#### WHO ARE WE?


The **URC** is neither a denominational church nor a temple but rather a center for campus ministries of various faiths (20 ministers from 16 different religious groups.)

LIVE also distributes government surplus food & garden produce as available at these times on Tues., Thurs. and Sat., 7 - 9 a.m.


