The pizza, reasonably priced from \$7.50 for a 12 in-cher to \$10.50 for a 16 incher, is probably some of the best to be found in Santa Barbara, and that's not a rating to smirk at.

Of particular note on the menu is Pino's Fettuccine all'Alfredo. Made with homemade egg noodles with cream, bacon, ham butter and cheese. This delight will make the trip into Goleta worthwhile whether you drive, ride or walk. And at a mere \$9.95, it is a clear standout among comparable dishes at other Santa Barbara Italian eateries.

One item on the menu that is difficult to find at Italian food places, but is always well worth the search, is Gnocchi. Pino's Gnocchi, or potato dumplings, are a special treat, especially for those connoisseurs of Italian food who pride themselves on knowing where

the best, hard-to-find food can be had. The Gnocchi is offered with either tomato sauce or a delicate fresh basil sauce.

Pino's offers more than just food, too. Pino, who has owned the restaurant for 14 years, can frequently be found singing to the patrons. And although he is a bit hard to understand few UCSB students understand Italian — he provides ample entertainment and

adds legitimacy to the Italian atmosphere.

If Italian wine suits your fancy, Pino's has a select offering of affordable, excellent wines. The Corvo, Rosso, at \$15.95 is an excellent Italian red wine for a date or just to swig with friends.

In traditional Italian style, Pino's serves up some heaping helpings of its food. There is no doubt that a Pino's entree is enough to satiate even the most hearty eater — although it certainly is difficult to restrain

I remember my first trip to Joe's Cafe in Santa Barbara like it was yesterday. But it wasn't yesterday, and I was not the cool, calm, mellow and relaxed guy I am now.
