The Gauchos are in the midst of a fantastic season that boasts a record of 22-3 overall and 11-1 in the Big West Conference. Despite losing the premier middle blocker in the nation, senior All-American Katie Crawford, to injury (see page 3A), Santa Barbara is currently ranked #7 in the nation by the USA Today/AVCA Coaches Poll.

The Gauchos have relied heavily on junior All-American Roberta Gehlke. Known as "Robbi" to her team, the outside hitter leads the Big West in kills and digs per game. Also

Also a plus for UCSB Head Coach Kathy Gregory has been the brilliance of freshman setter Brooke Rundle, who is second in the Big West in assists.

Friday night's #7 UCSB vs. #1 Long Beach State women's volleyball match will be broadcast live on KCSB, 91.9 FM. Tune in at 7 p.m. for all the action from the showdown in the Pyramid.

#### **Injury Casting Shadow for V-ball**

UCSB junior middle blocker Katie Crawford has been cooling her 6'3" jets for the past 10 games and will miss this week's crucial Big West heavyweight bouts with #9 Pacific and #1 Long Beach State due to an injured right hand.

The Santa Barbara star sustained torn ligaments and an evulsion fracture of the right thumb in pregame activities before the Boise State match on Oct. 8. Crawford, a Fallbrook, Calif., native had the Gauchos positioned at #3 in the nation at the moment of her injury.

Crawford was put into a hard cast and her status for the rest of the season was questionable. The prognosis has improved, however. While she will miss this week's action, Crawford could be out of the cast next week and may possibly see the floor against UC Irvine on Nov. 13 and Cal State Fullerton on Nov. 14 in the Thunderdome.

In the meantime, UCSB Head Coach Kathy Gregory has stressed the importance of a quick offensive attack. The Gauchos have sped up their game and have been able to spread the ball around quite effectively in Crawford's absence, but it will be a welcome sight for UCSB volleyball fans — and a fearful one for UCSB volleyball opponents — when #13 strolls back onto the court in uniform rather than street clothes.



The Gaucho men's and women's soccer teams have struggled to just a handful of wins, but those wins have been vindicating because most have come against better-funded squads.

The men's team has had a rough go of it and has limped to a 2-15 record. The Gauchos did, however, open a can of whoop-ass on Menlo College for their first win of the season. Santa Barbara punished the Bay

Area school for 13 goals. The shutout was a baker's dozen to remember.

The Gauchos seemed to be snake-bitten from the start. Junior Sean Herrity went down early to injury as did sophomore Steven Sosa, AKA "the Maestro." Sosa is a gifted playmaker with international experience and was sorely missed.

The women's squad was a defense/ball control team that just couldn't get the ball in the net. The Gauchos finished 4-14-1 overall and 1-7 in the Big West under

Junior Cindy Goebel was the high scorer with three goals.

While the women's team has wrapped up its season (on a winning note, too, because the Gauchos handled WAC leading UTEP) the men's squad still has games left on the docket. UCSB will have home matches on Nov. 6, 8 and 13 in Harder Stadium.
