

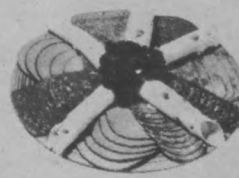

What can you say about a restaurant that's hidden in the hills of the Los Padres National Forest, looks like Laura Ingalls' home and is frequented by members of various motorcycle "clubs"?

Good food, that's what!

Be prepared, folks. This joint is not your typical greasy spoon, hole in the wall, dingy little diner. Not by a long shot, no way.

The Cold Spring Tavern is a classy operation.

From the homemade bread served before your meal, to the sizeable wine list, right on down to the genuine cloth napkins at each and every place setting, the CST — as it is wont to be called — has it all.

They've got duck. They've got rabbit. They've got chicken. Boy, do they have chicken. They've got

the north forty in the distance.

But step inside and you'll be transported away to another environ all together.

Comfort seems to have been the idea behind the modeling of the Tavern — as it is also wont to be called — and it is comfortable. As the menus say, the tavern originally was a rest-stop for weary travelers making their way by stagecoach across the Santa Barbara moun-

tains. It's too bad that option is not available anymore.

I don't know if you've ever ridden in a stagecoach, but it's hot, dusty, bumpy and all around — not too much fun. So naturally a rest-stop is going to try to be cool, clean, soft and fun — just like Cold Springs.

In fact, it's very fun. The fireplaces in each room are fun. The homey furniture is fun. The wood floors are fun. Heck, even the waiters and waitresses are fun.

So to sum it up, the Cold Spring Tavern offers good food, is comfortable, relaxing and fun. Check it out. You won't be sorry, not by a long shot.

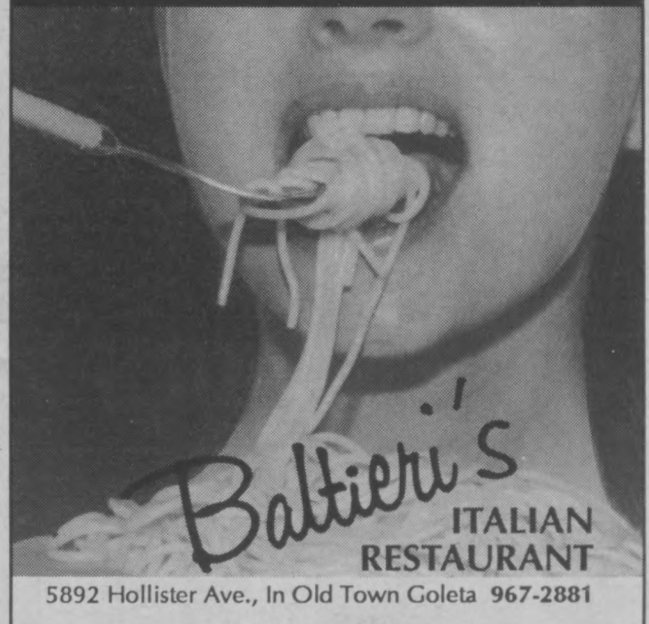

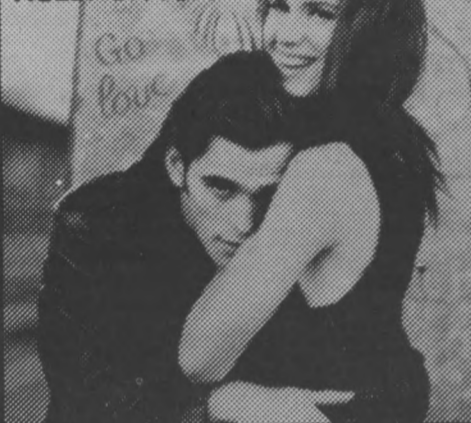

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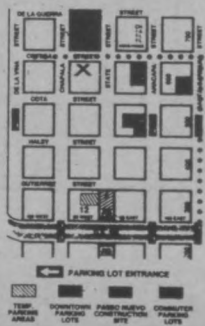

There are few completely family owned and operated restaurants in the Santa Barbara area, and if you want one with good food to boot, Pino's Ristorante Italiano is the place to go.

Pino and his family own and operate this marvel of Italian cuisine. Featuring everything from excellent pizza to fresh mussels, Pino's brings genuine Italian foods to the South Coast.

For appetizers Pino's offers some delicious, incredibly soft garlic bread in that true, mouth-stuffing Italian style. If you can, make sure to get a second order.

The pizza, reasonably priced from \$7.50 for a 12 inch to \$10.50 for a 16 inch, is probably some of the best to be found in Santa Barbara, and that's not a rating to smirk at.

Of particular note on the menu is Pino's Fettuccine all'Alfredo. Made with homemade egg noodles with cream, bacon, ham butter and cheese. 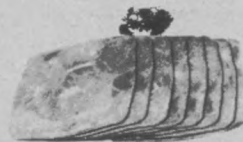

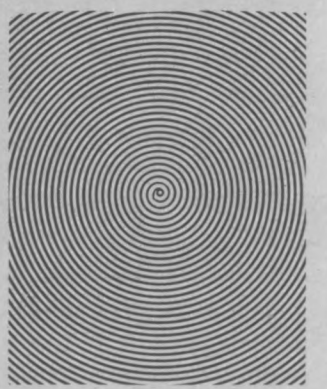

I remember my first trip to Joe's Cafe in Santa Barbara like it was yesterday. But it wasn't yesterday, and I was not the cool, calm, mellow and relaxed guy I am now.

Italian-American food, in an atmosphere that's guaranteed to make you enjoy the experience. Good food, good times, it's good enough for me (and for you too, I daresay).

The "older woman" has long since stopped being a part of my life, so my friend Natasha and I had a good laugh while I reminisced about that "first date" at Joe's. Natasha is a native Santa Barbaran, and loves Joe's Cafe about as much as I do.
