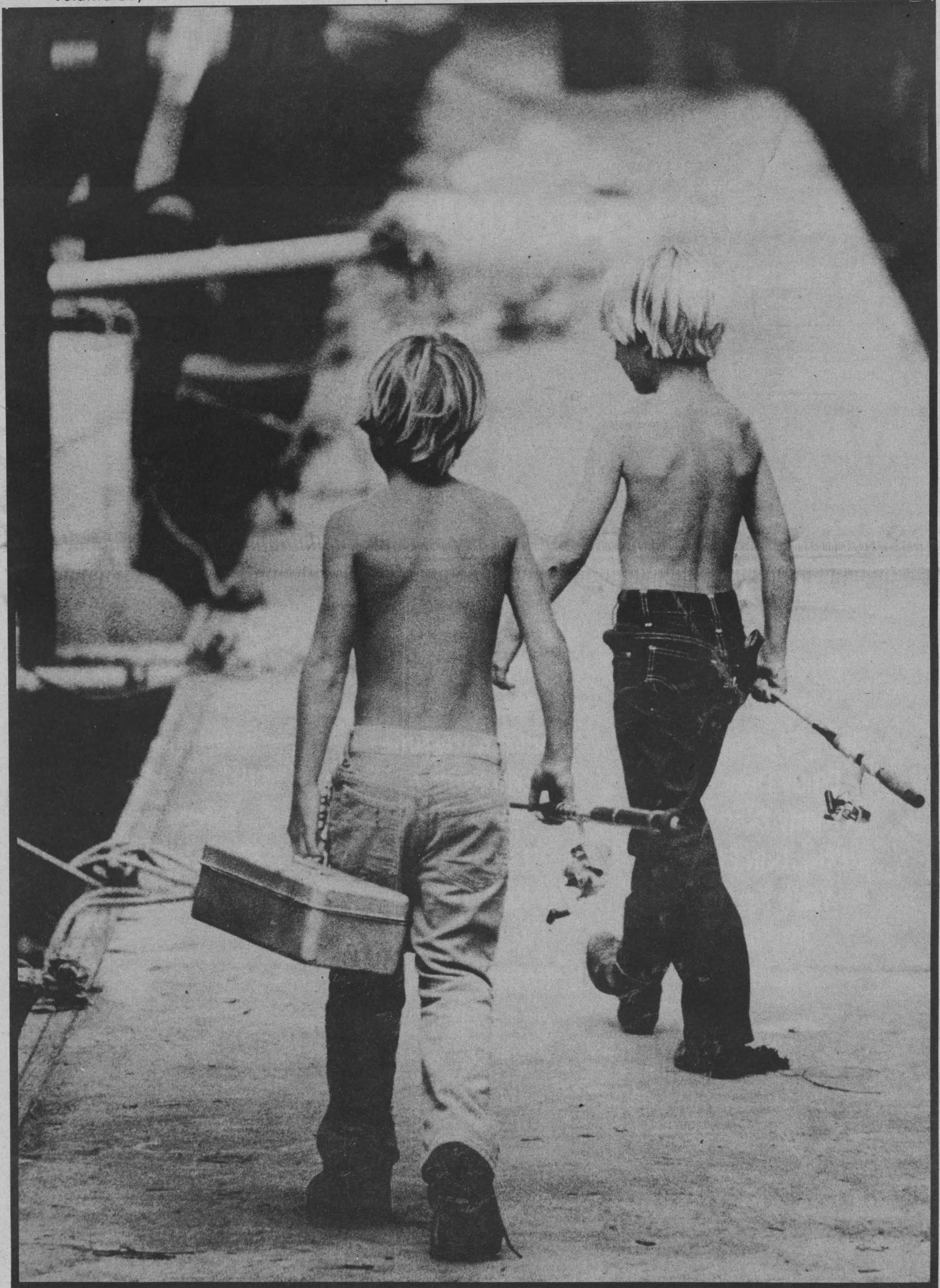

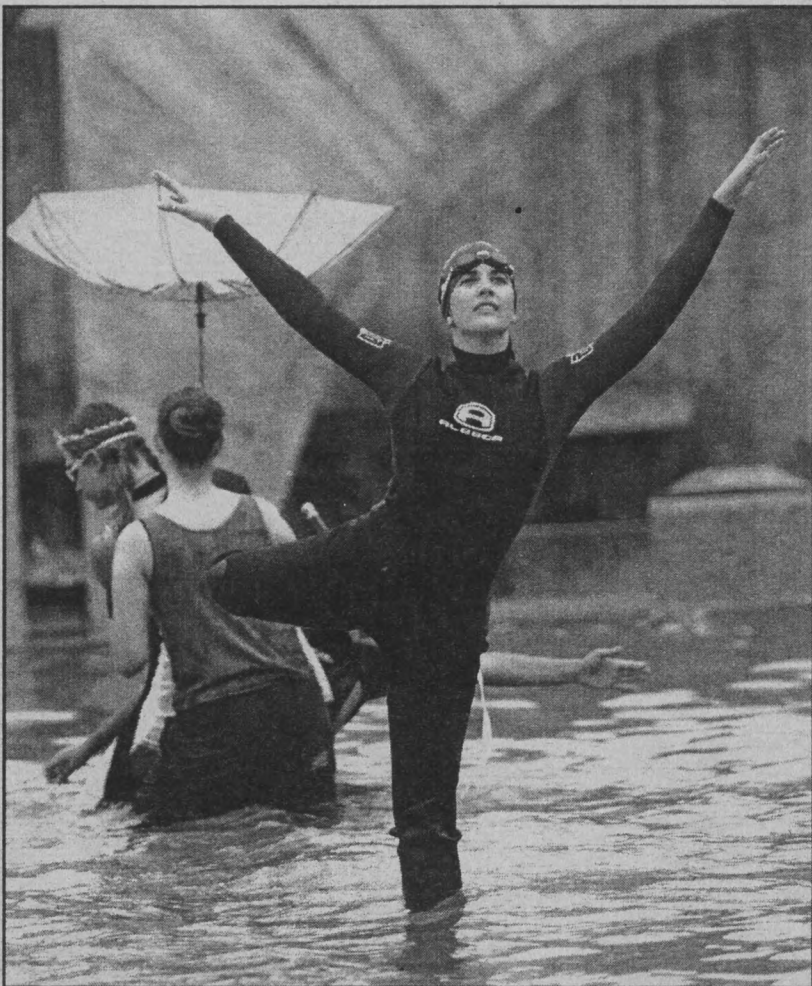

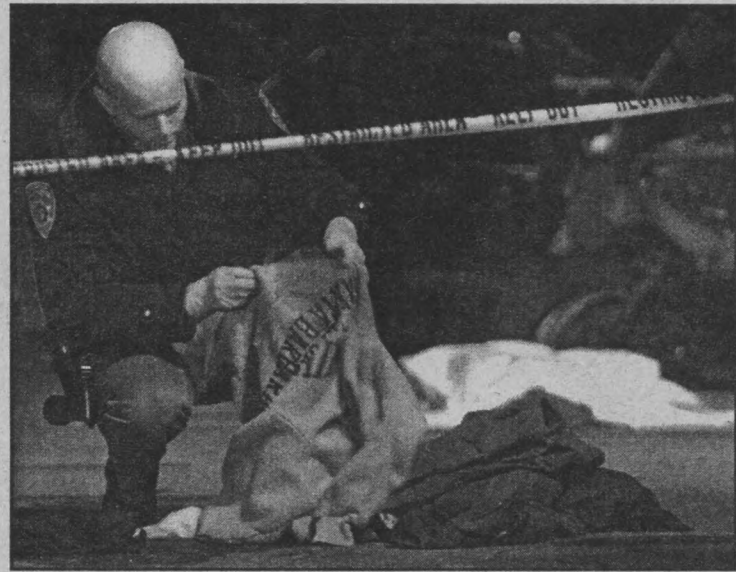

The William J. Villa Departmental Service to Students Award *honors*

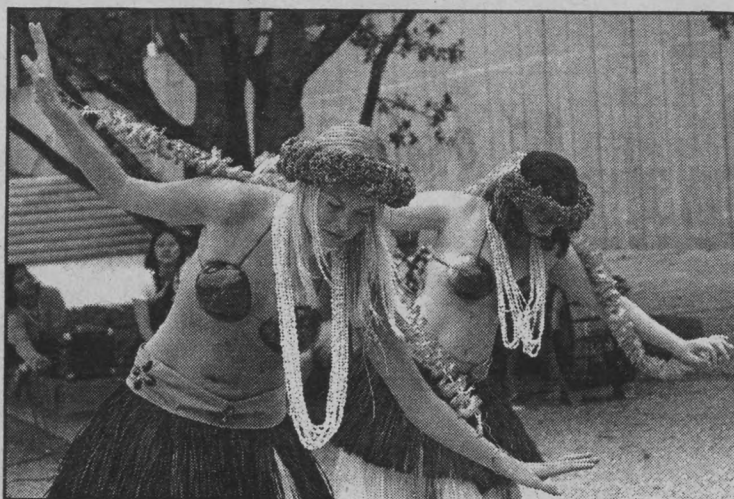
