Undergraduates doing original research and writing projects are invited to submit papers for possible publication in *DISCOVERY - UCSB Journal of Undergraduate Research*. Interested students should come to the Mathematics Department office in South Hall 6607 to obtain the basic information and guidelines concerning publication and to leave information about themselves and their work.

Papers should be analytical, involving critical reasoning. Examples of publishable work are research papers in the natural and social sciences and critical essays in the arts and humanities. Creative or impressionistic writing will generally not qualify (such work usually has an outlet in *SPECTRUM*), nor will work which is basically a review of the subject. The deadline for submission of manuscript copy is Friday, June 24, 1988. Students intending to submit a paper but needing more time may be allowed to submit after this date provided they make their intentions known prior to the deadline.
