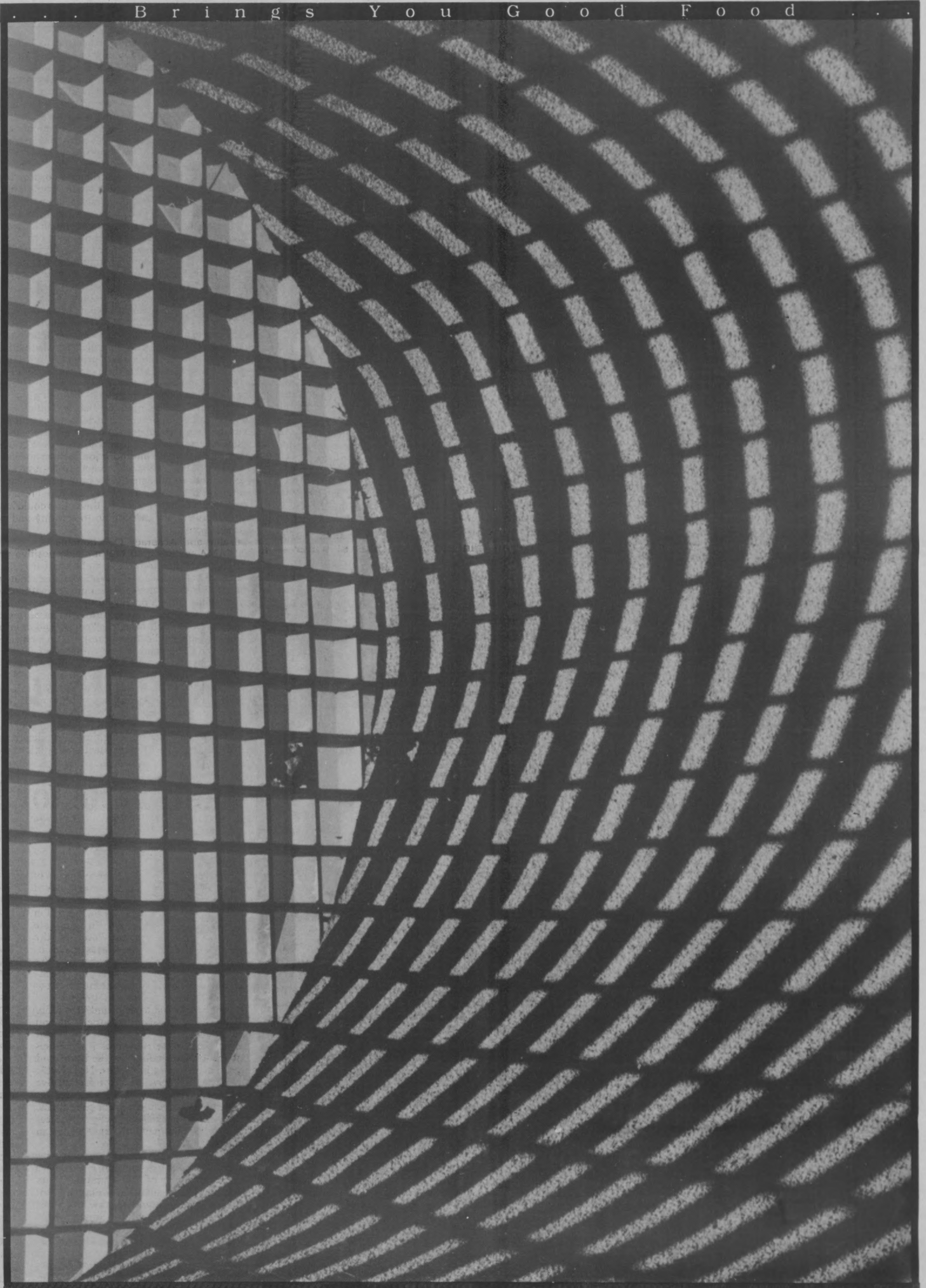

Pepe's: Good Mexican!

It was late afternoon on a hot Friday. Killer and I were driving home from the baseball card show. I was trying to finish spelling my name from the license plates around us. Killer had the Yellow Pages open to the restaurants.

I started talking about Reggie and Sandberg rookie cards and wondering how much I could get for my Tim Foli rookie. I asked Killer if he wanted to trade his Bob Welch for my Terry Forster, but he just sat there, without his seat belt, scanning the restaurant listings with the index finger on his left hand, mumbling something about flautas, mulas and strawberry margaritas.

I looked at him like you look at those people in grocery stores who stand in the aisles for hours comparing labels. I thought it was a little unlike Killer to be so in to something. I wondered where he got the Yellow Pages.

He mumbled for a couple more seconds and then lifted his head in a flash, half-screaming "Mexican—that's what I want." Really we had just eaten a couple hours before—they had served us up some finger sandwiches, pizza rolls and punch over at the show.

But Killer was serious—he didn't earn his nickname by frying ants with a magnifying glass. You know what I mean. At 5'6", 130 pounds, when Killer says "Mexican," you'd better throw on a sombrero and start callin' people Poncho.

I said "OK, what'll it be?" and Killer read the advertisement where the drool

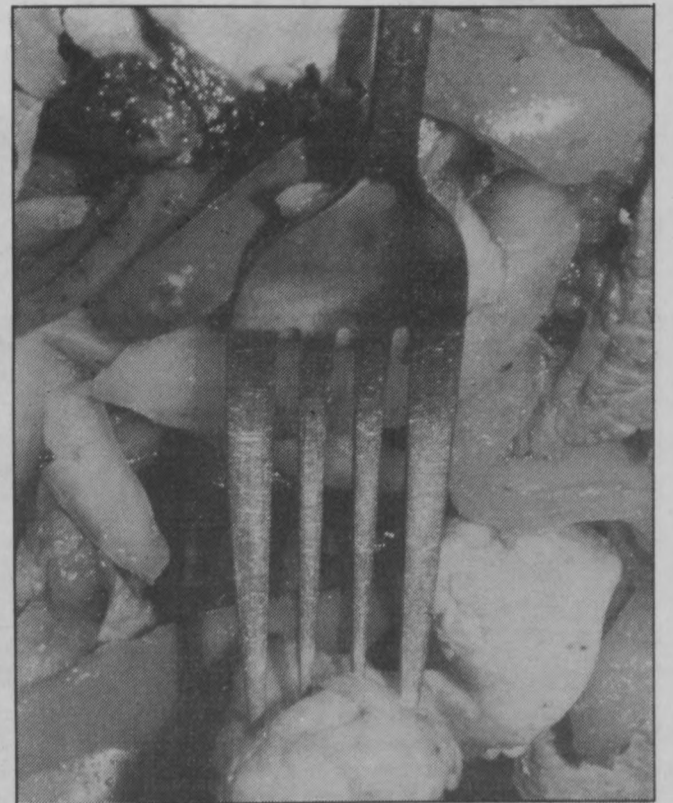
from his lip had landed. It was Pepe's Mexican Restaurant at 254 Orange Avenue in Goleta—one block north of Hollister Avenue. I was kind of in the mood for more of those pizza rolls, but what was I gonna do?

We got off the freeway and pulled up in front of Pepe's. It looked like an authentic Spanish *casa*—especially the immaculate Spanish-style roof, which spurred visions of salsa, laden with lots of cilantro and onions. And homemade corn tortillas. But Killer and I knew from experience that you can't judge a restaurant by its cover, so we walked inside.

It seemed like the hostess was waiting for us. She bade us good evening and we told her "Non-smoking, please." The eating area was like a cross between a mission and a restaurant—none of the usual walls and borders separating the patrons. That was just fine with us because when Killer and I hit the restaurants, we like to mix it up with the other diners, sort of compare notes, maybe even sample each other's selections.

So when the waitress came promptly with our fiesta platter appetizer, complete with taquitos, quesadillas, guacamole and jalapenos, you can bet there were two or three people with chips in hand looking to land a free taste. Soon the whole non-smoking section was like one big party of 16. It was Killer's kind of place—he was even practicing Spanish with the Mexican women sitting behind us.

By this time we had already deemed the evening a success. But there were still the entrees to be had. Mine

was a burrito (no problem substituting the beef with chicken), garnished with sour cream, guacamole and small pieces of green onions, served with the ritual beans and rice (I love it when the waitress tells me to watch out because the plate is real hot).

Killer went a little crazier than usual and got two orders: the tostada and the chicken enchilada-burrito combination plate covered with sauce. He didn't even finish. Neither did I—it was just too much. We sat around for a little while longer and drank margaritas and munched chips. The waitress came by and smiled, in-

quiring if we wanted one of those metal-looking take-home deals. We did.

We left to warm goodbyes from the waitresses and this guy in a brown suit (I think he was the proprietor). We were stuffed. We sat in the car for a couple seconds to digest and then we left. We went home and watched the news and talked about Pepe's. We got up late the next day and did it all again for lunch with our leftovers.

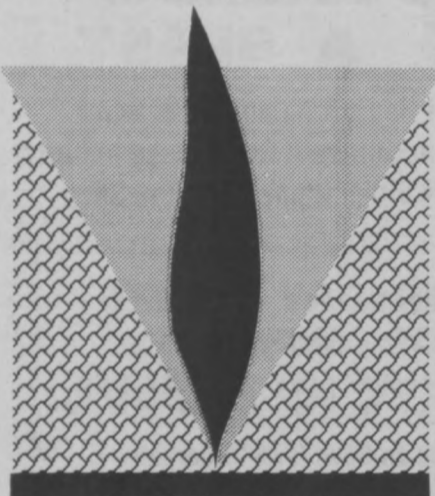

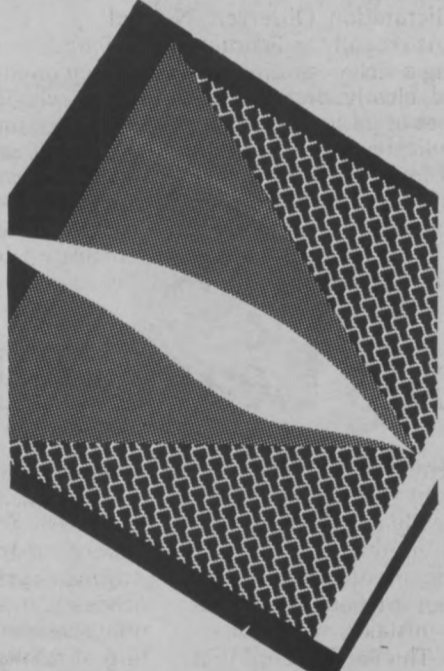
