Listen, everyone, I want you to put your head down and give a moment of silence for the late Anaconda Theater. It put on some great shows and had the potential to become an entertainment giant, but it is gone. Get it out of your system. Get over it.

Most of all, fight the urge to take out your de-spair on the new residents of that monolithic former bank in the middle of downtown Isla Vista. The I.V. Billiards Club rocks.

I, like many of you, felt a tinge of resentment towards the latest eatery to open up in our fair town. But stories kept coming back to me that the IVBC was great and that I should put my ill will aside.

"That place is great," said Marcel, who has been around as long as I have.

"You gotta come to the Billiards Club with me sometime. That place is great," said Winston, who has good taste.

"Have you checked out that new place where the Anaconda used to be? That place is great," said Edwin, who has the money to eat anywhere he

And so it went, until finally I was thinking to myOK." Odessa, Marcel, Mortimer, some other friends from work and I went over to check it out the other night, and now I am a convert.

I know all too well the entrance to that infamous edifice on Embarcadero del Something, and I thought "No big deal," as I prepared to pass over the threshold. When I actually entered the place, how-ever, I was thinking "Move me in, Herb, I want to live here."

The IVBC is a place with class, where people can dress however they want, but the proprietors care about how it looks. Art deco lamps are suspended above each of the 11 pool tables. Brass rails support the counter dining around the gaming area. Even the picnic bench tables are endowed with a sturdy elegance. And the place has darts!

The main reason I was there, however, was because I was hungry, so I looked at a menu. I was totally unprepared for what I saw before me: creative pasta dishes, salads, calamari — in short, good food. The IVBC does have burritos, but rather than repeating an old I.V. theme, IVBC burritos are something special.

sausage. Actually, the dish has a different name, but it is so authentic I can't remember it. Odessa, my immediate dining compan-ion, ordered the pesto chicken. I also ordered a very large beer.

I didn't know until our server had brought it to our table just how big this beer was going to be, how-ever. It was huge, although I found myself up to the challenge. I suppose I should mention that the IVBC has a bar and bartender as well. Hard alcohol is not available, but if you want to belly up and hunker down and pull at a frosty one, go to the Billiards Club. Now.

The food was great, too. My pasta, though sausageladen, was surprisingly light and laced with delicate flavors. Odessa's chicken, which I had the opportunity to sample, was a mouthful of marvel also. I expected the usual "pesto" - olive oil and basil. What was served was a Sauce, creamy, basil and cheese ... basically a medium through which the pasta and chicken were enhanced to such a degree that it enriched the lives of all who tasted it.

We'd been going together for about nine or 10 months, and both of our jobs kept us from getting out too much, when I decided that we were would have been my


ready, as a couple, for Chuck's of Hawaii. Steaks. Seafood. Chuck's.

Stuart's chicken wrap certainly looked like a delicious combination of chicken, avocado, cheese, tomatoes and more all bread. Stuart assured me


that's exactly what it was.
