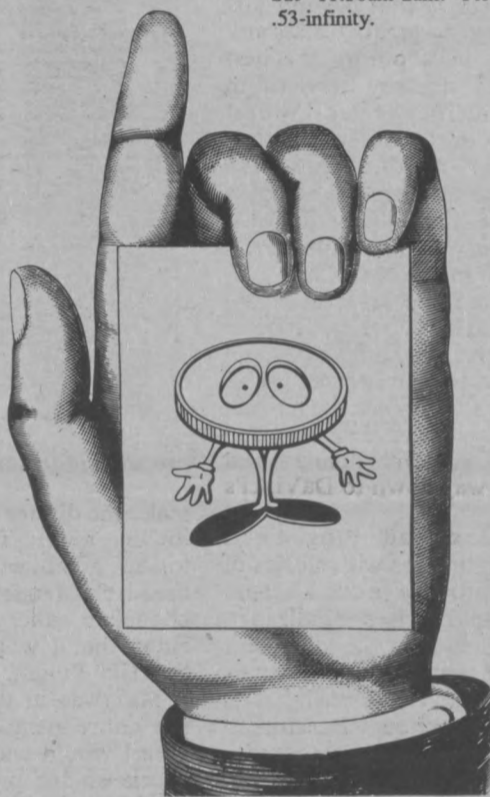

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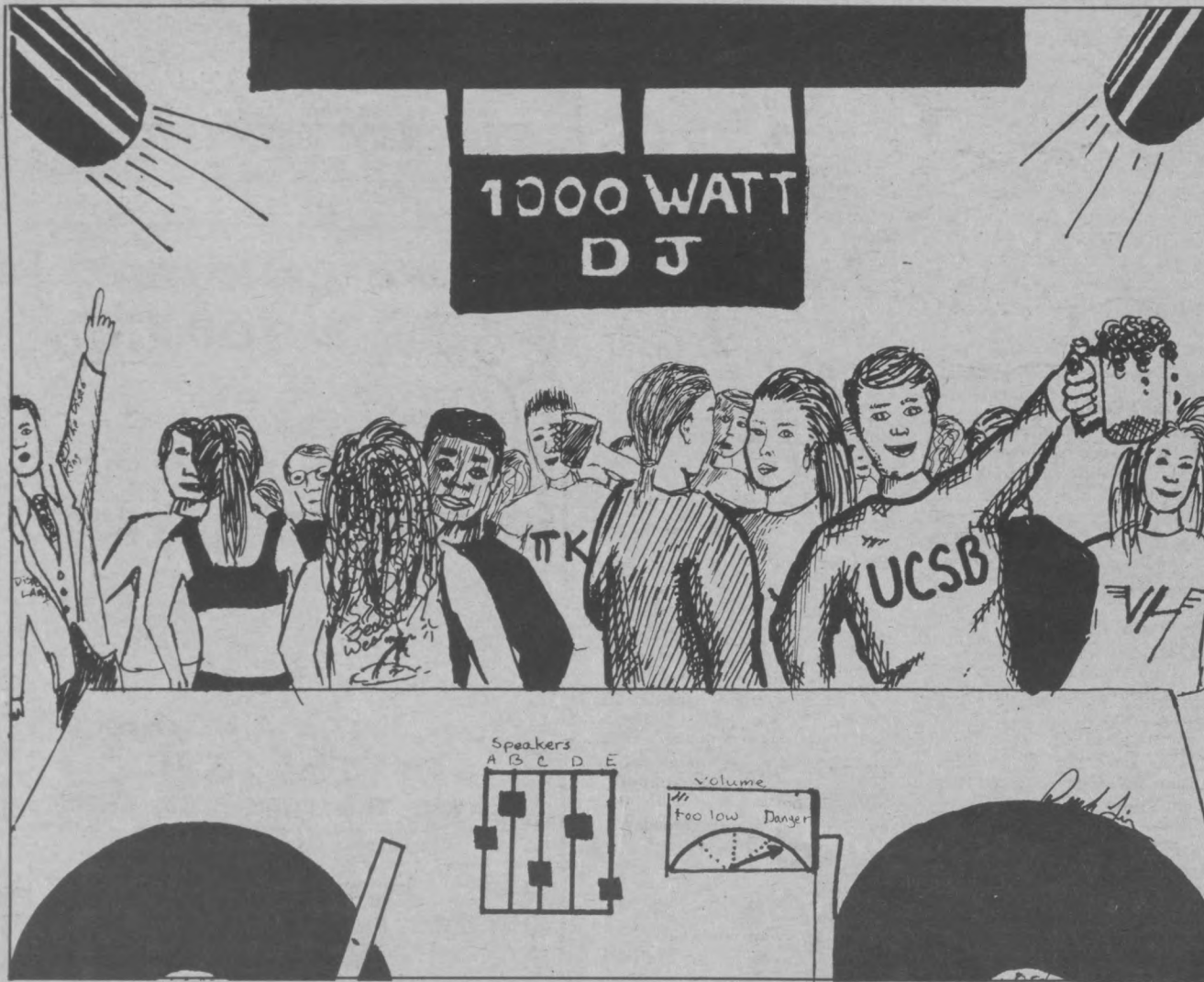
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1000 Watt Don Scott Rocks Hot

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Kyoto=Fine Japanese

Kyoto. I'm not sure what it means in Japanese, but in Santa Barbara it means great Japanese food at affordable prices. It may be impossible to eat at the same restaurant every night, but if you had to, Kyoto might be just the place, especially for those special occasions when you and your friends want to enjoy something of another culture and of a higher caste than Isla Vista can offer.

Whether your party enjoys the comfortable "Western"-style booths and tables or is adventurous enough to leave your shoes outside while you dine in one of the individual Japanese-style dinner rooms, you will enjoy the atmosphere. The restaurant is very tastefully decorated and the service is impeccable.

One thing that really makes Kyoto a standout among the local Japanese restaurant offerings is its menu. Whether you want a Yellowtail Sashimi appetizer (a standout at \$7.50) or the Baked Stuffed Squid dinner (accessible at \$11.95), the staff at Kyoto is guaranteed to serve you not only a large portion, but a good one too.

For my particular outing, I ordered a good old-fashioned Teriyaki Steak with all the fixin's. Even if I hadn't taken my shoes off already, I'm sure the great \$9.50 price tag would've knocked my socks off anyway. My date was a little more adventurous and ordered some kind of super-special meal. The meal, which is on the menu everyday so that even people who don't work for the Daily Nexus may order it, is as follows: eight California Rolls, shrimp, vegetable tempura and your choice of one of the following: Salmon Teriyaki (her choice that evening), Yakitori, Beef Teriyaki, Sesame Chicken, Torikatsu or Chicken Teriyaki. Wow!

Our meal commenced with the traditional and delectable Miso soup, cucumber Sunomono and Tsukemono. The Tsukemono was more to my date's liking, but, in my opinion, you can't touch the Miso soup and cucumber Sunomono.

Already anxious to see how the chefs at this fine eating establishment were going to improve on their

appetizer, I primed myself for the main course with a little conversation with my date. Yet, I had just begun to speak when the main course arrived — what speed!

My platter (a really nice one, too) contained a healthy portion of Japanese-style vegetables with a sauce so good I did not even bother to ask what was in it (it's probably beyond the comprehension of mere mortals), a piece of choice honeydew melon and a quite sizeable teriyaki steak.

My date had too much food for me to relate. There was just so much that it was scary. We even almost ended up taking some home, but the California Rolls were so good that I managed

to fit a few of them in even with the sizeable steak and all the other food I ate. Of particular note on her platter (besides the California rolls) was the Salmon Teriyaki. Can you spell H-E-A-V-E-N? I can. It was that good.

On top of the voluminous amounts of food we were served, we were even given Japanese rice in a couple of exquisite rice bowls that were almost as much of a pleasure to eat from as the food was good.

But of course, enough about the food — what about the drinks?! They have great Japanese beer (if you have never had some you must go and try it) and some of the best Sake available within a hundred miles.

Kyoto is definitely the place in Santa Barbara to go for Japanese food. Next time, I'm going to try the sushi bar, which offers such delicacies as Temoura rolls, Spiderhand rolls, Caterpillar rolls, Tiger-eye rolls and Hira-Ten Hand rolls, to name a few.

To close, I will quote the menu: "Anyone caught smoking on the premises will be hung by the toenails and pummeled into unconsciousness with an organic carrot." Kyoto: where they take eating seriously.

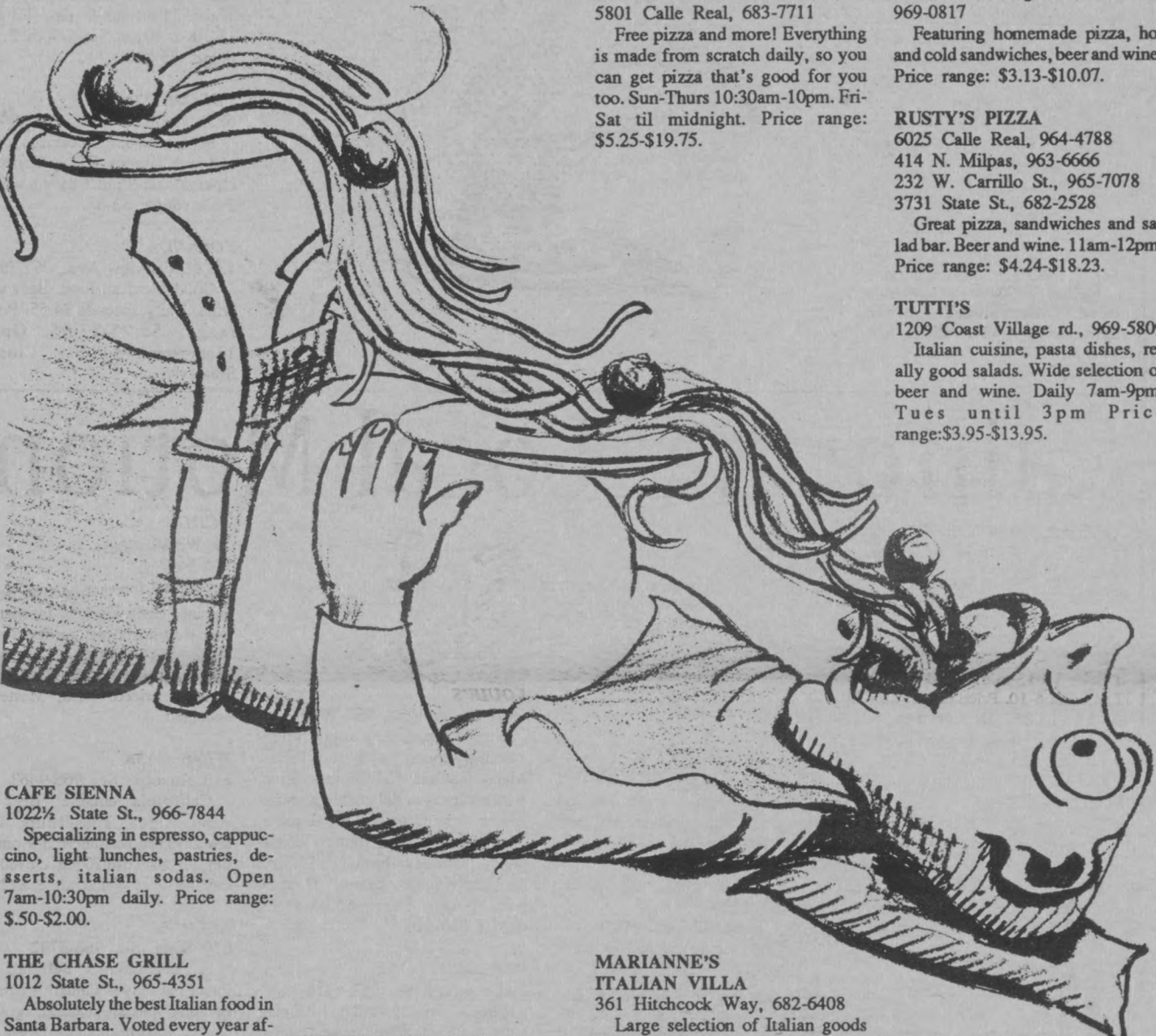

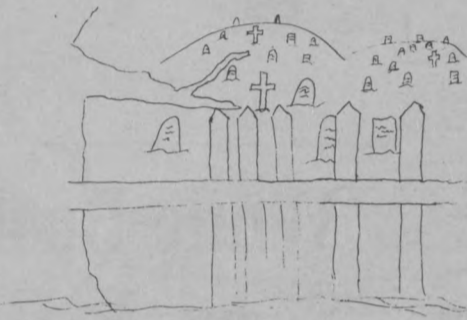
