cheese. Am I wrong? And about the Spaghetti Aglio-Olio ... well, let me tell you that Max has calmed



# Fresh I.V. Bakery

One balmy night last summer I sat among friends outside a local Isla Vista eatery, and while we contemplated life and baseball and the Civil War, a gentleman named Tennessee made an innocuous remark that has grown more and more pro-

found in my memory. "This is almost like Paris," he said, gesturing at the stars. "This is almost existential."

He said this with such conviction that it was hard to refute. Life indeed could be intensely romantic and beautiful, even in the mod-est climes of I.V.

I was reminded of this experience on a recent sojourn to the I.V. Bakery and Cafe - just possibly the best kept secret in town. It is a modest establishment at the center of Pardall with just a few well-placed tables inside for a cozy morning coffee and apple strudel as well as sea-

sant, fresh out of the oven. It boasts, without a doubt, some of the best pastry west of Berlin.

I was accompanied by Max, Ben and Matt (no relation). All were old expatri-ate friends and none could resist the temptation of a good bakery. Together, we succumbed to the scent of fresh bread and one by one we found ourselves, eyes closed and noses alert, walking through the door.

What they ordered speaks volumes about their strengths and weaknesses, but mostly the latter. Matt could not help himself any longer and, stepping sprightly to the counter, breathlessly asked for a cheese pocket - an airy, wonderful, not-too-sweet pastry lined with a healthy dose of cheese filling. For Matt it evoked memories of a youth misspent, of purloined pastries from the open markets west of the Seine. He ate it greedily, or-dered another and stepped outside.

In return, I bought a sensible blueberry muffin, a fresh loaf of bread for just 10 bits and a strawberry cheese pie to bring home for the child-ren. For \$3 (with a coupon), it was too cheap to pass up, and mõre than worth it to bring a smile to little Jimmy's face.

Kyoto: Fine Sushi

#### By Charles Gomer Scott

Charles Gomer Scott isn't the sort of guy to get wrapped up in trends.

He never owned a pet rock. He didn't waste his time trying to learn how to do the Rubik's Cube. And he certainly doesn't start patronizing a particular type of restaurant simply because the cultural elite says it's "the thing to do."

That makes Mr. Scott's infatuation with Kyoto, Santa Barbara's premiere Japanese restaurant, all the more tantalizing a story to tell

According to the Japan-ese literature that Charles Gomer studied at UCSB, particularly the works of noted 20th-century man of letters Yunichuro Tanizaki, Kyoto represents Japan's Far West — the traditional Japan — isolated from the perspective. You see, they do things there like in the old country.

Walk in the door and look around. The first thing to catch the eye is the long row of shoes lining the doors to the small tradition-ally matted, paper-walled dining areas.

In Japan one takes off one's shoes before setting foot on a traditional Japanese tea mat, or any other mat for that matter, and at Kyoto this tradition is well kept.

The walls of the small dining areas, as I said, are paper, and reveal the sillhouettes of diners, beautifully elegant and at the same time mysteriously unknown.

Tanizaki remarked in his classic treatise In Praise of Shadows that the beauty of Japan is what is not revealed to the naked eye. Just viewing two people sharing a clandestine embrace after the trimmings. a meal in their private dining area, while they recline on cushy pillow-chairs and sup on delectable delights from Kyoto's massive menu,

instills in us a knowledge of what Tanizaki was writing about.

If neccesity should call, however, they have tradi-

tional American booths. The food at Kyoto does not need to be obscured by shadows. It is a sushi lover's paradise, with numerous a la carte offerings and several specials guaranteed to leave you satiated.

There a sashimi combination (tuna, yellowtail, tako, saba and salmon strips served raw on rice) which comes with soup and Japan-ese salads for only \$13.95. Not only is the presentation aesthetic and authentic, but it's darn tasty too.

There's tuna hand rolls, yellowtail hand rolls, regular chef's specials and Mr. Scott's favorite, the California roll. Just think about it - crab, avocado, rice, special sauces, served with all

friends have attested to liking their food a bit more on the cooked side. To these Westerners Kyoto says, "No problem!"

There's seafood and veg-etable *tempura* galore, steak dishes cooked Japanese style, all sorts of other seafood dinners and yes, the perennial favorite sukiyaki.

Dream about it: vegetables and noodles and meat or seafood or chicken cooked in a sweet soy sauce/sugar broth, served with soup and salad, and rice and fruit, and KYOTO! Like I said, Charles

Gomer Scott doesn't dine just anywhere, yet this is one Santa Barbara establishment you're likely to find him taking his shoes off in often. Join him.

And it was! Everything sounded so good, we had no idea which way to turn. So we just ordered with our heart, which is generally a safe way to go.

And speaking of hearts, I want to say a few things about the health aspect of Max's. They're no wimpy health food store restaurant, but they approach their food and atmosphere in a fresh and — yes — healthy way. First of all, they do not allow smoking in the restaurant (not even as a

look and taste of things, they get everything they can fresh from local growers and distributors. They seem to have honestly gone out to find the best possible ingredients for every dish. Dining at Max's is a good, solid food experience.




