Papers should be analytical, involving critical reasoning. Examples of publishable work are research papers in the natural and social sciences and critical essays in the arts and humanities. Creative or impressionistic writing will generally not qualify (such work usually has an outlet in SPECTRUM), nor will work which is basically a review of the subject. The deadline for submission of manuscript copy is Friday, June 24, 1988. Students intending to submit a paper but needing more time may be allowed to submit after this date provided they make their intentions known prior to the deadline.
