It didn't take long for my roommate Max to start barking.

"I've been living in this yucky beach side of a community for coming up on six years now and nowhere, NOWHERE! have I seen any stinking Spaghetti Aglio-Olio in the local Italian Restaurants! Nowhere! No place!"

Max gets like that when he starts thinking about those days on Capri island, swimming naked in the Grotto Azura, talking about "one-eyed jacks." He was younger then (alas, weren't we all?), filled with the heady aroma of a young man's pride and hunger and his need for good old-fashioned Gnocchi.

Pino's. That is basically what I'm talking about here. It's a warm step away on Hollister — a fresh atmosphere with a knack for a good meal. I have heard on good authority that they have a man who goes around and sings traditional Italian tunes to the enjoyment of the patrons. I have also heard that this is Pino himself. If I'm to believe what I hear, this experience alone is reason enough to dine at Pino's.

When we went last week, apparently our timing was off, because I didn't get to see any live entertainment. But I say this now: Their food is reason enough to

They have everything an Italian-food eater could love, from said Gnocchi to Rigatoni to Scampi Paesano to Vitella Scaloppine. This is not some so-called Italian restaurant that will try to sneak by with some commonplace spaghetti and a

wedge of garlic bread. No, this is real and varied Italian food — the genuine article.

Perhaps Pino's is best known for their pizza. Its tangy sauces and rich cheeses has earned high marks from local pizza connoisseurs. And get this — they spell it "Pizze." Now

that's Italian.

While I'm at it, let me try to explain some of the dishes they serve up at Pino's. First, Rigatoni alla "Mamma Nata." It's your basic rigatoni with onions, ham, egg, pepperoni and cheese in tomato sauce. It may sound a little weird, but doesn't it

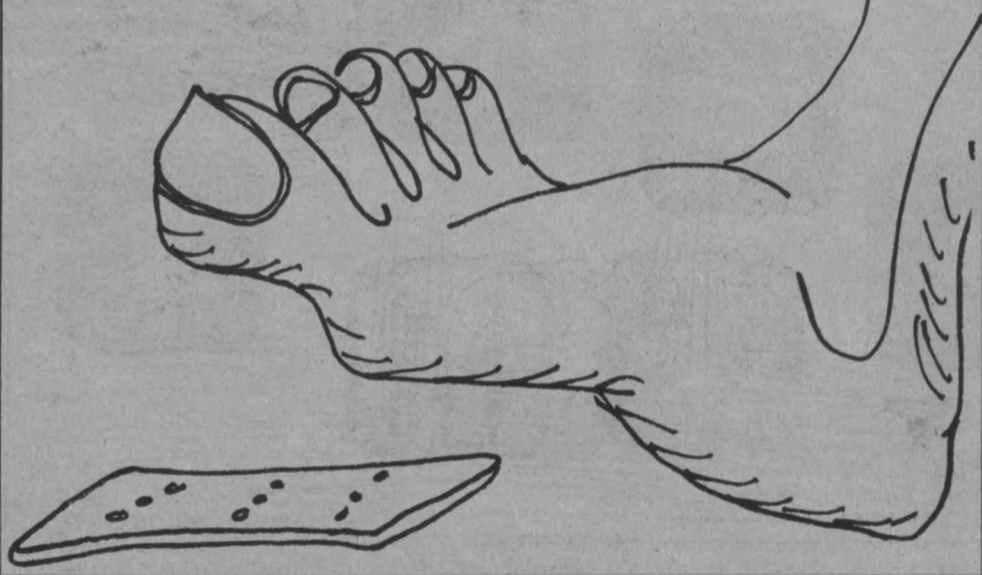
also sound a lot delicious? And what about the Fettuccine alla "Pino," with its homemade egg noodles and artichoke hearts, onions, garlic, cream, butter and cheese. Am I wrong?

And about the Spaghetti Aglio-Olio ... well, let me tell you that Max has calmed

down considerably. There's just something that good pasta with fresh garlic and olive oil does to sooth a soul.

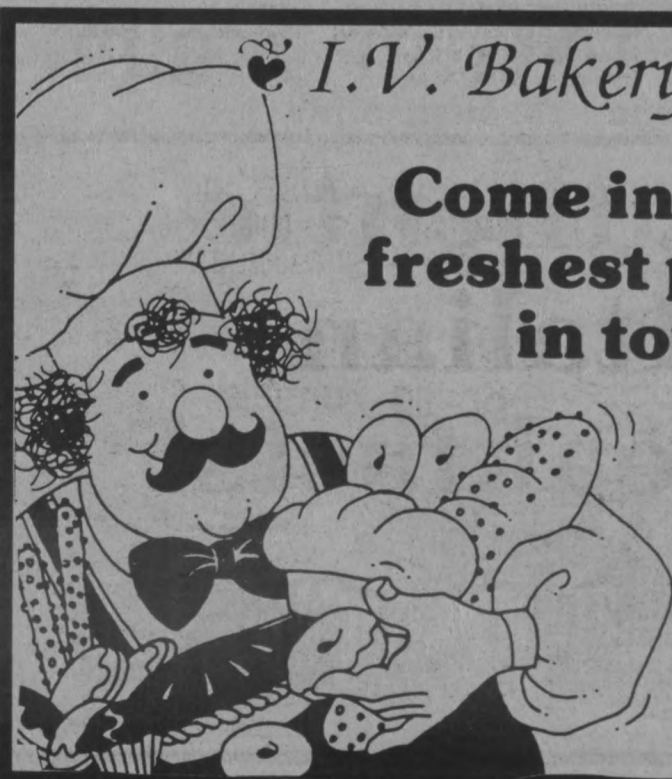



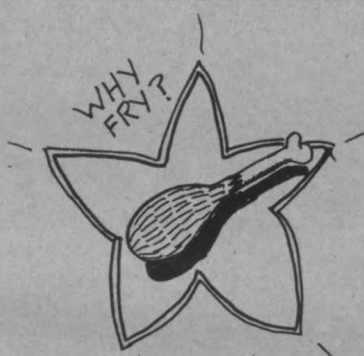

# Fresh I.V. Bakery!

One balmy night last summer I sat among friends outside a local Isla Vista eatery, and while we contemplated life and baseball and the Civil War, a gentleman named Tennessee made an innocuous remark that has grown more and more profound in my memory.

"This is almost like Paris," he said, gesturing at the stars. "This is almost existential."

He said this with such conviction that it was hard to refute. Life indeed could be intensely romantic and beautiful, even in the modest climes of I.V.

I was reminded of this experience on a recent sojourn to the I.V. Bakery and Cafe — just possibly the best kept secret in town. It is a modest establishment at the center of Pardall with just a few well-placed tables inside for a cozy morning coffee and apple strudel as well as seating outside for basking unabashedly in the sunshine with an orange juice and perhaps an almond crois-

sant, fresh out of the oven. It boasts, without a doubt, some of the best pastry west of Berlin.

I was accompanied by Max, Ben and Matt (no relation). All were old expatriate friends and none could resist the temptation of a good bakery. Together, we succumbed to the scent of fresh bread and one by one we found ourselves, eyes closed and noses alert, walking through the door.

What they ordered speaks volumes about their strengths and weaknesses, but mostly the latter. Matt could not help himself any longer and, stepping sprightly to the counter, breathlessly asked for a cheese pocket — an airy, wonderful, not-too-sweet pastry lined with a healthy dose of cheese filling. For Matt it evoked memories of a youth misspent, of purloined pastries from the open markets west of the Seine. He ate it greedily, ordered another and stepped outside.

Ben spent several revealing minutes in a fit of indecision. "I think I'll have a fruit

bar or a chocolate éclair — or maybe just a couple chocolate croissants and some milk. ... Wait, they have muffins? Hey, what's that (pointing to an apple turnover)? ..."

It was this indecision that cost Ben, many years ago, the life of his first love. But that is another story. This time, with no harm done, he settled on a fruit bar. He then retired to the sidewalk terrace and spent several more minutes selecting a chair to sit in.

Max, who had been prodding Ben impatiently for several minutes now, snapped at the poor baker in an unintelligible German tongue. It turned out he had asked for some blood sausage, for which the baker looked in vain. He later pounced on a ham and cheese croissant and, after attempting to haggle, agreed to pay the original 80 cent pricetag. The emotional carnage of Communism still scarred Max to the core, but he is a good man at heart.

I exchanged greetings with the baker and asked politely how he was afford

to stay in business with such low prices. "Volume!" he answered simply. In return, I bought a sensible blueberry muffin, a fresh loaf of bread for just 10 bits and a strawberry cheese pie to bring home for the children. For \$3 (with a coupon), it was too cheap to pass up, and more than worth it to bring a smile to little Jimmy's face.

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

# Kyoto: Fine Sushi

By Charles Gomer Scott

Charles Gomer Scott isn't the sort of guy to get wrapped up in trends.

He never owned a pet rock. He didn't waste his time trying to learn how to do the Rubik's Cube. And he certainly doesn't start patronizing a particular type of restaurant simply because the cultural elite says it's "the thing to do."

That makes Mr. Scott's infatuation with Kyoto, Santa Barbara's premiere Japanese restaurant, all the more tantalizing a story to tell.

According to the Japanese literature that Charles Gomer studied at UCSB, particularly the works of noted 20th-century man of letters Yunchuro Tanizaki, Kyoto represents Japan's Far West — the traditional Japan — isolated from the changes modernity brought to the island nation.

Knowing this before going to Kyoto in Santa Barbara puts everything into

perspective. You see, they do things there like in the old country.

Walk in the door and look around. The first thing to catch the eye is the long row of shoes lining the doors to the small traditionally matted, paper-walled dining areas.

In Japan one takes off one's shoes before setting foot on a traditional Japanese tea mat, or any other mat for that matter, and at Kyoto this tradition is well kept.

The walls of the small dining areas, as I said, are paper, and reveal the silhouettes of diners, beautifully elegant and at the same time mysteriously unknown.

Tanizaki remarked in his classic treatise *In Praise of Shadows* that the beauty of Japan is what is not revealed to the naked eye. Just viewing two people sharing a clandestine embrace after a meal in their private dining area, while they recline on cushy pillow-chairs and sup on delectable delights from Kyoto's massive menu,

instills in us a knowledge of what Tanizaki was writing about.

If necessity should call, however, they have traditional American booths.

The food at Kyoto does not need to be obscured by shadows. It is a sushi lover's paradise, with numerous a la carte offerings and several specials guaranteed to leave you satiated.

There's a sashimi combination (tuna, yellowtail, tako, saba and salmon strips served raw on rice) which comes with soup and Japanese salads for only \$13.95. Not only is the presentation aesthetic and authentic, but it's darn tasty too.

There's tuna hand rolls, yellowtail hand rolls, regular chef's specials and Mr. Scott's favorite, the California roll. Just think about it — crab, avocado, rice, special sauces, served with all the trimmings.

Charles Gomer may be a *gaijan*, or foreigner, in Japan, but at Kyoto he feels like the king.

Charles' more Occidental

friends have attested to liking their food a bit more on the cooked side. To these Westerners Kyoto says, "No problem!"

There's seafood and vegetable *tempura* galore, steak dishes cooked Japanese style, all sorts of other seafood dinners and yes, the perennial favorite — *sukiyaki*.

Dream about it: vegetables and noodles and meat or seafood or chicken cooked in a sweet soy sauce/sugar broth, served with soup and salad, and rice and fruit, and KYOTO!

Like I said, Charles Gomer Scott doesn't dine just anywhere, yet this is one Santa Barbara establishment you're likely to find him taking his shoes off in often. Join him.

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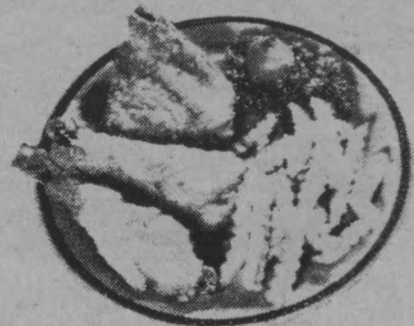
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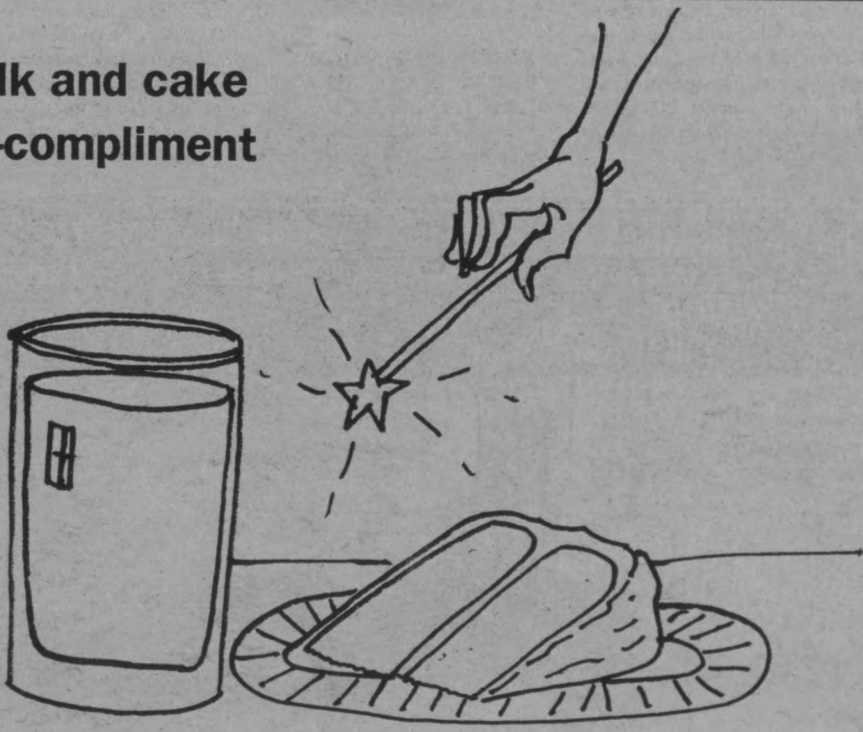

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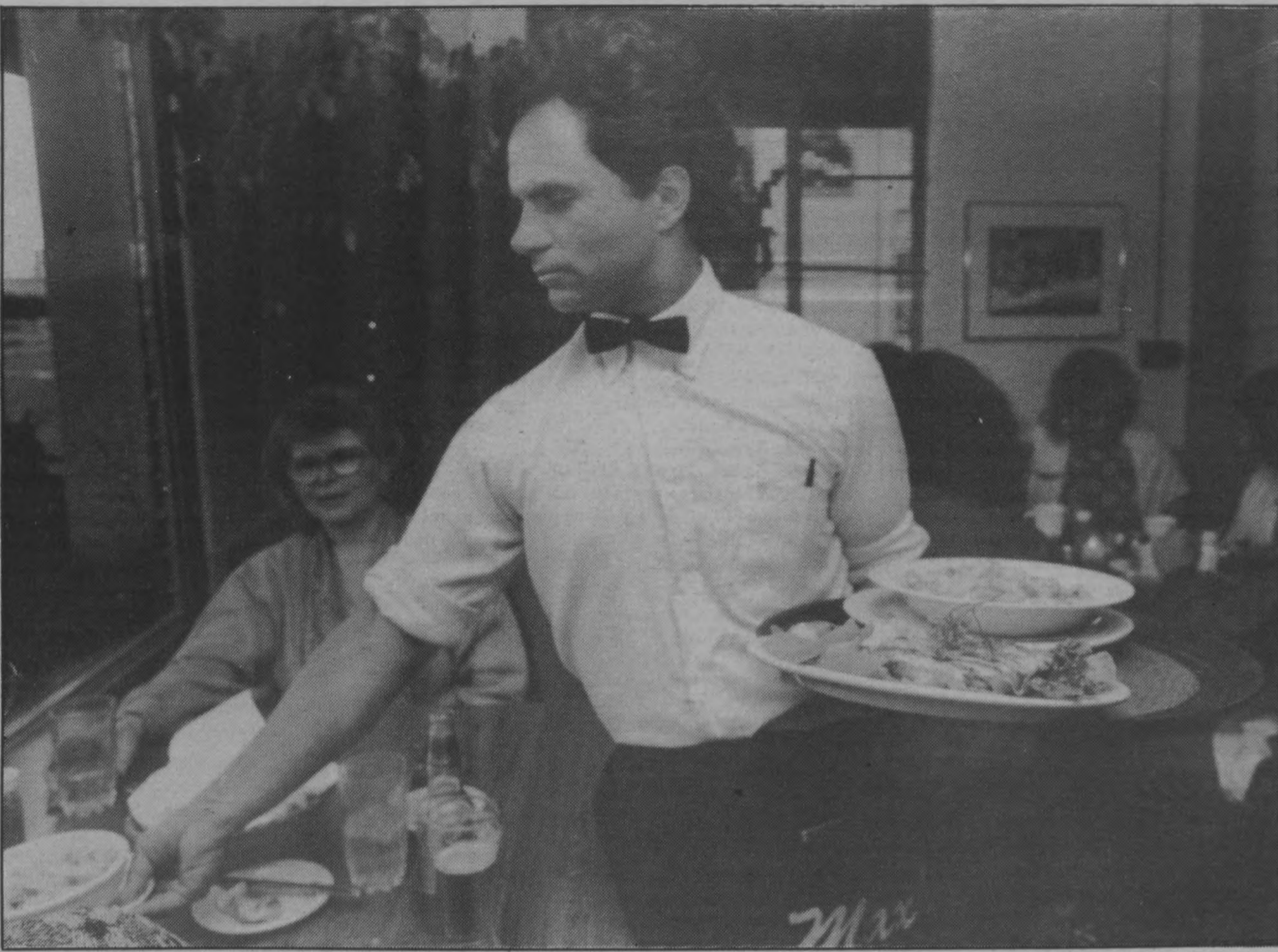

Dining at Max's is a good, solid food experience.

Take a look at their service. Every time I've been there, the waiters are just so friendly. It seems kind of silly to be saying this and be serious about it, but I think that the waiters are honestly trying to make your dinner or lunch a positive experience. It's just good! What can I say?

You can't begrudge Max's — nor would you want to. They are out there doing what a restaurant should be doing: stoking the patron. And it's a good place to take a date, I think.
