

Nestled snuggly between Thrifty's Drug Store and Home Federal in New Towne Goleta's Fairview Center, like cheese in a fresh made ravioli, sits the warm 'n' cozy Franco and Rosa's Italian Cuisine.

Inviting as a Sunday family get-to-gether, Franco and Rosa's is well worth the excursion out of Isla Vista and beyond the all-too-common Old Towne restaurantes we have all become familiar with. Yes, Franco and Rosa know how to treat a hungry, but adventurous diner right.
In what may be an daring

change for Isla Vistans, there's not a single pizza on this menu.

Comida Mexicana Buenisimo: That's Pepe's

As a young California tyke, dodging earthquake fissures and running naked through our commune's orchards, I always felt Mexican food to be a bit, well, mundane. I mean, granted, it was a nice change from the lentil soup and watered down red wine my vegatarian babysitter would give me, but it was still just the usual.

You see, beef tacos were the only dish my mom could really make. She sure as hell wasn't going to bake a damn cake; that was always made quite clear and Chinese food was my dad's domain. So I got to know how to roll a taco,

but quick.

Mexican food got a bit more exciting for me when my uncle moved back into town. He settled into the two room shack out back and set about making a living. His underground newspaper had failed despite the sex cartoons and now he was looking to get into the lucrative college food market. Tacos, he said with a sage smile, there's a big future in tacos.

First he bought a trailer, a little rounded thing so light he could pull it with his red convertible MG. Then he painted it, transforming it into the best looking ten foot high taco you ever saw, Warholian pop art on wheels. He assembled the fixin's, got my mom's recipe and schlepped his elfish bearded self up the hill to set up on Bancroft and Telegraph, a prime spot to catch all the college kids spilling out of class or a demonstration.

I made a point of hanging out with my uncle after that. I'd ditch the lentil woman and have him babysit me. His method was brilliant: he'd make my bed on the couch in his miniscule "living room" and say, "OK, Weston, I'm going to bed. I want you to try and stay up all night." With that he'd disappear into his room leaving me to exhaust myself trying to see the dawn, invariably falling asleep after ten minutes of

Early in the morning he'd shake me and we'd climb into the MG, shivering. I'd watch out the back to make sure the taco trailer was taking all the turns and then we'd park in our designated spot. My uncle would give me money to go buy an orange smoothie while he started selling the morning items: donuts, coffee, tamales. Then I'd come back and spend the day in the taco trailer, handing hot sauce to charmed co-eds. Or, on nice days, I'd go play in the fountain with all the other kids and their dogs.

Well, my uncle's taco trailer went bankrupt in 1974 but

Well, my uncle's taco trailer went bankrupt in 1974 but my image of Mexican food was forever transformed. And so imagine how pleasant my surprise to find an old-time, goodtime Mexican restaurant right here in Goleta, the down

home Pepe's, just off Hollister.

Mexican restaurants these days tend to be either giant margarita pick-up joints with waitresses in paper mache mini-skirts or nouvelle cilantro havens which cost a fortune. But Pepe's is a nice solid place with lovely, hand crafted leather chairs that'll swallow you whole, chairs from which you can look out on a panoramic view of the historic center of old Goleta.

I started with the chicken fajitas, a dish my uncle never carried and the one concession Pepe's has made to the hip yuppie overclass of the area who wouldn't know a chingadera from a chimichanga, even if it was on the damn SAT.

The fajitas were delivered with much ceremony. First, a big plate of steaming rice, beans, guacamole, salsa and sour cream were set down with a warning — "watch out, hot plate!" — before the main event: a frying pan full of marinated breast chunks sizzling along with green peppers and onions. The frying pan was placed on a candle and a butter-

broth was then poured on the meat-vegtable mix, an event accompanied with much hissing, steaming and a great floating of particulates across our table.


We were impressed to say the least, and ordered a pitcher of Miller in celebration — a mighty fulsome and reasonably priced pitcher I'd like to add.


The food was quite good — the salsa being an especial

I have a theory that if you take a date to an Italian restaurant, she will invariably find reason to dump you on the spot.

I know, you're thinking it's a theory that only applies to me, Matt Curplew, and maybe you're right. Maybe it's just that I get dumped in Italian restaurants. I guess I like Italian food too much to spend time paying attention to a companion. And just when my appreciation of the Chianti and the angel-hair pasta and oh-that-sauce reaches its glorious

It's also got spectacular architecture. A high, sunburst

chandelier. Ornate sculptures framing the stage. Towering

in the food as I am at an Italian place? Two words:

The Ventura Theatre has concerts that accompany the culinary prelude. To my pleasant surprise, I found myself tapping my toes as I munched on a flavorful slice of terivaki chicken. The Bombers, opening for the James Harman Group, started kickin' in some big horns-driven blues riffs that simply couldn't be ignored. The food could wait. The music could not. Folks just naturally started gravitating to the dance floor. (Be sure to make your reservations early, because people come in sizeable parties to enjoy the food/ band combo).


But despite the allure of the dance floor, the food was hard to disregard. The entree were accompanied by a generous portion of garden salad, a host of dinner rolls, a bevy of vegetables, and a baked potato with sour cream and chives or some rice; the choice is yours.

My gracious waitress said that the specials ain't bad, either, particularly the chicken oriental stir-fry. But she noted that "everybody's satisfied with the chicken." Damn
