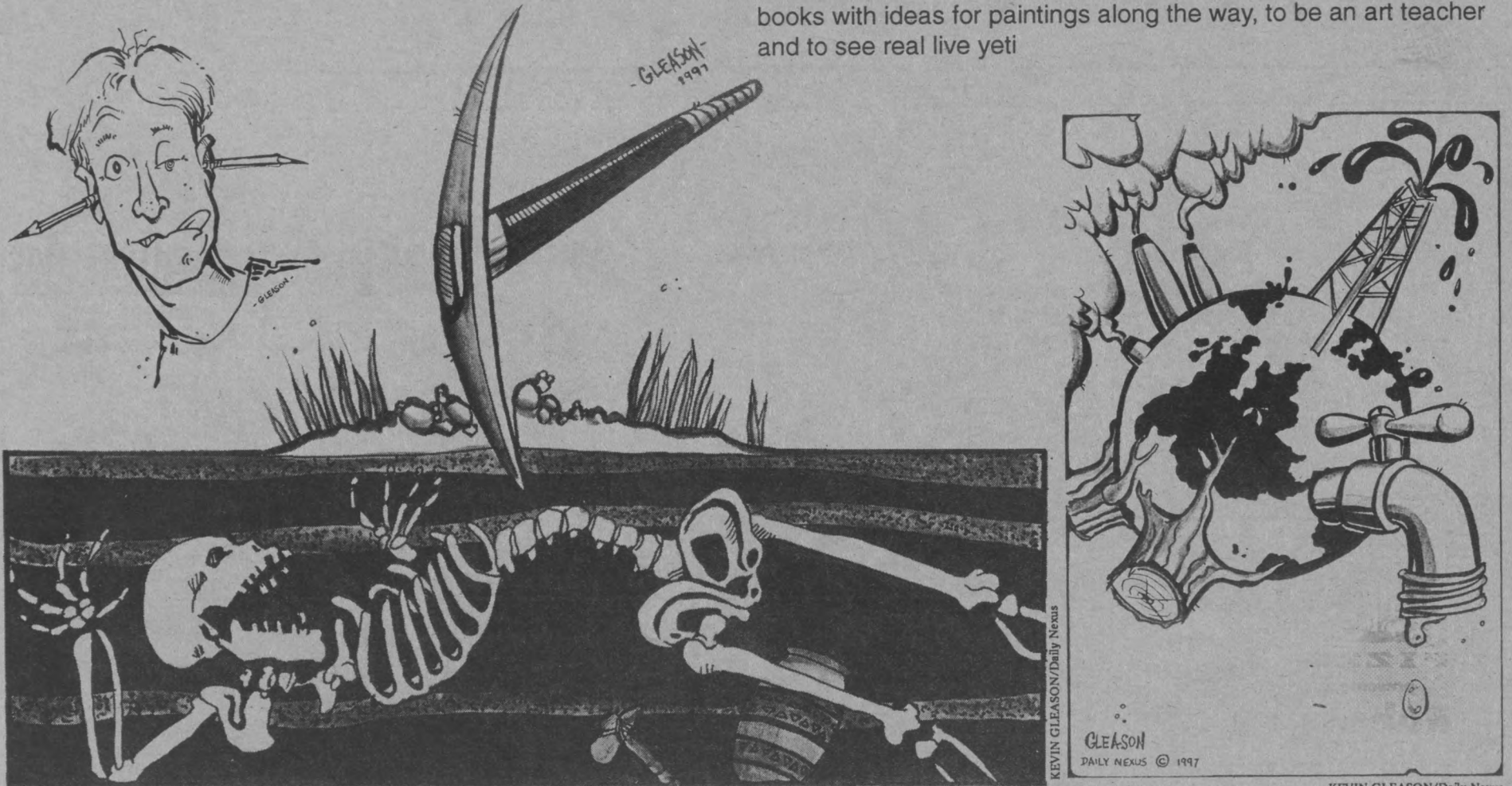

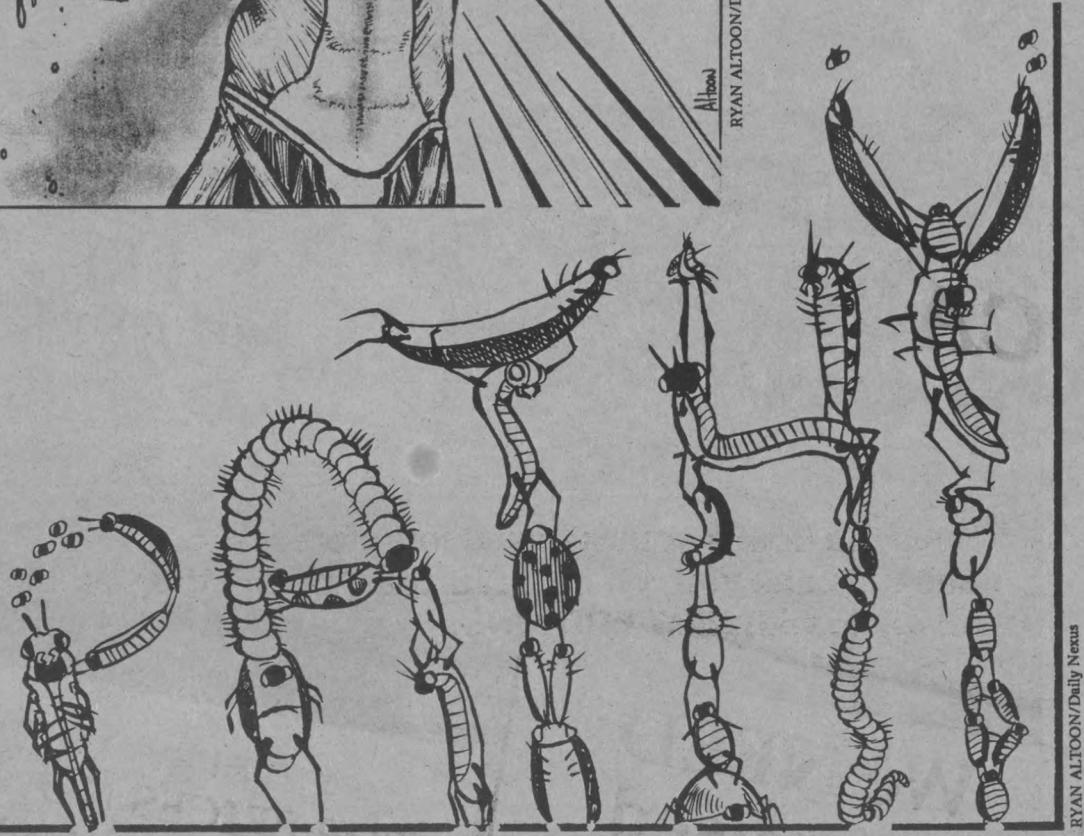

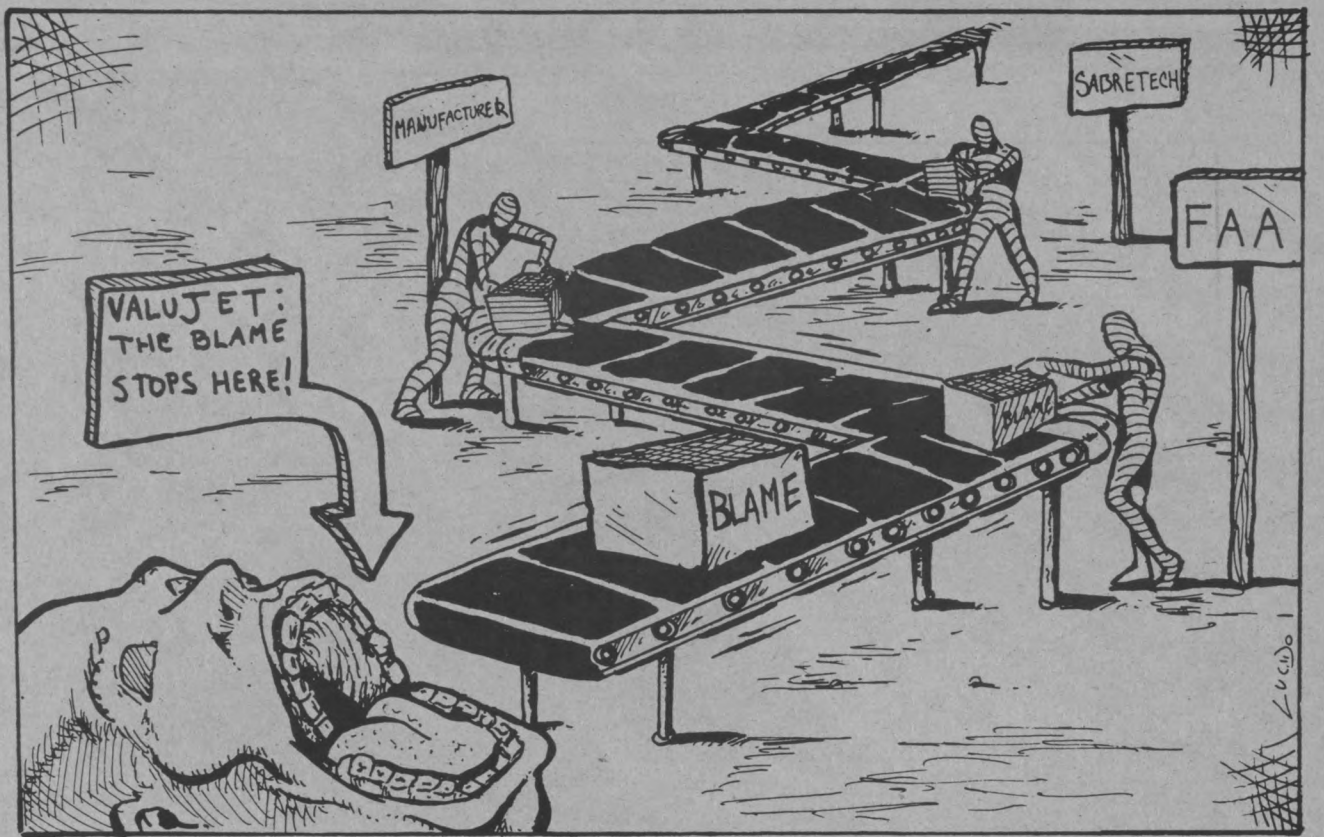

**PUBLIC HEARING AND NOTICE OF DEIR
 FOR
 SEAWATER SYSTEM RENEWAL PROJECT**

Pursuant to the California Environmental Quality Act, the Draft Environmental Impact Report (DEIR) for the proposed Seawater System Renewal Project is available for public review.

The proposed Seawater System Renewal Project consists of renewal of the existing seawater intake and supply system, including a new beach pumphouse, to replace the existing system, and provide new additional filters, supply pumps and seawater storage (reservoir). The project also includes construction of a Lagoon revetment and two new six inch diameter seawater land supply lines to the Biological Sciences II Building. The project also includes architectural and landscaping work, improved access to the beach including disabled access facilities, and improved fire lane access around the Marine Biotechnology Laboratory.

Pursuant to the California Environmental Quality Act, the Draft Environmental Impact Report (DEIR), LRDP Amendment and Open Space Management Plan for the proposed North Campus and West Campus Housing Project are available for public review.

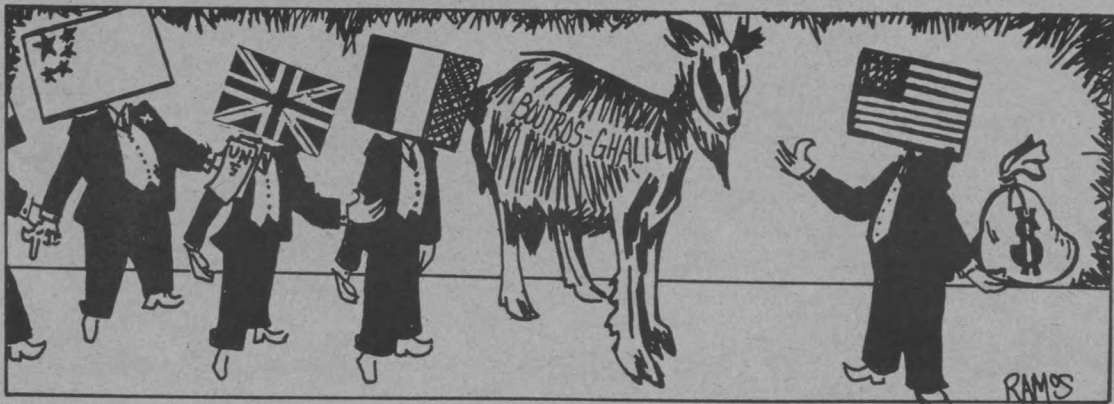
The proposed project includes the 174 acre North Campus (West Devereux Area) that would be designated as residential, open space, and environmentally sensitive habitat area. The proposed amendment would allow development of a maximum of 413 dwelling units, 296 faculty for sale units, 144 student rental units, and includes a 40 acre addition to the Coal Oil Point Reserve of the UC Natural Reserve System.
