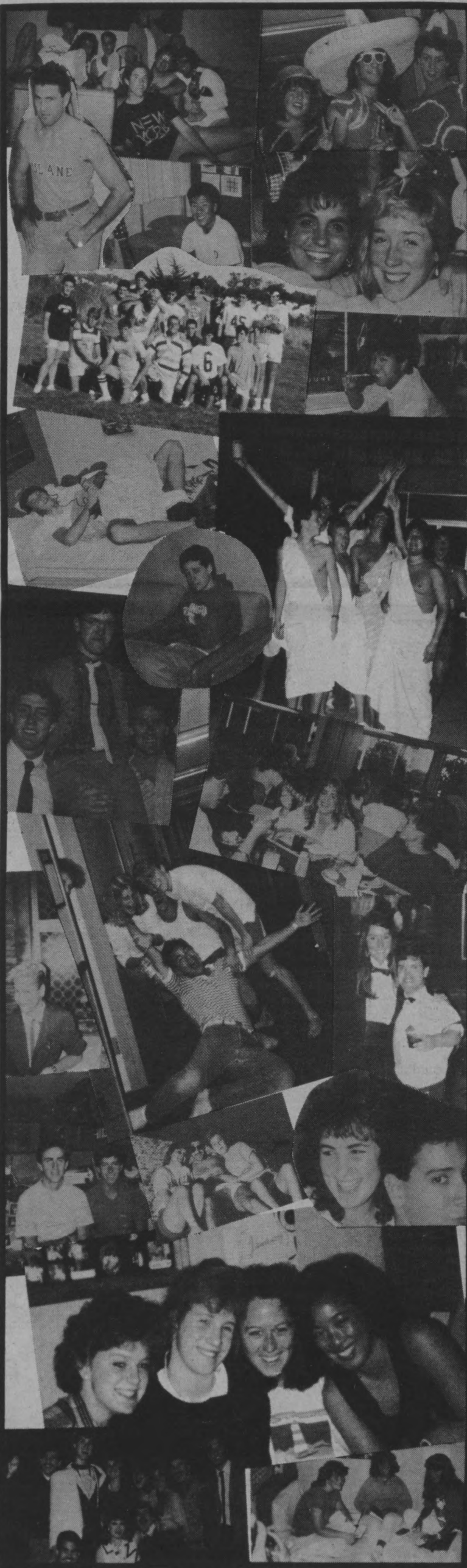

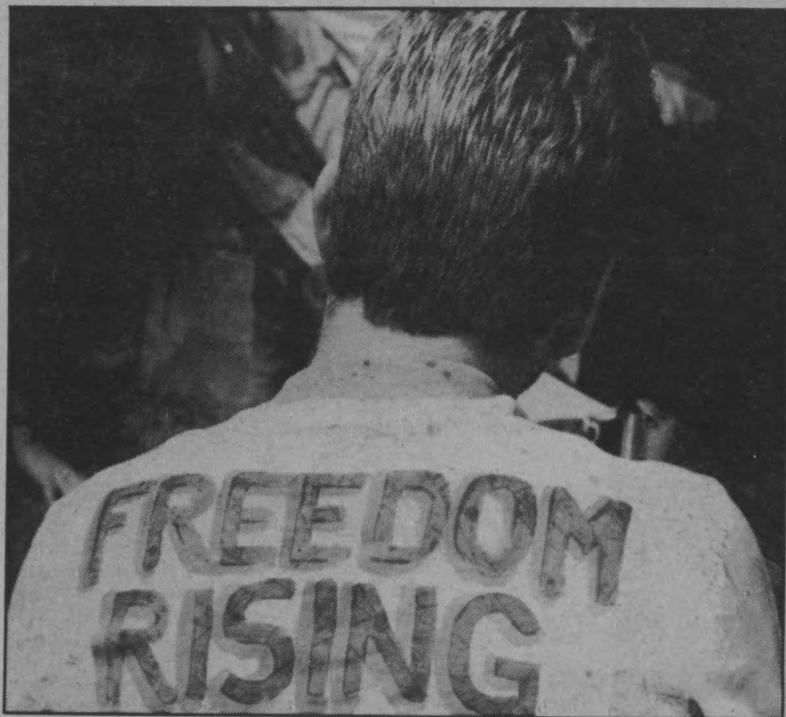
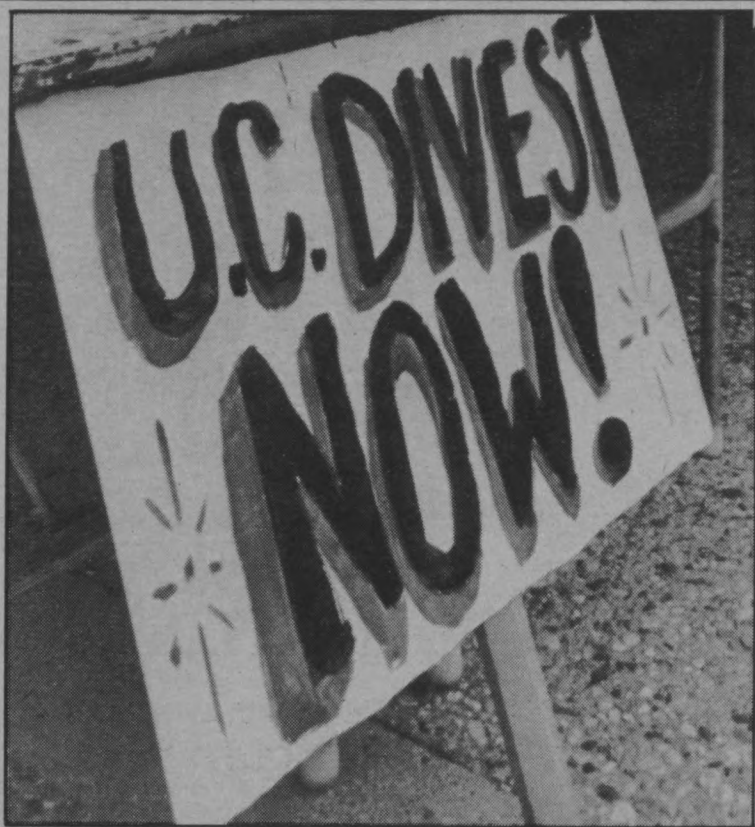
★ **TO MY NAUGHTY NUNS ON 10 NORTH**
