# Sig Eps' Capture Unprecedented Fourth IM Flag Football Title

Sigma Phi Epsilon, the team most pre-season observers felt would not be able to capture an unprecedented fourth straight intramural football championship, went ahead and did it anyway Wednesday, beating the Delts 26-20 in overtime.

Under the direction of last year's unanimous all-IM quarterback, Craig Rubenstein, the Sig Eps marched 49 yards with less than three minutes left in the five minute overtime, scoring on a sevenyard pass from Rubenstein to end Jim Ahler, who was standing all alone in the Delt endzone.

That touchdown broke a 20-20 tie which had ended the regulation contest, as the Delts had battled back from deficits of 13-0 and 20-14 to even the score with 3:36 remaining.

The Delts opened the overtime period with the ball on their own 20-yard line, and quickly picked up 10 yards and a first

down when end Jeff Read was tackled. The next three plays, however, netted only 19 yards, and two Dave Shoji bombs fell incomplete to end the Delt series of downs.

With 2:46 on the clock, the Eps took over at their own 31yard line. Dan Bungard took in a John Ahler pass for sixyards on first down, and on second Rubenstein unloaded a bomb in the direction of Bob Thoe, but it fell incomplete when Shoji batted it down.

Rubenstein faded back on third down as if he were going to throw for distance again, but instead hit halfback Steve Murata on a swing pass. Murata took the ball on the right sideline and promptly reversed field, galloping 36 yards to the Delt seven before Bill Chapman could pull his flag.

Victory was still within reach of the Delts however, as a tre-(Continued on p. 5, col. 1) **Cheadle Statement on Racism Commission** 


(Editor's note: The following is a statement released by Chancellor Vernon I. Cheadle concerning the Commission to Investigate Problems of Racism, which was formed immediately after the North Hall incident.)

I have been able these past few days to review the work of the Commission to Investigate Problems of Racism, of which Professor Otey M. Scruggs is Chairman, and to consider the Commission's recent recommendation to me that the campus make use of newly available teaching positions in 1969-70 to increase the number on our academic staff who are members of ethnic minorities. A major implication of this

recommendation, it seems to me, will be to enhance the capability of this campus educationally to respond to the differing needs of an increasingly diverse student body. Thus, I consider the recommendation to be sound in principle. There are, of course, legal constraints within which we must work, but nevertheless we can make significant progress, and I am actively seeking faculty support for that progress.

Indeed I have already been exploring with the academic departments ways and means of adding to our teaching staff persons whose cultures are not now substantially represented there in order to broaden the cultural and educational opportunities of our students, I intend also to cooperate fully with the Academic Senate in encouraging curricular innovations to which such teachers can bring a special competence.

The problem of minority representation within the university community is a significant but nevertheless partial expression of the university's broader commitment actively to deal with the problems generated by our nation's rapid urbanization. I am presently exploring administrative options that will enable this campus to organize its human and material resources in response to this commitment. I hope to be able to report progress within the near future.

## **UCSB Cagers To Host Basketball Tournament**

Jumping on the national bandwagon of top-flight Christmas basketball tournaments, UCSB will host Texas Christian (TCU), Harvard and Loyola of New Orleans in the California Winter Classic set for December 27 and 28 in Robertson Gym. Defending Southwest Conference champion TCU tangles with

Loyola (La.) in the 7 p.m. opener on Friday, December 27, with the Gauchos facing Harvard in the 9 p.m. battle.

Consolation and championship game times for Saturday are

also scheduled for 7 and 9 p.m., respectively. Student admission prices are \$1.50 per night (for both games), while the public can purchase reserved seats at \$3 per night. Other public prices on a per night basis include \$2 for a general admission ticket; \$1,50 for all students over 12 years of age and \$1 for all children under 12.

Contracts are now available in the Housing Services Office to all off-campus students who wish to live in campus residence halls Winter and Spring Quarters. \$140 is due as a security deposit upon return of the contract, Rent will be \$710 for two-man rooms for the two quarters. Singles run \$35 more per quarter.

"We are very pleased to bring such outstanding basketball talent to UCSB," said tournament director Jack Curtice, "This reflects highly upon Coach (Ralph) Barkey's program in particular and upon our entire athletic department in general."

The Gauchos, who started their 1968-69 campaign with a victory over traditional rival Cal Poly of San Luis Obispo, 72-62, dropped their next battle to a rugged Northwestern squad, 82-73.

Barkey's quintet will face Redlands at Robertson Gym on Wednesday, December 18, and then embark upon a weekend trip to Laramie, Wyoming and Fort Collins, Colorado for a pair of tournament tune-up games against the Cowboys and Colorado State University on December 20 and 21.

After a brief Christmas rest they will return to UCSB for the Winter Classic and their first meeting with Harvard of the Ivy League.

"This will be an outstanding tournament with some representative teams and some excellent basketball exhibited," Barkey enthused,

TCU and Loyola of New Orleans, which defeated the Gauchos in New Orleans last year, 85-81, are expected to ignite some explosive fireworks in the opening round of the two day affair.

Harvard, which defeated K.C. Jones' Brandeis five in its opener, also promises a great challenge to Barkey's cagers who are gunning for their first winning basketball season since 1963.

UCSB will be led into action by sophomore center Doug Rex, forwards Steve Rippe and Ron Rouse and guards Bob Emery and Larry Silvett.
