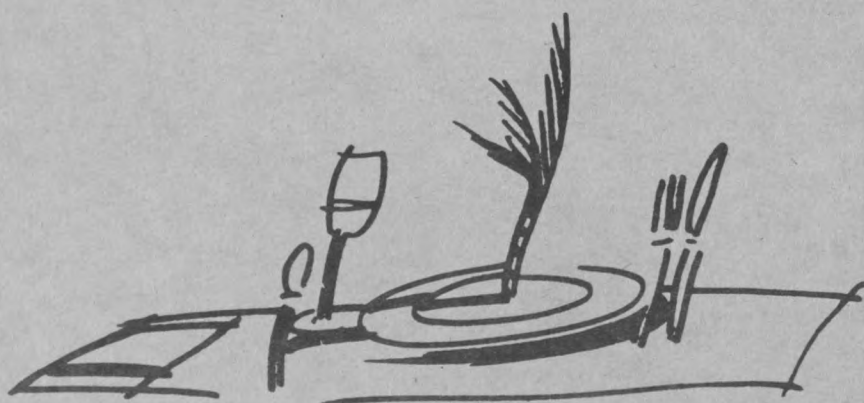
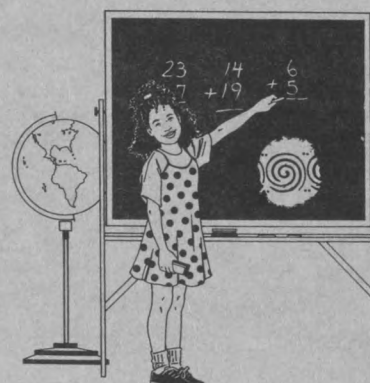

The Brickyard

The Indianapolis 500 is one of the grandest and most prestigious automobile races in the world, where people of many nations come together to view a driving spectacle.

And in that traditionally hot May weekend in Indiana, 100,000 fanatics will converge upon the Brickyard to drink beer, place a friendly wager on their favorite Italian driver and sit back to wonder how those Indy cars can achieve their 215 mph speeds.

Well, Santa Barbara has its own Brickyard located right in the heart of downtown, and even though you won't see Al Unser Jr., Mario or even Michael Andretti, you won't be in the 90-degree Indiana heat and you won't be able to view supercharged automobiles hit insane velocities — you can still get some good brew.

If it's beer you want, it's beer you can get at the Brickyard. Drive on down in your puny, four-cylinder vehicle at five miles under the limit and

try one of more than 80 kinds of brew on tap, though you might want to bring a designated sober person.

I like to just sit down at the long oak bar with my friends and experiment with all the import beers that can't be bought at any Isla Vista liquor store. Since we cannot wager on our favorite Andretti, we wager on who gets drunk first.

Starting off with an alcohol-rich Warsteiner Pilsner blend, followed by an intoxicating Double Diamond bitter ale, the lightweights spin out early and hit the wall. However, for those of us who are still in the running, we take a pit stop to order an appetizer of either the sausage platter, lemon lager chicken strips or split a couple of Bruno Burgers.

We head back into high drinking gear with a semi-warm Woodpecker cider and then take a hairpin turn into a Buzzard's Breath pale ale, before going into the final beer lap enjoying a full-head Guin-

ness stout.

By this time I've been declared the winner, because I can still stand, and I usually celebrate by dancing in the winner's circle. The great thing about the Brickyard is that the night is not just relegated to drinking.

After downing a few pints, I get the courage to dance in the people-packed portion in the back.

Not only does the Brickyard have that unique atmosphere of being both a dance club and a bar, but for the sporty types, darts, pool and video games (with Cruisin' USA) provide another element that can be wagered upon.

As every Indy car has a different engine, every drunk has his drink. In other words, the Brickyard has a fully stocked bar and provides a wide variety.

Dine at Cody's Cafe

To me, patriotism is a year-round sentiment. If I had my way, the Fourth of July would be celebrated 24 hours a day, 365 days a year.

But never mind the fireworks. What I'm talking about here is some good ol' American cuisine.

That's why when that U.S. of A. urge overtook my favorite dining companion Biff and myself, we barely hesitated before hopping into the car and jetting over to Cody's Cafe.

Located off swinging Hollister Avenue, Cody's unassuming facade belies a warm, inviting inner sanctum of culinary content that served as a warm welcome to Biff and myself. Upon entering, we encountered a picture of Cody's namesake — the appealing pooch for which the establishment was named.

Settling down in a comfy booth, we were quickly assisted by a friendly server and promptly provided with our drinks — a sparkling diet cola for myself and the finest of iced teas for the Biffmeister. Nothing but the best for that little pup.

The choice of cuisine was tempting, almost too much so. What to choose, what to choose, when the substan-

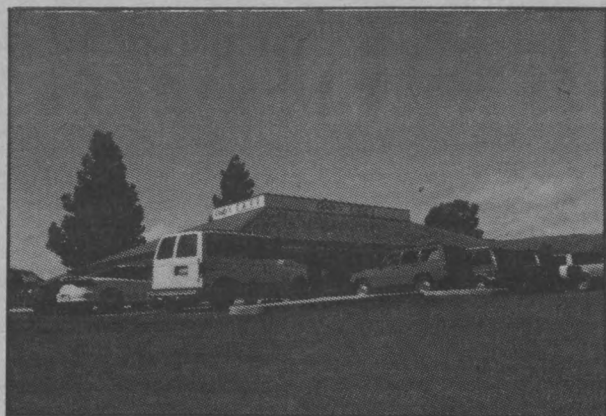
tial menu seems to include everything up to and nearly including the kitchen sink? It all looked so appetizing that we were temporarily thrown into a culinary quandary before finally making up our minds and giving our orders to our mercifully patient waitress.

Then came the meals — and a feast they were. I indulged in the grilled chicken, which came accompanied by the crispest french fries this side of the ol' Miss. I vowed to forever forfeit home cooking as I savored the side salad and the garden of mixed vegetables along with my meal — who could beat this?

Biff, for his part, partook of the steak dish, and I have yet to see his eyes glow before or since in the manner they did as he consumed his meal. It was superbly cooked, rare and tender on the inside, juicy and substantial-looking on the outside.

Biff, too, had nothing but praise for Cody's fare, and the superlatives bounced back and forth across the table like tennis balls at a spirited match.

Then came time for dessert — once again, it was American all the way. It was delectable apple pie a la mode for Biff and a hunk of mouth-watering chocolate

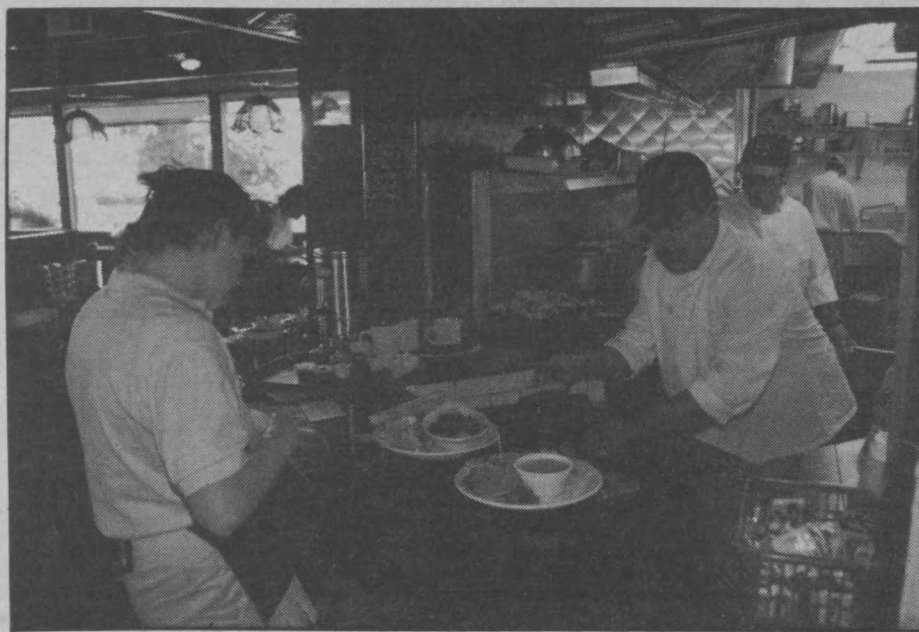

cake for myself, accompanied by some of the finest coffee I've had in a while. Dessert proved the perfect end to a fabulous meal, and Biff couldn't help but agree.

As we bid goodbye to the photo of the restaurant's namesake in the front lobby and ventured out into the chilly night, Biff and I vowed that the next time that patriotic urge was to strike, Cody's Cafe would most definitely be the establishment where it would be assuaged.

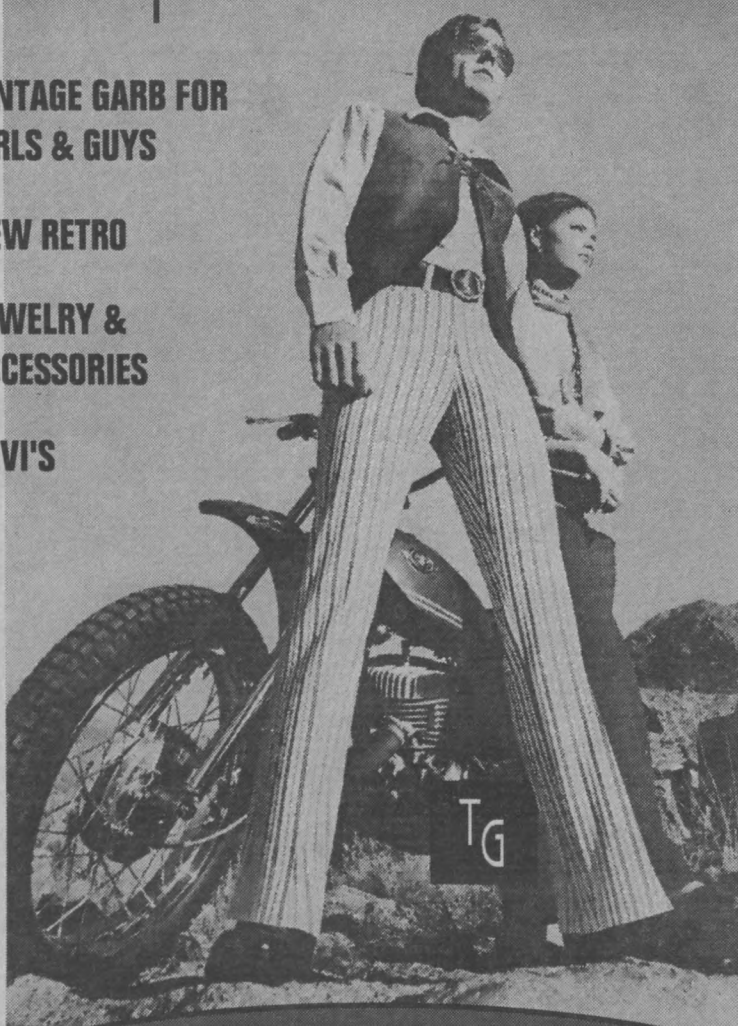

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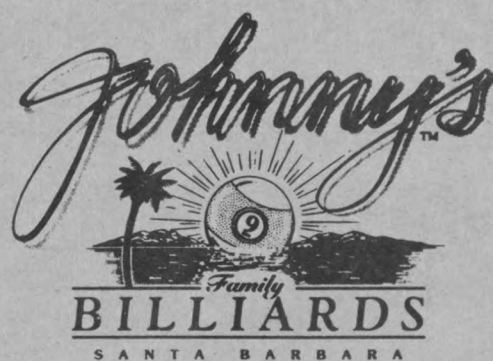
