



Gosh was it good. As a matter of fact, it was so good that I wolfed it down along with the other burger I had ordered, before I realized that I had eaten far too much. Sometimes good eating can be dangerous.

We took Candice's second burger to go. (She would savor it at home.) The concert was wonderful. But that was to be expected from a consummate musician like Jimmy Buffett. Toward the end of the show, he told us how he was planning on spending the rest of the weekend here in Santa Barbara. Candice and I looked at each other and smiled. We were both thinking the same thing. If Jimmy knew what was good for him, he would have to go to Hamburger Habit, all weekend long.
