WHAT DOES THE U.R.C. DO?

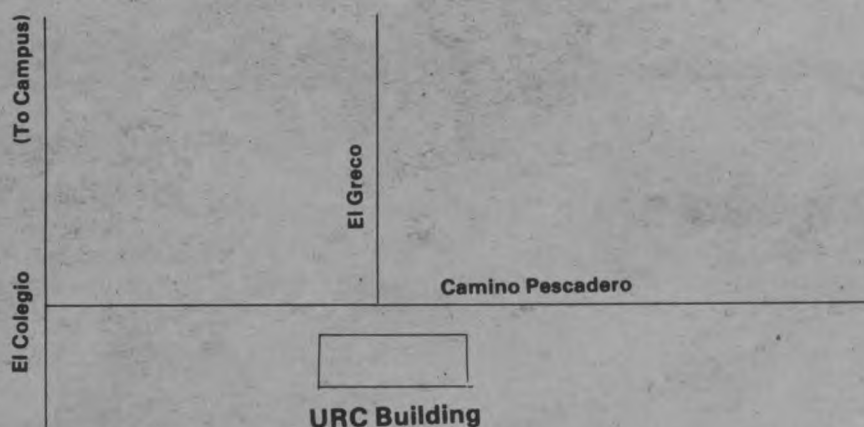
It acts as a meeting place for students, initiates interfaith programs, has individual religious group activities and provides counseling services.

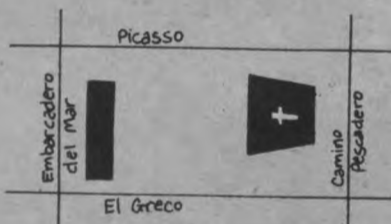

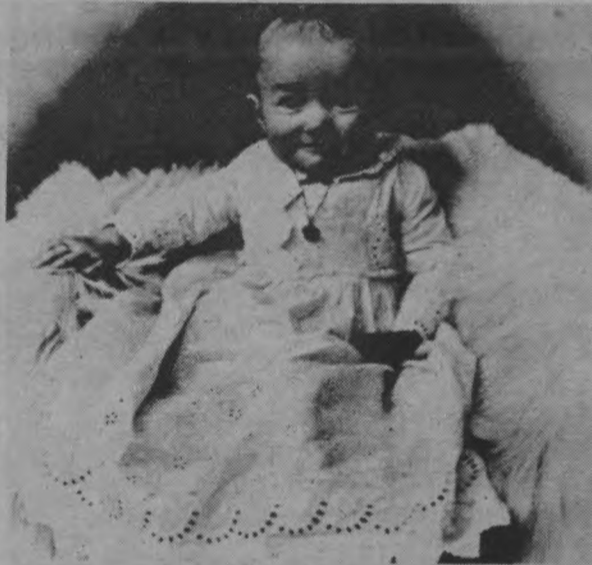

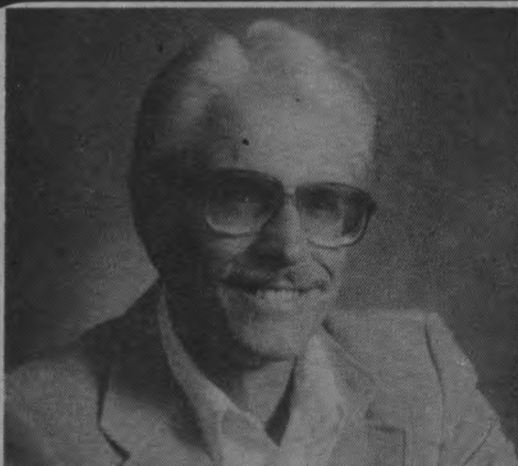


The CHRISTIAN SCIENCE ORGANIZATION of UCSB invites you to:

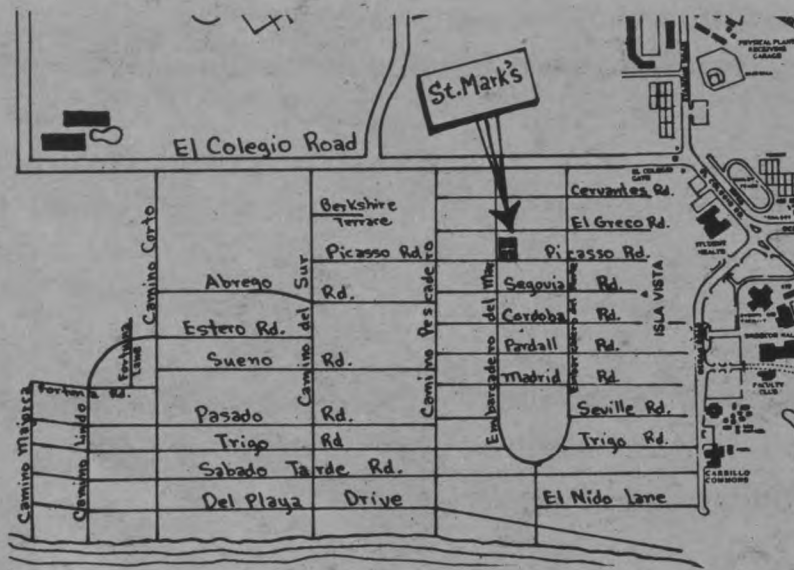
