AN OPEN LETTER TO THE UC ADMINISTRATION

Contract negotiations between AFSCME and UC are at a critical point. We are angered and insulted by the proposals the University has made at the bargaining table. Those proposals show that you don't care about your employees.

You don't care if your employees are safe or secure on the job. Despite numerous citations by CAL/OSHA, you refuse to add language to our contract stating that you will abide by federal and state health and safety standards.

You don't care if your employees have worked for UC for 10 or 20 years or more. You want the right to lay them off anytime--with no notice and without regard to seniority--and to take away the employees' right to grieve and arbitrate layoffs.

You don't care if your employees have a decent standard of living or if their buying power is less this year than last. Your salary proposal is for no increase at all for employees at two of UC's medical centers and less than 3% for certain job classifications. You are also proposing that any increase in Shift Differential would have to be subtracted from any wage increase. This despite the fact that funds are available for more.

We protest these proposals by UC's Bargaining Team. We care about the health and safety and job security of UC employees. We think they deserve fair treatment and a decent wage increase.

We urge you to sit down at the bargaining table and bargain fairly. Demonstrate that you really do care about your employees.
