A nutty, bearded, apparently salty old chap peers out from cover of The Chase Uptown's menu. He looks to be some sort of crusty fisherman, what with a meanlooking net over one shoulder and a stuffed bag o' pescado slung under the other. His brow is quite furrowed. But it's the man's gnarled face that holds the most fascination. With an intense look of concentration, our man seems to be catching a whiff of something quite satisfac-tory. Maybe like fresh fish and chicken, accompanied by generous helpings of pasta smothered in thick, savory sauces and zesty cheeses, wafting from a nearby restaurant.

He's probably sniffing out Chase Uptown, the essence of Santa Barbara's Italo cuisine. Recently selected as having the best Italian food in Santa Barbara in a reader's poll sponsored by the friendly, local Independent weekly newspaper, Chase Uptown is a delightful experience in casual dining, one highly recommended for first time daters looking for moderately priced excellence.

Completely unpretentious with it's remodeled pizza parlor decor, soothing New Age background music and tasteful lighting, The Chase offers discriminating diners large portions of tender fish

and chicken, scrumptuous veals and steaks, and of course, impeccably boiled pastas. And the portions are large - perhaps too generous for some, especially considering the pre-meal soup or salad and bread. The menu is inde ¹

plump, brimming with all variety of Italian delights. Diners, however, are also recommended to sample the daily special, as well as the succulent "Uptown Combos" - Jumbo Shrimp and Chicken Piccata (with side of Fettucine Alfredo) for \$13.95, and the classic Surf and Turf (New York Steak and Medallion of Lobster Piccata, with Side of Spaghetti or Potatoes) for \$19.95. And hey — let's not forget that fine selection of wines and beers.

As the sister restaurant of the lower State Street staple Chase Downtown, Chase Uptown (located at 3614 State St. in low-key Upper State) is an ideal fun-spot for collegians seeking a respite from the dreary gaggle of Isla Vista/Goleta beer-foodmeat market nightspots. Beyond its downtown sister, The Chase Uptown features fish — and lots of it. And if the Uptown spot is too crowded, don't forget Downtown — both restaur-ants share the same chief chef, so the freshness (and quality) stays locked in.

The Chase is aggressively courting the UCSB market. With a new outdoor patio, which will feature in future

weeks heat-releasing umbrella coverings for those cool afternoons and evenings, the restaurant now has a delectable happy hour from 4-7 p.m. Monday through Friday. But here's the lucky catch: In addition

For some reason. whenever I eat at The Egghead in Isla Vista I get + feeling of being at a diner. Although the waitresses aren't wearing silly pink dresses embossed with their name in long, fluid, cursive script, and there's no blue plate special on the menu, you still always know what to expect when you eat there.

Many consider The Egghead an I.V. institution, as they've been providing students with a consistently good place to have a huge breakfast, at a reasonable price, for longer than most can remember. I humbly agree with this assessment and feel priveleged to introduce this landmark omelette on the wrong side of the point to those of you not familiar with it.

and the reason for that is simple — there isn't a better one made in I.V. The last time I Egged it, my roommate and think diner whenever I'm I arrived just before the morning rush, which seems to start anytime after 10 a.m. We both had omelettes, mine a #7 with tomato, bacon, onion and cheese, (\$4.50) his a #3, the simpler sausage and cheese (\$4.50).

While the short order cook I just mentioned omelettes, stoked up our food on the grill directly across the counter from us, (maybe this is the touch that makes me there), we drank coffee and did a little TM ... ok, you caught me - no TM, just coffee.

By the time our food arrived we were both feeling quite hungry, but no appetite could have prepared us for the mountain of food placed before us by a smiling, Egghead-t-shirted UCSB student/waitress. Meals come with a choice of two of the following: toast, English muffins, bagels or blueberry muffins, fresh fruit, cottage cheese, homefries or tortillas

enough for you there are a variety of side orders as well.

While our omelette selections were fairly conventional, some of the other offerings were far from ordinary. Of the seventeen omelettes served the most popular is probably the Denver omelette, consisting of ham, onions, and cheddar cheese, topped with pineapple, (\$4.50), although many people also return regularly for the #13, a combination of ham, mushrooms, cheddar cheese, and green onions topped with avocado, (\$4.75).

For any non-conformists out there — you know who you are, the single person who refuses to eat what everyone else is having fret not. The Egghead has other breakfasts besides their

17 omelettes. A stack of pancakes starts at \$2.25 and goes up in price depending on what you have with it, and the french toast, rumored to be very thick and fluffy, served with maple syrup, starts at \$2.75.

After we finished breakfast we slowly descended down the stairs, not looking forward at all to the long day of work and studies ahead. Perhaps a sign of just how good the breakfast was were my roommate's last words as we parted on our seperate ways: "I feel like going to sleep!"

The Egghead is open for breakfast and lunch from 7:00 a.m.-2 p.m. weekdays and 7:30-2 on the weekend. They are located upstairs at the corner of Pardall and 900 Embarcadero del Mar.
