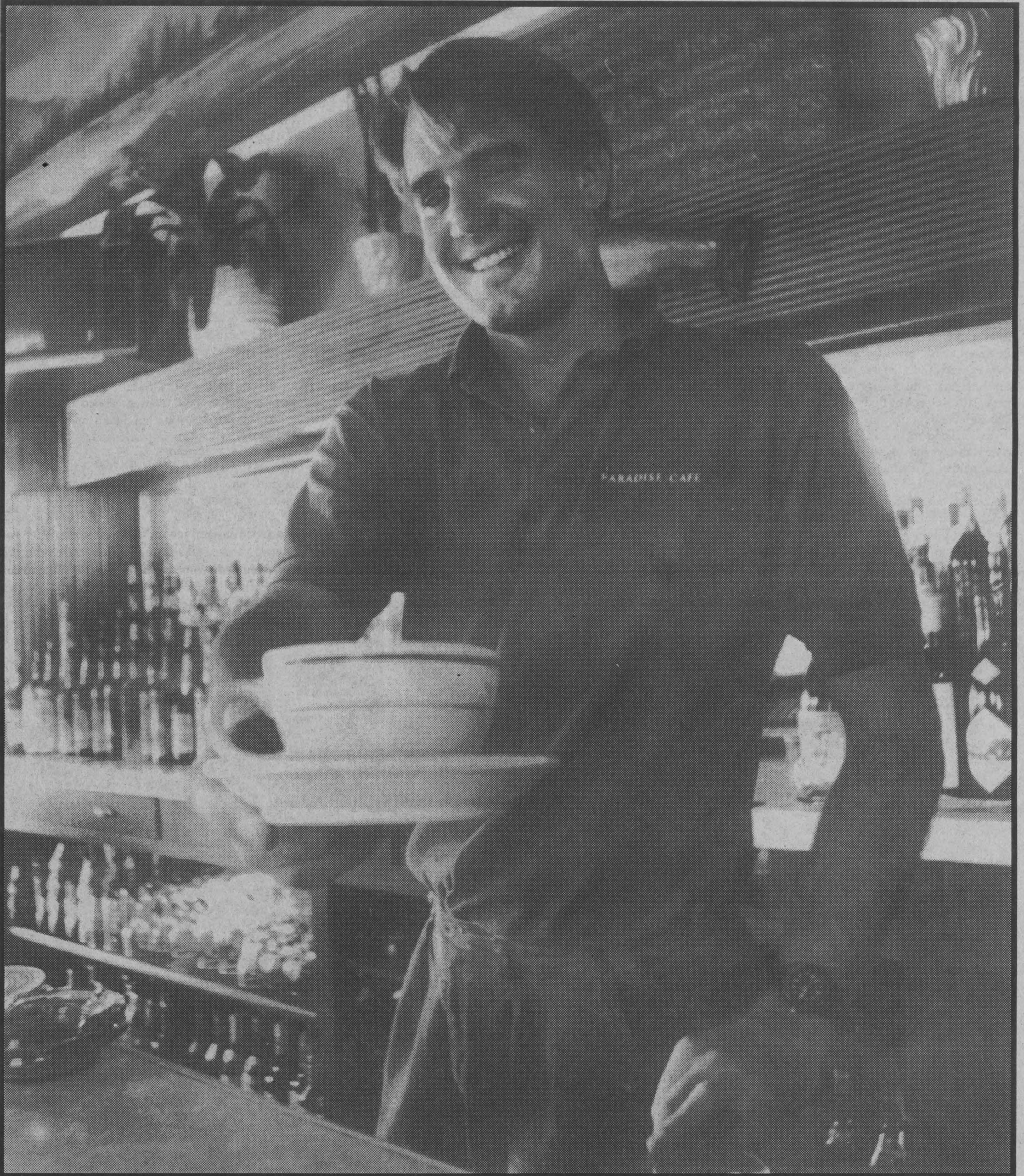

"Wear whatever. It doesn't matter," he answered, still grinning.

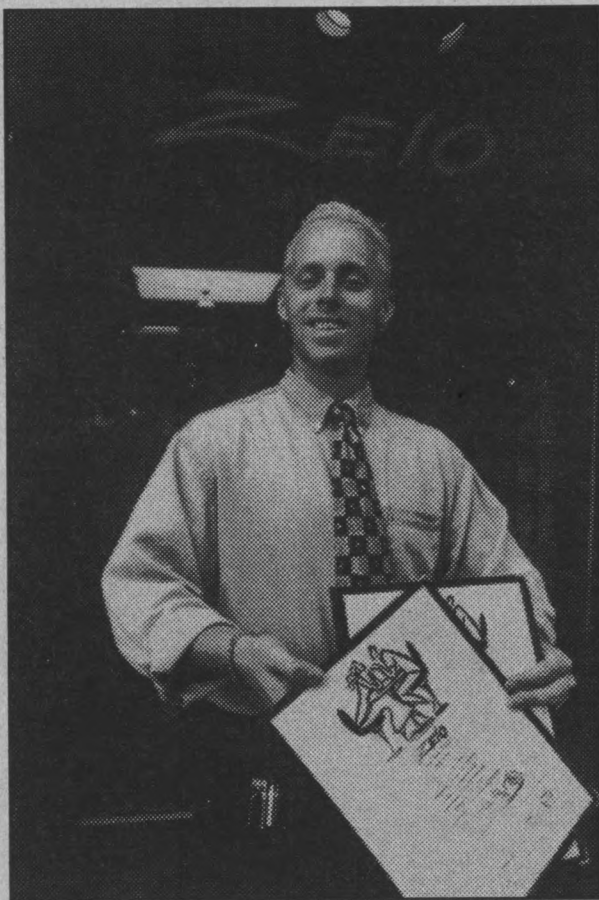
A half-hour later in downtown Santa Barbara:



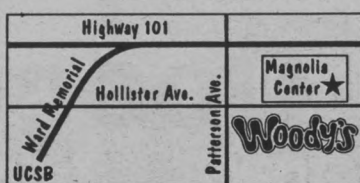

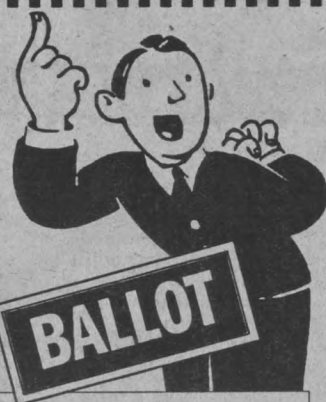
