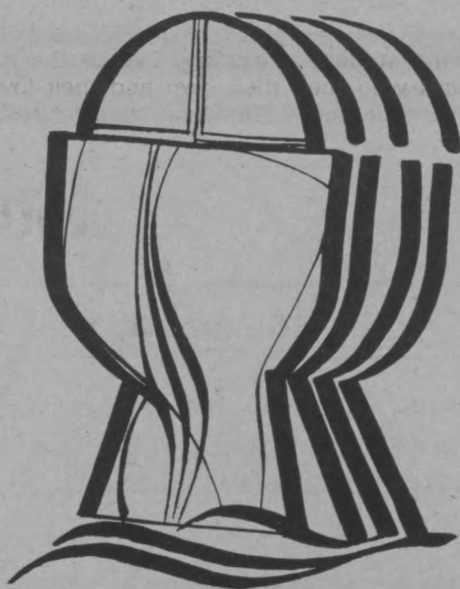
(LIVE) provides free breakfasts Mon.-Sat. to low income people:

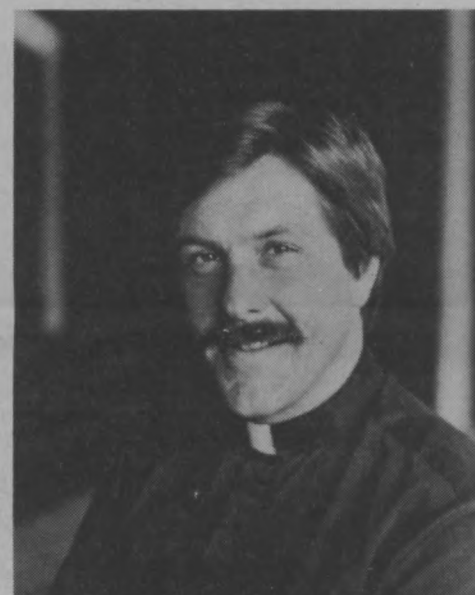

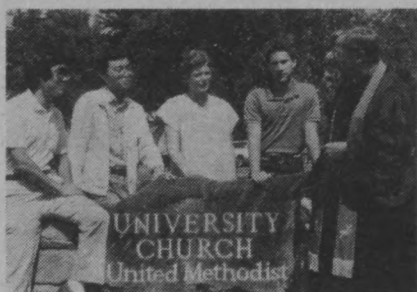
Come Look Us Over

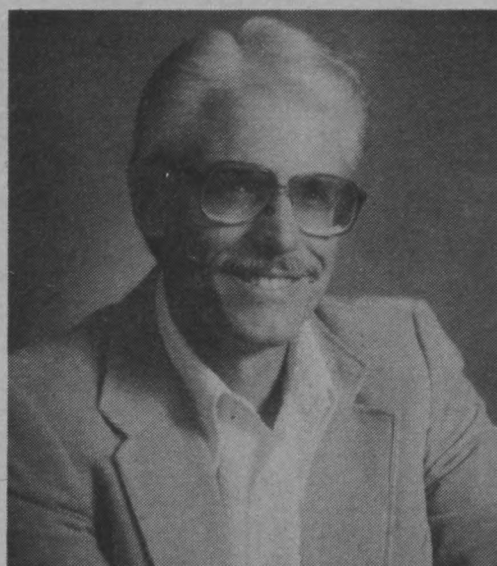

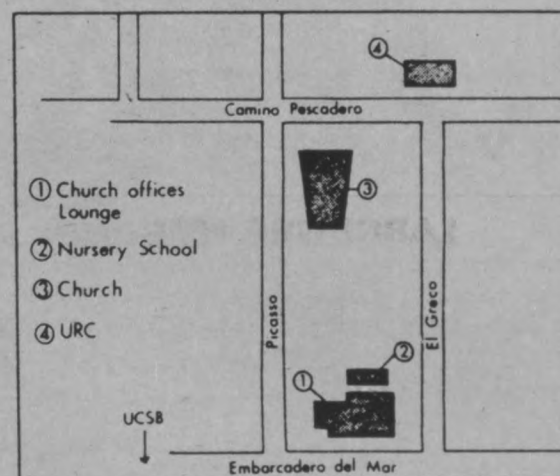


