## A GOOD HABIT

If you've ever been to Tommie's in Los Angeles, you know what a great chiliburger tastes like. If you've never been to Tommie's in L.A., you can find out what a great chiliburger tastes like right here in Santa Barbara.

Hamburger Habit was originally a little food joint in Isla Vista, where Mc-Burley's is now. It specialized, in case you haven't already guessed, in chiliburgers.

It changed hands three times or so, then it moved to Hollister Avenue in Goleta, where it still stands. In 1980, it changed hands for the final time. And if you go there, you'll know why it hasn't been sold since. The place does business. And if you eat there, you'll know why it does business. The food is pretty darn good!

The atmosphere is very comfortable, with more than a dozen tables set up outside, so there's never a problem finding a seat in the Santa Barbara sunshine. The window to order from is as unique as the restaurant in which it is located. The little signs "Ask" and "Get" tell you where to order and pick up your food.

The specialty, chiliburger, can be bought in single or double patties (I got the double, of course). The chili is piled heaping high, and it's good eatin' for a hungry appetite! And hey, the chiliburger may be the specialty, but it isn't all they have to offer.

They serve plain hamburgers, patty melts and steak, and they are all good. You can't go wrong with this

And all their burgers (even their doubles) go for under two bucks. The place drives a hard bargain.

And of course, everyone who visits a hamburger joint wants to know about the side dishes. What about the fries? What about the onion rings?

Well, the fries are toprate: crunchy and golden brown. And the chili fries give you the best of both worlds. The onion rings are flavorful enough to give the fries a tough run for their money.

What about drinks? Besides the usual assortment of soft drinks, the Habit offers shakes and malts that will cool you off when the hot weather comes back around. I drank the chocolate shake and had a

taste of the strawberry malt. They were both so good, I just might have to drink them both next time.

If you go there, ask for Brent, who bought the place in 1980 after working there for four years, and has made a great success out of it since. He'll be more than happy to fill you in on not only the joys of the Habit, but also his other popular restaurant, Cal Taco.

But the best way to get acquainted with the Habit is to make it a habit of yours.

# BALTIERIS

Nobody has to tell UCSB students that there's more to cuisine than the overpopulation of pizza palaces in Isla Vista, but hasn't anyone told them that a real Italian restaurant is as close as Hollister Avenue in Goleta? Baltieri's, across the street from Alex's Cantina, provides a vital difference in dining experience, creating a private yet casual atmosphere that allows people to concentrate less on their appearance or eccentric manners and more on the fine meal in front of them.

Instead of the usual condescending melody of Italian violins through tiny speakers, the little restaurant is filled with lively conversation and the clatter of dishes. My companion and I agreed that it resonated with the feel of a bistro, friendly and inviting. The quick, conscientious servers were a definite plus, and I noted the swiftness with which a roll of French bread appeared on our table.

The menu has a long list of pasta dishes as simple and traditional as spaghetti and other dishes that are as exotic and unusual as the seafood stew, which I'm told is unique in most Italian restaurants. The prices run from about \$7 to \$15, quite reasonable for the amount of food the restaurant offers.

The fettucini gorgonzola was recommended to me, and I allied it with a glass of Bollini Chardonnay. The wine list has a nice selection of local and California wines, reasonably priced and Baltieri's always seems to be well stocked. To start off, the choice of soup or salad was happily given to a cup of the Venetian fish chowder, which contained really big chunks of red snapper that literally melted in my


There was a group of men at a nearby table, laughing heartily over a bottle of red wine. Baltieri's clientele varied greatly, from young people to older, with only their enthusiasm for conversation in common. It is that kind of restaurant, where you go to get to know a person and to share stories and eccentric secrets. Baltieri's is a kind of restaurant where you look at

each other. When our entrees were served, I thought that in my passionate hunger, two or three platters wouldn't be enough. One good look at the expansiveness of our fetfor good. This was a meal. My gorgonzola was heavy with fresh, steaming broccoli and large, plump shrimps smothered in cheese sauce. My companion's fettucini primavera was covered with mushroom, cauliflower and other vegies. For several long minutes, our light conversation gave way to slurps and chomps and satisfying mmmms. My wine was light and sweet and

tucini platters resolved that did well to wash down the gorgonzola.

Baltieri's serves lunch as well as dinner, except Saturday and Sunday, and is open until 9:30 nightly. When I left, I clutched my doggy bag greedily and reminded myself repeatedly that it was the best meal I'd had in a long while. And the best thing of all, it wasn't at all much farther away than those pizza places.





Santa Barbara, like all famous cities, has an image and a reputation that precedes it. Besides that intellectually numbing and strained soap opera that exploits our favorite city's style and dignity, the character of Santa Barbara is recognized by its slowpaced lifestyle, the timeless beauty of its shores and the ideal of leisure that can be found only in California. A Santa Barbara restaurant should therefore be representative of that idea. Paradise Cafe on Anacapa, one block parallel to State Street, is not only representative, it is the exemplification.

The outer appearance is unobtrusive, almost to the extent that the restaurant looks hidden. This is accurate to a degree, since its location is very close to the main shopping strip on State, but far enough removed to give it that sense of privacy. Immediately, you discover that it offers outdoor dining on the patio for the balmy days Santa Barbara offers. The restaurant and bar area are set apart and might suggest a claustrophobic atmosphere, but this is far from the truth. The bar has a high ceiling and a bright decor, so you can actually see the person you may be sharing a margarita with. My waiter aptly described it as a "'40s style" saloon with a "light and airy atmosphere.'

The inner restaurant is also divided into two sections. The outer room has high glass windows and bright walls to provide more of that comfortable, relaxed attitude. For more intimate engagements, the rear room is darker and candlelit. The small rooms imply a cozy demeanor.

And don't think I'm trying to avoid the topic of food by lecturing on the lofty importance of atmosphere over taste. No, I've just been saving the best for last. The little menu overflows with possibilities, with a truly continental offering of steaks, linguini, seafood and even good burgers for those of us who are hopelessly addicted. Paradise also earned a mark on my good list by its continuous flow of hot, buttered sourdough bread. Entrees come with a soup or salad, rice or shoestring potatoes. Anyone can chop lettuce and carrots at home in my opinion, but not everybody can make a gazpacho like Paradise does, perfect for the end of a warm

And of course that will just warm up your digestive tract for many of the delicious meals the restaurant serves. I opted for a traditional beef fillet, but still had that shark in the

back of my mind all the time. And if you're of the legal drinking age, dare to peruse the very lengthy wine list, which your server will be happy to help you with.

My waiter informed me that the clientele is "across the board." I can think of any number of different occasions that the Paradise Cafe would accommodate, but for college students, it is especially suited for those special visits from your parents, grandparents and old friends who are willing to shell out the bills to do the Santa Barbara "experience." Prices can run as low as \$6 and as high as \$20, with most good meals running in-between.

So grab that sweetheart, invite those parental units and call in that raincheck (you know you have one) and enjoy spring in Santa Barbara in only one place ... Paradise.

A disease that once put an end to its victims, may soon be put to an end itself.

The disease, carnitine defi-ciency, destroys the body's ability

ciency, destroys the body's ability to produce carnitine, a muscle-fueling substance. Until recently, carnitine deficiency meant certain disability. Often, it meant death. 
