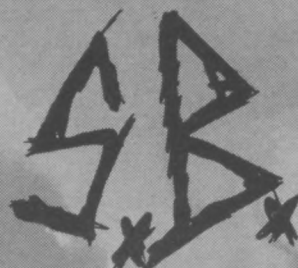

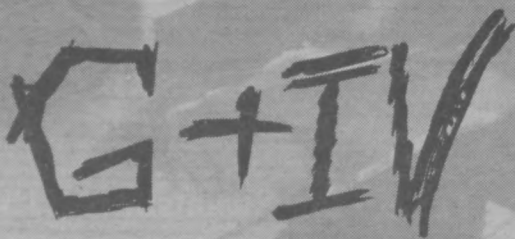

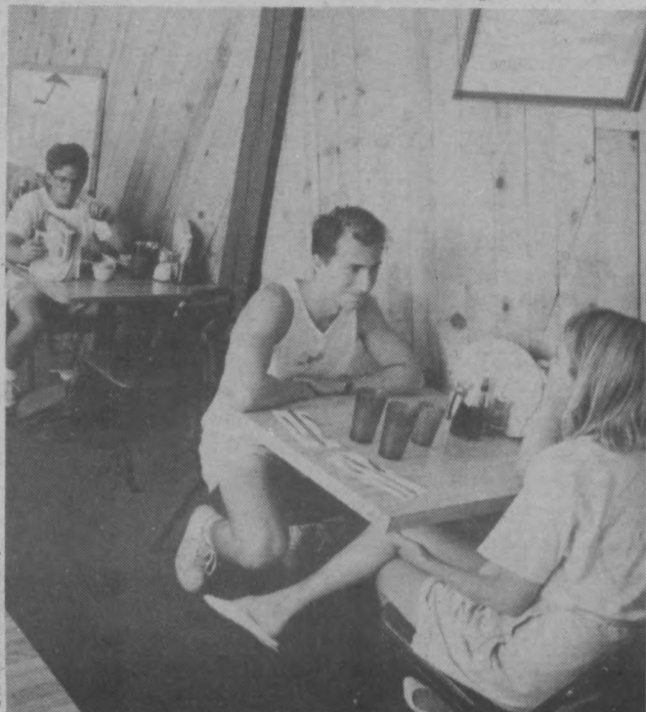

WOODY'S

As difficult as it is to grow weary of the regular culinary fare of the typical student, the time always comes when a person has to lengthen his or her own horizons to include not just burgers and pizza and Chinese food, but also some good old-fashioned grub. And the food you'll find at Woody's at 5112 Hollister Avenue isn't just ordinary grub, it's authentic barbecue-style eats!

Barbequed beef and pork ribs and chicken dripping with Woody's own special sauce is enough to turn any well-travelled palate back to the essentials of eating. The look of the restaurant itself reflects the basic essentials of comfort and relaxation, molded to fit their own personal style and flair.

After a day of driving through the streets of Santa Barbara, my companion and I had only our stomachs in mind. The first refreshing sight we found was Woody's bottomless soft drink bar. The menu offered was full of different tantalizations, including three different-sized racks of ribs, combination plates of ribs and

chicken, 1/3 pound burgers and a host of similar combinations. All sandwiches and dinners are accompanied by a large, thick batch of french fries and a choice of cole slaw or BBQ beans.

The sandwich my companion had, the "Comstock Load," included 1/3 pounds of lean hamburger meat, tomato, lettuce and pickles, and I settled for the 1/2 chicken with the BBQ sauce.

Woody's, we learned, was generous with their helpings, and even our appetites couldn't go the distance with all the food before us. In addition, I made the effort of trying out their special onion rings that have a sweet, spicy taste that is incomparable.

Woody's is of special notice for those who are planning large parties, because they'll also come out to your party and cook up

a mess of ribs and chicken right in front of you, a perfect way to make a picnic or get-together.

We finally had to fill our doggie bags on our way out, ensuring that we would not waste any of Woody's excellence. And I found that though this restaurant was a little out of the way for hardcore Isla Vistas, it's worth the effort to get some real good grub.

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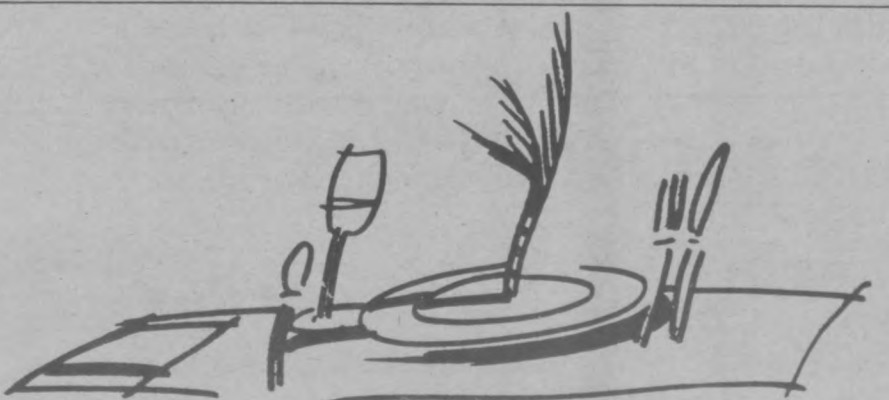

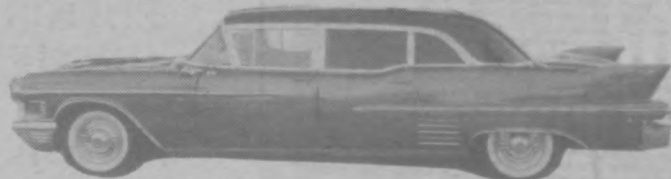

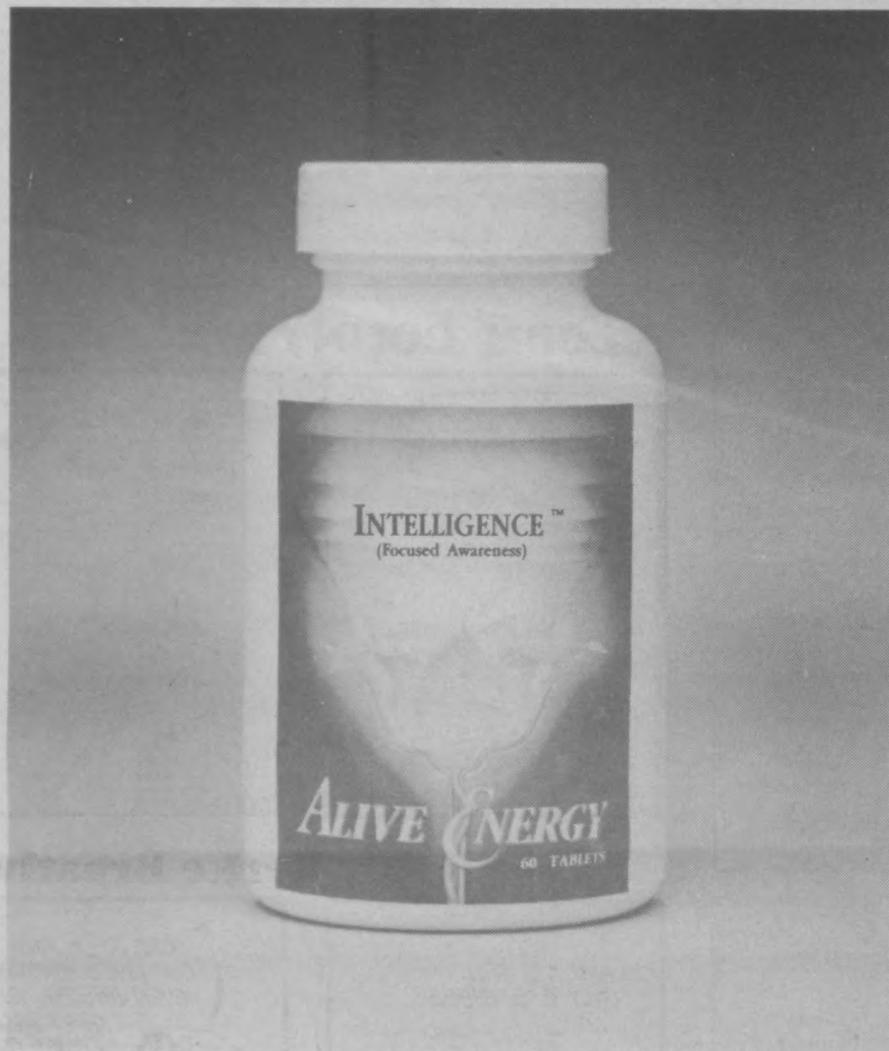
