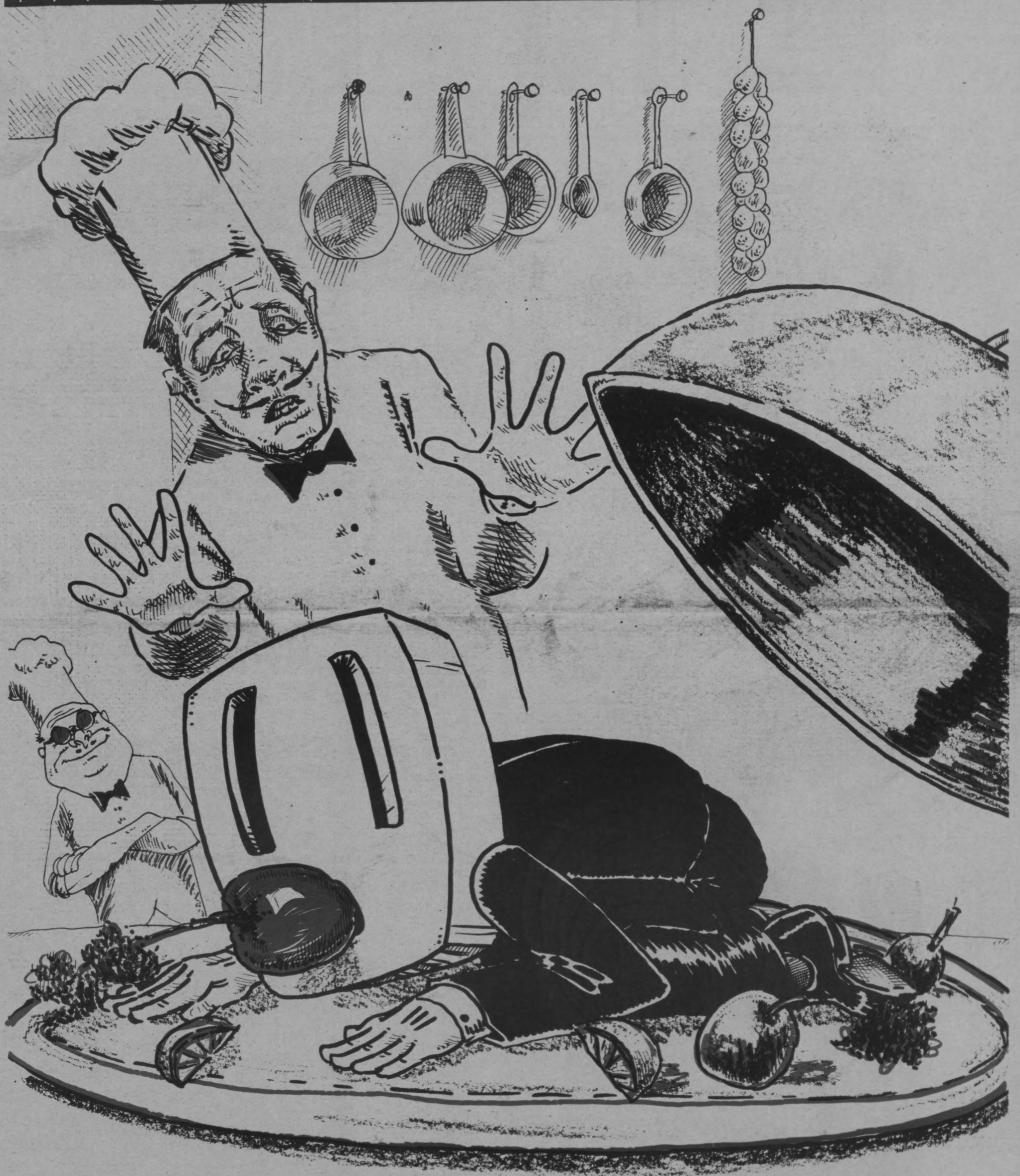

I rushed inside completely disheveled. I was late in meeting a friend and I thought bad attitudes might prevail. Wrong. The attitude inside the restaurant was completely nonexistent. People were just sitting back, drinking and having a generally nifty time. There was no way a bad mood could survive in this environment.

I stood at the entrance and glanced around a bit before I noticed the outside patio. It was a sunny day and the patio had little trees and plants scattered around to create a more nifty effect. When I got to the table, my friend was waiting for me, beer in hand — ready and willing to do whatever it is that beer drinkers do ... in public, at least.

Before I had ever been to Spike's, I had heard about their beer selection, but had chosen not to believe it. The worst beers on this list of 40 selections were Coors Light and Budweiser. After years of Meister Brau, anything else was looking good. I couldn't imagine spoiling myself on imports from nearly every part of the world. I had no idea half of these beers even existed, but hell, I'm an open-minded individual ... bring 'em on!

Wine Country

There are approximately 11,000 acres of grapes planted in Santa Barbara County. Vineyard size ranges from less than one acre to several thousand acres. The area consists of two major growing regions, the Santa Ynez Valley and the Santa Maria Valley. The major grape varieties planted are: Chardonnay, Sauvignon Blanc, Pinot Noir, Cabernet Sauvignon and Riesling. Also planted are small lots of Merlot, Gewurztraminer and Chenin Blanc.

The fifty miles of coastline from Point Conception to the Rincon constitute the only east-west traverse of shoreline from Alaska to Cape Horn. This southern exposure, combined with a soil chemistry and microclimate almost identical to that of the important wine-growing regions of France, makes Santa Barbara County ideal for grape-growing.

The uniqueness of the east-west running mountain ranges, combined with the proximity to the ocean, assures the vineyards of ocean breezes which temper the warm days with cool nights. Consequently, Santa Barbara County is one of the coolest growing regions in California.

Most of the area is defined as a cool Region II on the scale developed by Professors Winkler and Amerine of the University of California at Davis to measure degree days. Parts of the Santa Maria Valley and other areas closer to the ocean are classified as a cooler Region I.

An American viticultural area is defined as "a delimited grape-growing region distinguishable by geographical features." With that definition in mind, the Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco and Firearms has approved Santa Barbara County, the Santa Maria Valley, and the Santa Ynez Valley as designated viticultural regions.

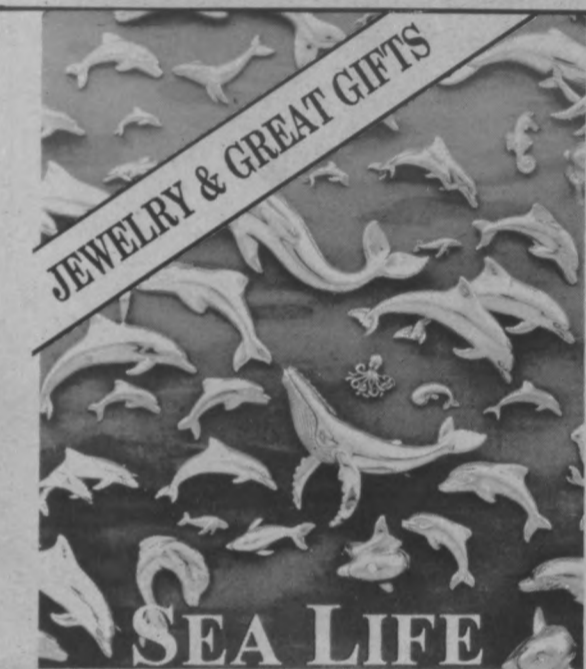

Then there's other well drinks, but I am just going to get straight to the beef of the bar. They got Tecate! Now if you are either saying "What is Tecate?" or "So?" then you are either crazy or you have never gotten Mexican. In both cases you should drink Tecate.
