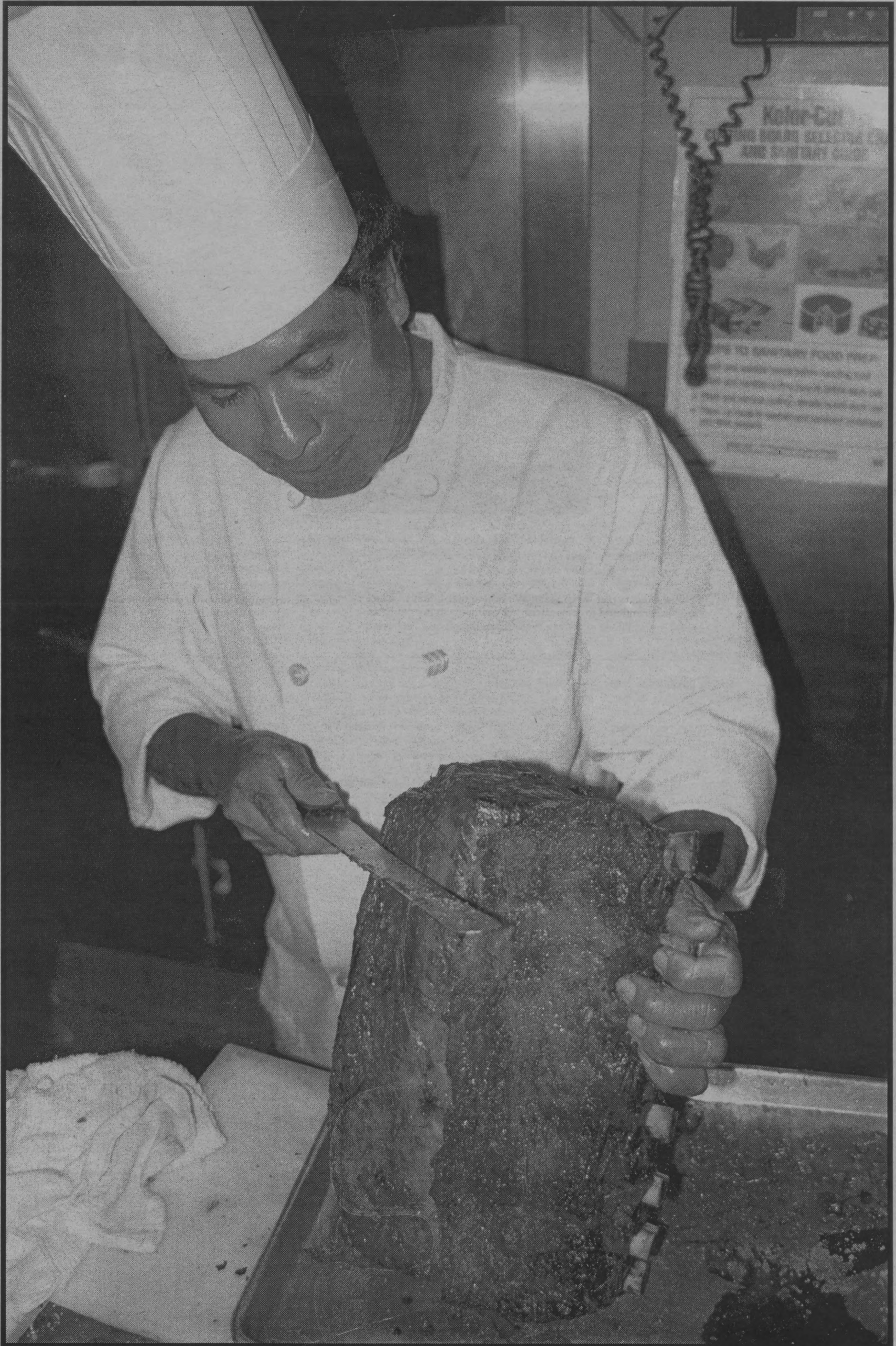

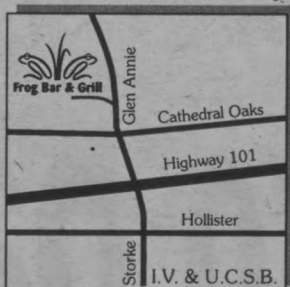

on the side, which I ate every bit of (and I don't even like vegetables!)

Before dinner, it is ideal to sit in Paradise's full bar. Here, friends gather to enjoy the warm atmosphere and good drinks. It's a wonderful place to simply enjoy your company and relax.


