To top it off, Soho offers a fine selection of champagne and wine and an extensive list of beer varieties. And last but not least, be sure not to overlook the sinful dessert tray with creamy caramel flan, lavish chocolate mousse and rich cheesecake in raspberry sauce.



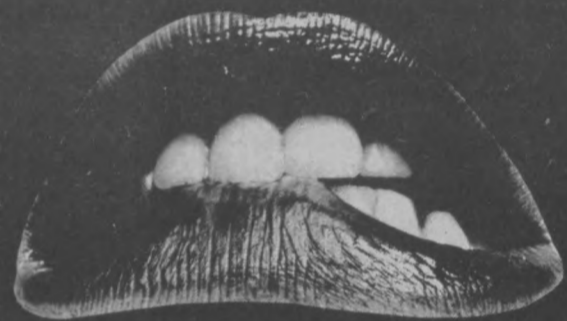

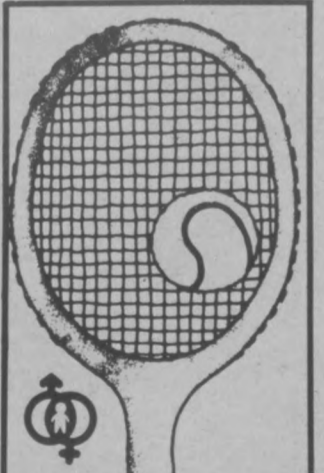

tastiest you've ever seen!

But just wait until your entree arrives. Chase Uptown specializes in seafood and expertly prepares dishes such as red snapper piccata, scampi and lobster provencial, each served with flavorful fettucine. And the proportions are more than generous with the delicious sauteed calamari steak spanning a full 10 inches.

If you're really hungry, you can try the Surf and Turf, which includes a New York steak and medallion of lobster piccata with a side of spaghetti or potatoes. Aside from their classy combinations, there are also all of the great pasta dishes, including fettucine carbonara, spicy spaghetti and meatballs, homemade cheese ravioli, and linguine with white or red clam sauce.

Chase Uptown is a great retreat any time of the week. But weekends are extra special, with a happy-hour pasta bar every Friday from 4-7 p.m. Beers are only 99¢ and all well drinks are \$1.50. 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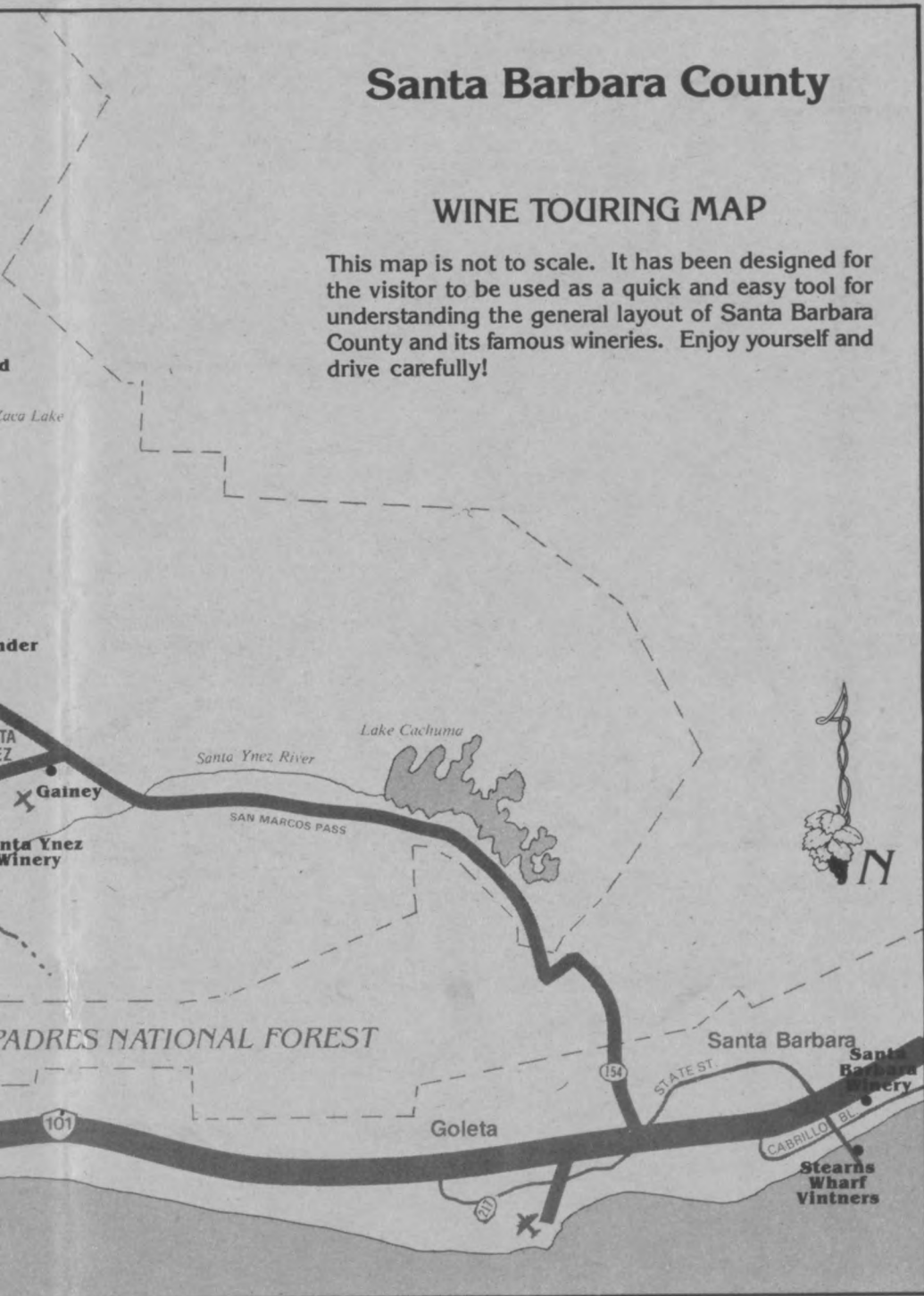

WINE TOURING MAP

This map is not to scale. It has been designed for the visitor to be used as a quick and easy tool for understanding the general layout of Santa Barbara County and its famous wineries. Enjoy yourself and drive carefully!

There are approximately 11,000 acres of grapes planted in Santa Barbara County. Vineyard size ranges from less than one acre to several thousand acres. The area consists of two major growing regions, the Santa Ynez Valley and the Santa Maria Valley. The major grape varieties planted are: Chardonnay, Sauvignon Blanc, Pinot Noir, Cabernet Sauvignon and Riesling. Also planted are small lots of Merlot, Gewurztraminer and Chenin Blanc.

The fifty miles of coastline from Point Conception to the Rincon constitute the only east-west traverse of

shoreline from Alaska to Cape Horn. This southern exposure, combined with a soil chemistry and microclimate almost identical to that of the important wine-growing regions of France, makes Santa Barbara County ideal for grape-growing.

The uniqueness of the east-west running mountain ranges, combined with the proximity to the ocean, assures the vineyards of ocean breezes which temper the warm days with cool nights. Consequently, Santa Barbara County is one of the coolest growing regions in California.

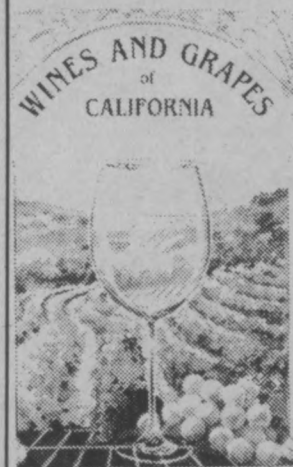
Most of the area is defined

as a cool Region II on the scale developed by Professors Winkler and Amerine of the University of California at Davis to measure degree days. Parts of the Santa Maria Valley and other areas closer to the ocean are classified as a cooler Region I.

An American viticultural area is defined as "a delimited grape-growing region distinguishable by geographical features." With that definition in mind, the Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco and Firearms has approved Santa Barbara County, the Santa Maria Valley, and the Santa Ynez Valley as designated viticultural regions.

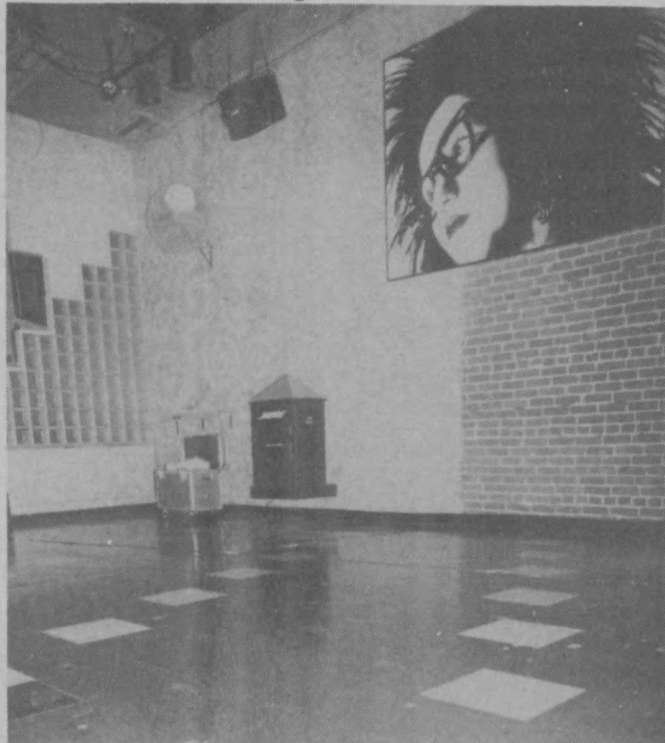
