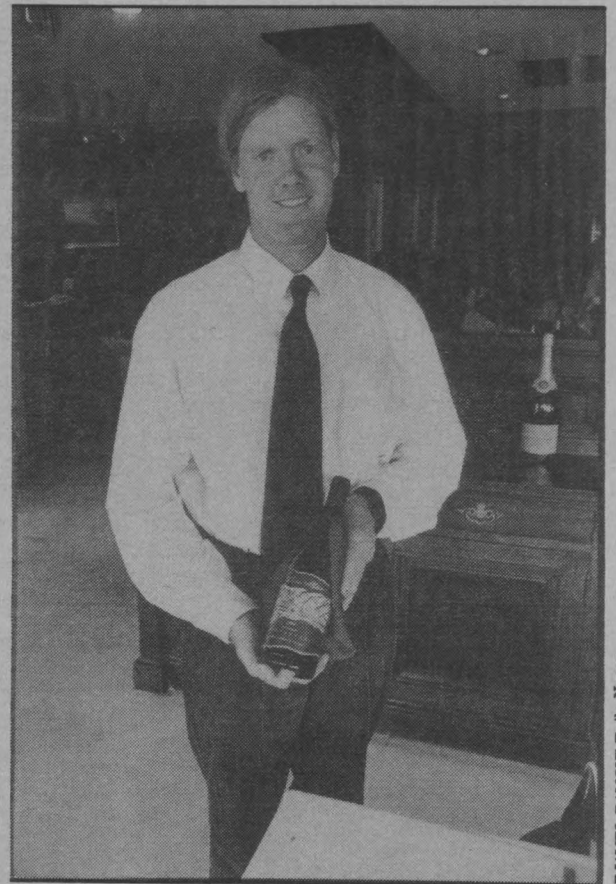
Romantic Rosa's Ristorante!

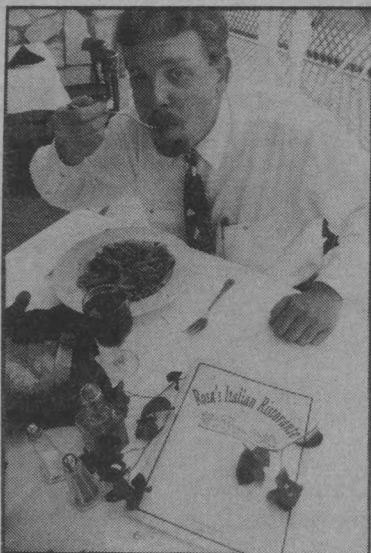

Surprisingly enough, most of these dinners were around \$11.50 (including the beverage).

Like always, Rosa's dinners come with unlimited Italian bread, a generous salad and your choice of pasta and sauce. For the delicate or conscious palate, they also offer a variety of vegetarian Italian dishes as well. I was personally impressed because 95 percent of their menu was Italian, right down to their desserts. If the main course isn't enough to indulge you, go for the dessert and try the tiramisu. I am warning those who want to do this: if you go this far, you may never leave the restaurant. It is pure indulgence!

Believe it or not, this hedonistic locale is under 15 minutes from Isla Vista and under 10 if you live downtown. And grads, if you haven't planned your party yet, Rosa's Italian Ristorante has banquet facilities for 20-100 people. Call ahead for reservations, soon! Lazy Lunchin' at Red Robin

Despite a misplaced wallet and a closed freeway off-ramp, I completed the first part of my assignment by making it to the Red Robin restaurant.

Since my memory lapses had already added a few time-consuming and unplanned sidetracks to the evening, I was hoping that once I entered the front door, I would be allowed to relax and enjoy the experience.

Much to my extended

relief, the interior of the Red Robin was pleasantly designed and, due to the hour (I assume), relatively empty. I distinctly remember trying to decipher the exact motif the restaurant was trying to achieve — it had '50s-diner-style wall decorations and chrome, '70s upholstery on the booth cushions and large cartoon pictures of red robins everywhere.

Although I still felt comfortable with the family-

oriented themes, I couldn't help but feel that I should have brought someone who would have made use of the crayons and coloring placemats that were prominently displayed.

Complementing the rest of the decor was a painting of a Mona Lisa with the munchies, for she held a huge Red Robin double cheeseburger in one hand.

I had managed to work up quite an appetite be-

forehand, so I was hungry and ready to go. With a big budget in mind, I ordered chicken fajitas, while my dining companion got a "whiskey" something-or-other chicken sandwich.

Despite the name and high hopes, we concluded that the chicken sandwich did not, in fact, contain any whiskey.

Right away, I bit into pure ecstasy: fried mozzarella sticks. For a guy with a relatively bland and monotonous diet, these batter-dipped sticks of cheese were unbelievable when dipped in sumptuous ranch dressing.

Our waitress, who was also the hostess, was prompt, courteous and friendly. When Jennifer, as she allowed me to call her (although this might have had less to do with her being friendly and more to do with her not wanting to give me her last name), brought our meals, I was pleasantly surprised at the size of the portions.

The fajitas came with so much chicken and other various toppings that I would get confused and overfill my tortillas, resulting in a messy plate and an unattractive napkin. The nonalcoholic chicken sandwich was average, according to an on-site study I conducted.

For the amount of food

Although the Red Robin does offer beer and some drinks, my financial situation precluded their sampling. Oh well, all the better for next time.


