Try The Thai Food Challenge

Thai food did not arrive in Santa Barbara until 1982, when Bangkok West opened its doors to customers on Milpas street. Since then, three more Thai restaurants have emerged to satisfy Santa Barbara's exotic demands. In the last several years, this Southeast Asian food has clearly risen to a place of prominence among Santa Barbara's leading cuisines.

Modern Thai cooking is the culmination of centuries of foreign culinary influences, primarily through trades with China and India. Over the years, the Thais transformed and modified these foods to a distinctively different cuisine of their own. The Chinese stir-fry style, for instance, has been altered to depend less on cooking oil, while relying more on indigenous spices. The Indian influence is evident in the Thais' spicy curries. But the Thais have changed these to fit their taste as well.

Their colorful curries are made from coconut milk and a paste which combines such ingredients as red chili, dried shrimp, onion, garlic, and lemon grass. But the Thais' cooking secret is probably their fish sauce. This sauce, made from fish extracts, salt and water, is indispensable in all Thai eateries. Aside from foreign influence, the Thais have also created numerous dishes of their own. Most of the diverse soups, for example, were invented by peasants in Thailand's countryside.

Where should you go to munch on this tasty cuisine? All four Thai restaurants in town offer comparable food quality and prices. However, they all have different atmospheres. For a romantic date, I recommend "Your Place," located on 22A N. Milpas, for its coziness and snug setting. A few blocks farther north at 435 N. Milpas is "Bangkok West," the pioneer of Thai food in this city. If you're dining out with a group of friends, this place is the place to go for its spacious and comfortable scene. In addition, "Bangkok West" is

Thailand's cultural history. So look around once you're inside, and ask your host about these decorations.

For more elegance, you might want to try "Kanda" at 3132 on upper State street. A candlelit dinner here could foster any romance, or start one. But if you just want to carry on some casual conversation, I suggest the "Shores of Siam," situated



on 2829 De La Vina street. A delicious and complete dinner for two at any of these four restaurants shouldn't exceed twenty bucks. And you're guaranteed to be treated nicely.

After knowing your choice of Thai restaurants, you may like to know the kinds of dishes to order. It all really depends on the durability of your taste buds and how daring you are. For Westerners, Thai food is a challenge, a palatable alternative to the often plain Western cuisines

Definitely begin with an appetizer or two. By far the most popular appetizer is the "sa-tay," which is barbecued pork or beef that has been saturated overnight by authentic, slightly spicy powder. These barbecued skewers are dipped into a peanut sauce, and are served along with pickled cucumber. You could also order egg rolls or wontons. Among

decorated with beautiful ornaments and crafts reflecting all the soups, I recommend the "Thom Kar Gai," which mixes chicken, with herbs and coconut milk, lemon grass, and hot chilis. If you prefer to start with a salad, try "Yum Yai" with its zesty dressing.

For your main course, many choices are available, ranging from mild entrees to eye-watering ones. Stir-fry dishes are very popular. You could get your favorite meat pan-fried with any vegetable. Or, if you're a vegetarian, the meat could be omitted. Specifically, request for "Spicy Bamboo Shoots," or "Mint Leaves" with your preferred meat or chicken. You could also choose from the rice and noodles dishes, though they're usually eaten for lunch by

Of the noodles items on the menu, "Phad Thai" is by far the most popular. This reddish-looking dish uses imported rice noodles with pork, shrimp, and egg, sprinkled with ground peanut on top. For spicy challenges, the curries are notorious. They come in different styles and forms. But fundamentally, they are cooked very much the same way. Try the "Duck Curry" if you're tired of beef or chicken. These curries are enriched and spiced up by coconut milk and chili paste which are imported from Thailand.

There are also many seafood dishes, some hot and some not. Ask for "Spicy Scallops and Squid" or any other seafood delights of your preference. Always specify the degree of spice. All four restaurants have their own daily "specials," so don't forget to make inquiries to your waitress or waiter.

To cool off your mouth, try the Thai ice tea or ice coffee. They are slightly sweet and creamy, just right when your mouth and lips are burning. Thai beers are known for their higher alcoholic contents, and are also ideal for quelling your flaming tongue. For dessert, you should not miss the unique and home-made "coconut ice cream."

The kinds of food listed above vary from one restaurant to another. But all four of Santa Barbara's restaurants offer similar menus. Ask your waitperson for further information. And before leaving, say "sawaddee" to your host. You are
